Day 1: Arrive to Cairo Airport

A Cairo Top Tours representative will meet you at the luggage belt at [Cairo International Airport](#), holding a sign with your name and the company logo. You will then be driven to your hotel in Cairo in a private, air-conditioned vehicle. At the hotel, your tour leader will help you check in quickly and review your Egypt tour itinerary to confirm pick-up times for each day of your tours.

Enjoy an overnight stay in Cairo with a welcome drink.

Day 2 : Pyramids and the highlights of Cairo Tour

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel in the early morning, then join your Egyptologist guide for a tour of the Giza Plateau. Visit the [Giza Pyramids](#), starting with the Great Pyramid of Cheops, built over 4,500 years ago and the largest of the three pyramids. You'll also see the pyramids of Chephren and Mycerinus, as well as the Great Sphinx, created by King Chephren, and the Valley Temple.

Next, explore in your [Cairo Days Tours](#) Coptic Cairo, including the Hanging Church, built above the ruins of the old Fortress of Babylon, the Church of St. Sergius, and the Ben Ezra Synagogue, originally a Coptic church.

Have lunch at an oriental restaurant before visiting [the Egyptian Museum](#), which opened in 1902 and houses a vast collection of artifacts from Egypt's history.

Finally, experience shopping at Cairo's oldest bazaar, [Khan El Khalili](#), a popular destination during Islamic Cairo tours.

Return to your hotel for an overnight stay in Cairo.

Day 3 : Cairo to Bahariya Oasis

start your [Egypt Luxury Tours](#) with a journey to [Bahariya Oasis](#). Accompanied by an Egyptologist guide in a modern, air-conditioned vehicle to Bahariya Oasis, a 4-hour drive from Cairo. Upon arrival, you'll visit the Valley of the Golden Mummies, the Tombs of the Nobles, the Temple of Alexander the Great, and the Temple of Muftella dedicated to the god Bis.

Enjoy a delicious lunch at a Bedouin-style restaurant, then check into your hotel and relax for the afternoon.

In the evening, you'll take a 4-wheel drive to the Black Mountain to see the ruins of the "English House" and enjoy the stunning sunset view over Bahariya Oasis.

Stay overnight in Bahariya.

Day 4: White & Black Desert

In the early morning, have breakfast and visit the stunning Salt Lake to enjoy the views and take photos. Experience the golden sand dunes, learn to climb palm trees like the locals, and pick fresh seasonal fruit in the lush gardens. Begin your adventure to [the White Desert](#) with a stop at [the Black Desert](#), known for its volcanic rock-covered mountains, and visit the Valley of El Haize. See the quartz at Crystal Mountain and spend some time in the picturesque Valley of Agabat. Spend the night camping under the stars in the White Desert, surrounded by beautiful white limestone and chalk formations.

Enjoy a Bedouin dinner in the desert.

Day 5: Farafra & Dakhla Oases

Start your day with a traditional breakfast and refreshing mint tea. Then, head to Farafra Oasis to relax in the hot sulfur spring of Bir Setah and visit Badr's unique mud brick museum. Explore the old town of Al Qasr, and then drive for three hours to Dakhla. There, you'll visit the Roman Temple of Deir El Hagar, buried in desert sand, and see beautiful rock-cut tombs at the Roman burial site of El Muzawwaqqa.

After lunch, explore the 12th-century Islamic Village of Al Qasr with its ancient houses, oil press, wheat grinder, court, prison, school, and mosque. Spend the afternoon at the pool-like hot spring, then visit the lush Dakhla farms and enjoy a sunset over the Great Sand Sea with Bedouin tea.

Spend the night at Desert Lodge Hotel in [Dakhla](#), overlooking the green village and the famous rose-colored mountains.

Day 6 : Kharga Oasis

Today, you'll visit Kharga Oasis. After breakfast, start your tour at Dakhla Oasis with a visit to Qasr El Labkha, a Roman fortress on the ancient caravan route known as the Forty Days Road linking Egypt to Sudan. Next, explore the Kharga Museum, the Roman Temple of Hibis, Nadura, and Bagawat, the world's oldest Christian cemetery with its chapels featuring well-preserved biblical murals.

Then, head to Baris Oasis, the smallest oasis in [the Western Desert](#). Visit the Temple of Dush, a well-preserved Roman settlement with mud-brick houses, a fortress, and a temple dedicated to Isis and Serapis.

Enjoy camping amid the golden sand dunes of Kharga.

Day 7: Kharga \ Luxor (East Bank)

Have breakfast amidst the golden sand dunes, then take an air-conditioned vehicle to Luxor, a 6-hour drive. Upon arrival, board your 5-star Nile River cruise.

Enjoy lunch on the cruise, then start your [Luxor Day tours](#), focusing on the East Bank. Visit the massive Karnak Temple and the famous [Luxor Temple](#), built by various ancient Egyptian kings.

Enjoy dinner on board and stay overnight in Luxor.

Day 8: Luxor West Bank

Enjoy breakfast on the Nile River cruise with a view of the river. Start your West Bank tour in Luxor by visiting the [Colossi of Memnon](#), then explore the Valley of the Kings, where 62 pharaohs, including Tutankhamun and Ramses II, were buried in tombs adorned with stunning paintings and treasures. Don't miss the Temple of Hatshepsut, Egypt's first female pharaoh.

Have lunch on the cruise as it sails to Edfu. Enjoy a relaxed dinner on board.

Stay overnight on the Nile cruise.

Day 9: Edfu / Kom Ombo

In the early morning, enjoy breakfast on the Nile cruise. Visit the [Edfu Temple](#), dedicated to Horus, the falcon-headed sky god. Then sail to [Kom Ombo](#) to see the unique temple dedicated to Sobek, the crocodile god. Have lunch on board and continue sailing to Aswan.

Enjoy dinner in the evening and stay overnight on the Nile cruise.

Day 10: Aswan Sightseeing

Enjoy your delicious breakfast on the Nile cruise before starting your Aswan day tour. Visit the impressive [High Dam](#), a remarkable engineering feat, followed by the beautiful Temple of Philae dedicated to the goddess Isis, accessible via a scenic motorboat ride. Then, explore the granite quarries to see the Unfinished Obelisk, the largest known obelisk.

Enjoy dinner on board the Nile cruise and spend the night in Aswan.

Day 11: Disembarkation / Cairo

After breakfast, check out from your Nile River Cruise. You have free time in Aswan or can opt for an optional tour of Abu Simbel. Later, you'll be transferred to the Aswan railway station to catch the Sleeping Train to Cairo. Dinner will be served on the train.
