Itinéraire

Day 1 : Arrival to Cairo airport

Our agent will meet you at <u>Cairo International Airport</u> with a sign bearing your name and the Cairo Top Tours logo. From the airport, a chic vehicle will transport you to the Cairo hotel. After helping you quickly check into the hotel, the Cairo Top Tours representative will meet with you to go over your itinerary and give you all of the pick-up times for your excursions in Cairo while you are on holiday in Egypt. On the first day of the family vacations, Cairo at dusk

There is a warm drink at your disposal.

Day2- Tour to Giza Pyramids, , Dahshour

After breakfast, you will be picked up by our tour guide and driven to the magnificent<u>Giza pyramids</u>. In addition to admiring the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, one of the Seven Wonders of the World, you can go out on an expedition and explore it while you're there. <u>The great Sphinx</u> that watches above the Pyramids will then materialize. Then we switch buses and head to the Dahshour pyramids. Visit the Red and Bent Pyramids at Dahshour, which were constructed by King Sinfru, Cheops' father. Discover the errors that the Egyptians made when constructing the pyramids.

After that, eat lunch nearby before returning to your accommodation.

Day3 - Tour To National Museum Of Egyptian Civilization & Sultan Hassan mosque

To get your day off to a good start, we will pick you up from your hotel and have our tour guide wait for you in an air-conditioned automobile. <u>The National Museum of Egyptian Civilization</u> (NEMC) will be your next destination. It is acknowledged as being the first museum in the world to provide a thorough portrait of the Egyptian Civilization throughout its history, from prehistory to the present.

The NMEC features a range of artefacts on display to give visitors a flavor of Egyptian civilization over the ages, beginning with predynastic and ancient Egypt.

We'll proceed to Citadel Square after that. We'll go to the Sultan Hassan Mosque, a stunning Mamluk structure built in 1359. Similar to how the El-Rifai mosque (1912), with its distinctive architecture and magnificent prayer hall decorations, and Sultan Hassan mosque are symbols of old Islamic Egypt, the Giza pyramids are a representation of ancient pharaonic Egypt.

At the end of the day, a driver will drive you back to your hotel!

Day4-Boarding

Before you transfer to the Nile Cruise at 10 a.m., our local representatives will meet you and assist you at the Luxor airport. board before lunch. served aboard for lunch. Go to the Karnak Temple and the Luxor Temple. visit the Luxor Temple to see the Ramses the Great statues in the courtyard.

Take a carriage or bus to Karnak, which contains a multitude of temples built at various points in time. Start with the Avenue of Sphinxes and visit the Unfinished Propylon, the Hypostyle Hall with its 134 huge columns, the Obelisks of Queen Hatshepsut and Tutomosis III, the Temple of Amon with its papyrus and lotus decorations, the Granite Scarbeus of Amenophis III, and the Sacred Lake. Sunday coffee. Dinner on board and a performance of belly dancing. Luxor spends the night at sea.

Day5-The West Bank Sail to Esna.

Breakfast on board, then tours The West Bank is home to <u>the Valley of the Kings</u>, the Colossi of Memnon, and <u>the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut</u> in El Deir El Bahari. visit to the Valley of Kings; see Deir El Bahari's temple and the tombs of many kings.

On the way back, pause at the Colossi of Memnon, two gigantic statues of Amenophis III that are seated and facing the Nile.

Visit the Queen Hatshepsut Mortuary Temple following that. Hatshepsut, a pharaoh of the Eighteenth Dynasty who died in 1458 BC, had the temple at Deir el-Bahari on the west bank of the Nile near the Valley of the Kings constructed for her. served aboard for lunch. Travel to Esna. Afternoon tea and disco night. A Boating Trip at Night

Day6- Edfu. Sail to Kom Ombo

A lunch is given on board Horus Temple. Go to the Horus Temple in Edfu. The most well-known building in Tell Edfu is the Temple of Horus, which is dedicated to the god Horus of Behedet, lord of Edfu. Due to its completion and state of preservation, it stands out among Ptolemaic temple structures in Egypt. The edfu temple is oriented from south to north and is approximately 140m long and 7000m2 in size.

served aboard for lunch. Visit the Kom Ombo temple that is shared by the gods Sobek and Haroeris. the Temple of Kom Ombo. Two identical entrances, halls in the hypostyle style, and sanctuaries can be found in <u>the temple of Kom Ombo</u>, which is dedicated to Sobek and Horus the Elder. The symmetry of the temple's structure honors the purported friendship between the two deities. afternoon tea. Having dinner at sea and celebrating Galabya In Kom Ombo, spend the night at sea.

Day7- Sail to Aswan arrival Aswan

breakfast on board, travel to Aswan, and arrival there <u>The High Dam</u> in Aswan is a must-see. The northern border between Egypt and Sudan is marked by the dam known as High Dam, which is made of rock fill. The dam is fueled by the River Nile, and Lake Nasser is formed by the reservoir. Construction on the project began in 1960 and was completed in 1968. In 1971, it was properly inaugurated.

Near Aswan (Assuan), Egypt, in the northern area of the ancient Egyptian stone quarries, stands <u>The</u> <u>Unfinished Obelisk</u>, the largest ancient obelisk known to survive. Archaeologists assert that a female pharaoh named Hatshepsut authorized its construction. Modern engineers don't believe the Dynastic Egyptians could have accomplished this, though.

The Isis-dedicated <u>Temple of Philae</u> was relocated by UNESCO because its original position was in jeopardy due to the construction of the Aswan Dam, and it now stands in a breathtaking environment that was meticulously rebuilt. served aboard for lunch. Sailing the Nile via felucca, pass Kitchener's Island and the Agha Khan Mausoleum. afternoon tea. served onboard the ship. Spend the night at Aswan.

Day8- Disembarkation

a meal served on board. Disembarkation and transportation to the airport in Aswan

Day9-Day use in Fayoum

Cairo Top Tours provides knowledgeable tour guides to Fayoum, where visitors can explore the pyramids of Lahoun and Hawara. Lahoun is a 48-meter-long granite-core pyramid, while Hawara is a limestone-coated brick pyramid. The Kom Oshim Museum in Fayoum houses notable archaeological relics, sculptures, and artefacts, including mummy portraits from the Ptolemaic colony of Karanis. Visitors can also enjoy guided tours.

You'll then savour a delectable supper in an Asian restaurant.

After that, sail down the vast Nile River in a felucca.

After that, we will end our service and drive you to the drop-off point.

Day 10 : From Cairo to Bahariya Oasis / White Desert

The tour guide picks you up from your Cairo hotel and takes you 350 km south-west to <u>the Bahariya</u> <u>Oasis</u>. After lunch, you visit Al-Marsous Mountain, a famous volcanic crater in the Black Desert. You then visit <u>Crystal Mountain</u> and the Valley of Agabat's Cold Sulfur Water Well. In the Great Sand Sea, you can surf the 140-meter-high dunes. <u>The White Desert</u> National Park is a popular desert destination with unique rock formations. You return to the Al Haiz campground for an overnight stay.

Day11 - Bahariya Oasis / Cairo

After breakfast at the camping, visit Siwa hot sulphur springs. Take a shower in a hotel, then eat lunch at the Bahariya oasis before returning to Cairo around 5:00 p.m. breakfast and lunch

Day 12- Cairo to Sokhna

Cairo Top Tours offers a day trip to <u>El Ain El Sokhna</u>, a city located two hours from Cairo. The tour guide will assist you in checking into a hotel, and you can enjoy swimming, relaxing at an Egyptian beach resort, and enjoying the serene surroundings. This trip is suitable for all ages and groups, with lunch provided on the sand.

Day13- Snorkeling Trip

You'll be picked up by our tour guide to begin our journey after breakfast.

You will begin by going snorkelling at El Ain El Sokhna. You'll travel by boat to the Red Sea where you may go snorkelling and take in the breathtaking underwater scenery of the coral reefs.
