Itinéraire

Day 1: Your Arrival To The Capital of Egypt

At <u>the Cairo International Airport</u>, our tour guide will meet you and drive you in a private vehicle to your hotel so you can rest and eat a nice lunch before beginning your next day with renewed vigor.

Day 2: Day Tour to Pyramids and The pyramids of Dahshur

The journey begins with a warm meal at <u>Giza's Great Pyramids</u>, where you'll see the Sphinx, a carved statue of a human head and lion body. Lunch is followed by a visit to <u>Dahshur</u>, a village built during Pharaoh Sneferu's reign. The Bent Pyramid, a departure from traditional pyramid design, is also a highlight. The journey concludes with dinner and overnight stay in a private car.

Day 3: Museum of Civilization and El Refaai Mosque Visit

You will prepare for our upcoming journey after waking up and eating breakfast.

The main exhibition hall of <u>the National Museum of Civilization</u> displays the accomplishments of the Egyptian civilization from ancient times to the present, as well as traditional culture and popular heritage. An integrated picture of the development of Egyptian culture is provided by this thorough exhibit.

After that, you'll eat lunch in a casual eatery close by.

And we'll continue our journey by going to the Sultan Hassan El Refaai Mosque. The structure included a mosque, a school for the four schools of thought—"Shafi'i, Hanafi, Maliki, and Hanbali"—as well as two libraries for calligraphy instruction and the sciences of Qur'anic interpretation. The Prophet Muhammad's hadith and the seven readings were also taught there.

Then you will back to the hotel to have your dinner and stay there.

Day 4: Visiting The City of Luxor

After breakfast, you'll get ready to go to Luxor, relax up, and check into a hotel.

The 200-acre <u>Karnak Temple</u>, which includes <u>the Temple of Amun-Ra</u>, other temples, and a mud brick wall with eight gates that was constructed by a king of the Thirty-first Dynasty, is the greatest deity-honored monument in the entire globe.

You will then proceed to the Great Temple of Luxor after this. It was constructed under the rule of the monarchs of the Eighteenth and Nineteenth Dynasties. Amenhotep III and Ramesses II constructed the most significant structures in the temple.

After that, you'll return to the hotel for lunch before taking in Luxor at night.

Day 5: Day Tour to Luxor Attractions

This tour takes you to the Valleys of Kings and Queens, two famous attractions in Luxor. The Valley of Kings features underground tombs with an entrance and corridor, while the Valley of Queens is located near the Valley of Kings. The tour then takes you to el-Deir el-Bahari, a burial site with tombs and three temples. The Colossi of Memnon, a northern statue famous for emitting a strange sound, is also visited. The tour concludes with a rest at the hotel.

Day 6: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples Visiting

The tour concludes in Luxor with a visit to <u>Edfu's temple</u>, where the Osiris myth tells the story of Horus and Set's conflict, featuring Hor Bhaddati.

Visit<u>the Komombo Temple</u>, which has a collection of historical scenes, the goddess Maat, ancient Egyptian implements, and Egyptian holidays. It also has a collection of medical items.

Day 7: Aswan Attractions

After breakfast, you'll travel to Aswan to see the High Dam, which began construction in 1960. The dam diverted river water to the diversion channel and tunnels, closing the Nile course and starting water storage. The obelisk, believed to be carved during Queen Hatshepsut's reign, is also a popular attraction. The tour ends with a Nile sailboat ride to the Nubian Village, where you'll live in styled Nubian houses with beautiful views and hospitality. You'll return to your Luxor hotel.

Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner are planned in our program.

Day 8: Return To Cairo

After checking out of the hotel, you'll take one of our ready-made cars to the airport to catch your flight back to Cairo International Airport, where you can relax and get some rest before we embark on our next adventure the following day.

Day 9: Fayum Day Tour

You will begin your day in Egypt with a delicious Egyptian breakfast, and your tour guide will be with you the entire time.

Upon arrival in Cairo, you'll be transported to <u>Fayoum</u>, the capital of the Fayoum Governorate. The city is divided into residential neighborhoods and is home to <u>the Lake of Qarun</u>, one of Egypt's largest natural lakes. Discover its history and explore its unique features.

You take a break so that you can have your lunch and resume traveling.

The Wadi El Rayan Reserve, which is found in the southwest of the Fayoum Governorate, will thereafter be your destination, according to the tour guide. Wadi El Rayan is made up of the Jabal al Rayan area, which is the region around the eyes, the higher lake, the lower lake, the waterfalls area that connects the two lakes, the Uyun al Rayyan area south of the lower lake, and the Wadi El Rayan area.

You finished your tour as your driver drove you back to your hotel in Cairo.

Day 10: Day Tour to Bahariya Oasis and The White Desert

After eating breakfast at the hotel, you will go to <u>Bahariya Oasis</u> in our own air-conditioned automobile. In 1912, a dinosaur skeleton was discovered in Bahariya Oasis and is now on display in Germany's Munich Museum. The majority of the dinosaur's pieces, however, were lost when the museum was destroyed during World War II. There are still some of the images that the German geologist "Strummer" took and drew. Following that, he discovered several of its remains in Marrakesh, Algeria, and Niger; however, it is known as the Egyptian dinosaur.

Lavender Desert It is known as <u>the White Desert</u> because of the snow-white chalk that makes up its floor and the chalk columns and mushrooms that were created as a result of wind-sculpting processes, giving the area a rare geological status. According to the International Union for Conservation of Nature's categorization, it is categorized as a national park reserve.

Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner all are prepared during the program.

Day 11: Get Back to Cairo

After spending a long, wonderful, easy night in the outdoors, you'll return to Cairo, take a beautiful warm shower, and then spend the rest of the day as you choose at the hotel or in your room.

Day 12: Travel To El-Ain El-Sokhna

You will prepare to travel to <u>El-Ain El-Sokhna</u> in our private, comfy automobile after eating breakfast. Several hours later, we will check into <u>the Stella Di Mare</u> hotel or Similar and give you some free time to use as you choose.

Day 13: Snorkeling in El-Ain El-Sokhna

After finishing your supper at the elegant Stella di Mare hotel, you'll get ready to go snorkeling in <u>the</u> <u>Red Sea</u> from a boat. Once you've had an enjoyable time in the warm water, you'll return to the hotel for lunch and to stay the night.

Day 14: Back Again to Cairo
