Day 1: Arrival Cairo

You are welcome in Egypt

Once your flight arrives, the Cairo Top Tours representative will be waiting for you in your terminal at [Cairo International Airport](#) with a sign with your name on it. He will accompany you to your hotel in Giza in a private, air-conditioned vehicle. When you arrive at the hotel, you can settle into your room after our representative assists you with a smooth check-in.

Day 2: Pyramids – Cairo

After your breakfast, an Egyptology guide from [Cairo Top Tours](#) will meet you early in the morning at a prearranged time to begin your tour of the Great Pyramids. Here you can see one of the seven wonders of the ancient world, the huge pyramid of King Khufu, as well as the pyramids of King Chephren and Mycrinus.

The Pyramids of Giza are known for their enormous size and amazing degree of preservation. On a day tour of Egypt, explore the 4th dynasty of the ancient kingdom, where these antiquated buildings were constructed. You'll see [The Great Sphinx Of Giza Facts](#), a rock carving with the head of a pharaoh and the body of a lion. You will have the opportunity to visit the Valley of the Temples of Khafre, which was built after Khufus as his successor. His younger brother and Pyramid-era successor to King Djedefre, King Chephren, built this temple to aid mummification in Egypt.

We will enjoy a delicious Egyptian lunch and then continue to visit the [The Egyptian Museum In Cairo](#) in Tahrir Square in the heart of Cairo. The museum houses a variety of Egyptian monuments from around the world, dating back 6,000 years.

If you have time, you can also incorporate a trip to Coptic Cairo into your itinerary. Visit [The Hanging Church](#), one of the oldest Jewish monuments in the country, the Church of Saints Sergius and Bacchus, and the Roman fortress of Babylon. Before returning to your hotel, you can also check out the Ben Ezra Synagogue and the Bazaar of [Khan El Khalili](#), one of the oldest bazaars in the Middle East.

Day 3: Cairo - Luxor Nile Cruise

Check out of your hotel in the morning and transfer to [Cairo International Airport](#) to catch a flight to Luxor. There you will be met and supported, then boarded in an air-conditioned vehicle for your 5-star Egyptian Nile River cruise and checked in. After lunch on board, enjoy visiting to the impressive [Karnak Temple](#) |

[The Largest Egyptian Temple](#) and Luxor temples.

Overnight stay on board the Nile cruise.

Day 4: Luxor West Bank

After breakfast on the Nile cruise, take an excursion to the Royal Tomb of the 62 Pharaohs in the [Valley Of The Kings](#) and visit Hatshepsut's Mortuary Temple, built by the architects of New Kingdom pharaoh Hatshepsut around the 15th century BC. Masu. Head to the [Colossi Of Memnon](#). After lunch, sail to Edfu and enjoy a leisurely dinner on board.

Overnight cruise on the Nile.

Day 5: Edfu - Kom Ombo

After breakfast on the Nile cruise, visit the well-preserved Ptolemaic temple dedicated to [Edfu | The Temple Of Horus](#). Sail to [Kom Ombo Temple | Temple Of Sobek And Horus](#) to visit the unique Sobek Temple, dedicated to Sobek, the crocodile god, and Horus, the falcon-headed god. Lunch on board. Continue to Aswan. Dinner and

Day 6: Aswan Sightseeing

After breakfast on board the Nile Cruiser, enjoy sightseeing in Aswan for a day. Start with the largest known ancient obelisk, located in the northern region of ancient Egypt's quarries, the [Unfinished Obelisk In Aswan](#), then on to the beautiful [Philae Temple | Temple Of Isis](#), dedicated to the goddesses Isis and Hathor. Dinner and

Disembark from your Nile cruise after breakfast, then travel to Aswan Airport and return to Cairo where you will be met and assisted at [Cairo International Airport](#) before being transferred to your hotel.

Day 8: Cairo - Fly to Amman

After breakfast, you will transfer to Cairo International Airport to catch your flight to Amman. Upon arrival at Queen Alia Airport, our representatives will meet you and assist you with customs and immigration procedures. Transfer to Amman hotel and stay overnight.

Day 9: Jerash, Ajloun and Umm Qais Tour

In the morning, we drive two hours from Amman to Gadara (Umm Qais), which used to belong to the famous Decapolis, a confederation of 10 cities, founded by Alexander the Great. Here you have a wonderful view of the northern Jordan Valley, the Golan Heights, and the Lake of Galilee. We head to Jerash, located in the foothills of Mount Gilead, an ancient city reminiscent of the Roman Empire.

As one of the largest and best-preserved sites of Roman architecture outside of Italy, its splendor can be seen in the colonnaded streets, the Nymphaeum, and the Temple of Artemis. The next stop is Ajloun, the large 12th-century Islamic castle built around 1184/85 by the famous Islamic leader Salah al-Din. Back to Amman and overnight.

Day 10: Dead Sea in Jordan

After breakfast, head to Mount Nebo, the place where the Prophet Moses looked at the Promised Land before his death and his alleged burial place. You visit the ancient monastery and overlook the Jordan Valley, the Dead Sea, Jericho and Jerusalem. After that, we move to Madaba, where we find the famous mosaic map of Palestine dating back to the sixth century in the Church of St. George.

Then head to the Dead Sea. Located at the lowest point on earth and rich in various minerals with medicinal properties, this place has developed into a health spa-like hotspot. The mineral concentration in the mud is used for therapeutic and cosmetic purposes. It is said that Queen Cleopatra and Sheba both knew the value of this ruin and used it. It is called the Dead Sea because the salt concentration is too high for life to exist in this water, and it is easy to float on it. Get ready to swim and relax in the mud before returning to Amman.

Overnight at the hotel in Amman.

Day 11: Petra Tour

After eating breakfast, we will drive for a while to get to Petra, which is a very famous and beautiful place in Jordan. The city was built a very long time ago by a group of people called the Nabataean Arabs. The buildings there are carved into the mountains and look wonderful. When we arrive, we will walk through a colorful gorge that is very tall and impressive.

When you walk out of the narrow canyon, you see the amazing beauty of Petra, which is considered one of the most amazing places in the world. After exploring Petra, you walk back through the canyon before going back to Amman.

Day 12: Final Departure

After breakfast, your tour leader will meet you at the lobby of the hotel to transfer you to Queen Alia Airport for final departure.
