Itinerary

Day 1: Embarkation and tour to Abu Simbel Temples

Your Cairo Top Tours tour leader will greet and assist you upon arrival. You will be transferred in a modern air-conditioned vehicle to board the stunning Mövenpick Prince Abbas Nile Cruise on the magnificent 4-day Lake Nasser cruise from Abu Simbel to Aswan.

Have your delicious lunch on board this beautiful Nile Cruise. It's time for your first excursion with an exceptional visit to the ancient and majestic temples of Abu Simbel. Built by order of [King Ramses II](#) of the 19th Dynasty, these magnificent rock temples are the second most famous ancient monuments in Egypt after the famous [Pyramids of Giza](#). Twice a year, on February 21 and October, in an astronomical phoenix act, you'll see the magic when the sun passes through the temple at dawn to illuminate the statues of the gods.

After visiting the Abu Simbel temples, you will return to the Nile Cruise for afternoon tea. You will also have the opportunity to attend the extraordinary [sound and light show at Philae Temple](#) (additional ticket required).

Complete your day with dinner on board and spend a wonderful night in your cabin in Abu Simbel.

Meals included: Lunch and dinner

Day 2: Tour to Kasr Ibrim, Amada Temple, Derr Temple, and Wadi El Seboua

Breakfast will be served on board the Mövenpick Prince Abbas cruise on Lake Nasser, and you will be ready to start sailing towards Ibrahim Palace. Your cruise will stop for approximately 15 minutes giving you time to take some photos of the site from the deck.

After a short stop near Ibrim Palace, you will be transferred to visit three archaeological sites, the [Temple of Amada](#), which is the oldest temple in Nubia, the Deir Temple, which was built during the [nineteenth Dynasty](#) by Ramses II, and the tomb of Pinot, who was responsible for managing the property of Horus Temp. You will be amazed by these three sites, and visiting them will be an unforgettable experience that you will remember for the rest of your life.

You will return to the cruise again, and the cruise will begin to sail towards Wadi Al Saboua or Wadi Al Aswad, where a delicious lunch will be served along the way, followed by afternoon tea shortly afterward.

In the evening, you'll be treated to a small cocktail reception, then it's time to sit down for another delicious dinner, followed by a very enjoyable Nubian show. You will spend the night on board the ship in Wadi El Seboua.

Day 3: Wadi El Seboua Excursion and sailing to Aswan

Your breakfast buffet starts early in the morning, then the Nile cruise docks and your professional guide accompanies you to visit the [Temples of Wadi El Seboua](#), which was dedicated to the god Amun and built by [Ramses II](#). The temple is also known as the Valley of the Lions. Like most of the Nubian buildings along the shores of Lake Nasser, the temples were dismantled and relocated to higher ground when the water level of Lake Nasser began to rise after the construction of the Aswan High Dam.

Upon completion of the temple visit, you will be transferred back to the Prince Abbas cruise on Lake Nasser where the cruise will begin sailing towards Aswan. Spend the remaining time of the day as you wish. Your lunch will be served and you will enjoy afternoon tea. Have your dinner on board and you will spend your night on board the boat in Aswan.

Meals included: Breakfast, lunch and dinner

Day 4: Sightseeing Tour and Disembarkation at Aswan

Enjoy a hearty breakfast during your Egypt tours and get ready to visit the wonderful day tours in Egypt and [sightseeing in Aswan](#), where our Egyptologist guide will accompany you to explore the Temple of Kalabsha, which dates back to the Greco-Roman era. This ancient temple was never finished, but in any case, it is still considered one of the finest examples of Egyptian architecture in Nubia.

It is also the second largest ancient structure that was moved to higher ground in order to preserve it from the rising waters of Lake Nasser, which was the result of the construction of the [the High Dam](#) across the Nile between 1958 and 1970. This great temple contains a wealth of magnificent decorations and artwork, and your private tour guide will explain to you the significance of these objects.

After visiting these amazing sites during your [Aswan day tours](#), your Cairo Top Tours representative will transfer you to the airport or to the railway station as per your request after we finish most of the classic Egypt tours.
