Itinéraire

Day 1: Get to Cairo and register

At Cairo International Airport, a representative from Cairo Top Tours will meet you and help ensure a seamless check-in and departure. It will be a cozy, air-conditioned car that drives you to your accommodation. Once at the hotel, your tour guide will confirm all pick-up times for your Egypt travel packages and go over your itinerary for the Red Sea, Nile Cruise, and Cairo tour. They'll assist you with a quick check-in procedure as well.

Your first evening is yours to do as you like, or you can reserve a tour to see the Sound and Light Show at the Giza Pyramids.

Stay the night in a Cairo hotel.

Have a welcome drink.

Day 2: Tour of Sakkara and the Giza Pyramids and Sphinx

An agent from Cairo Top Tours will greet you at Cairo International Airport with a sign bearing your name on it. After that, they will drive you in a private, air-conditioned car to your hotel. They will assist you with a speedy and seamless check-in upon your arrival.

You can choose to attend Giza Sound and Light Show in place of relaxing on your first evening, should that be your preference. Start the first day with breakfast at the hotel and then meet with your personal Egyptologist from Cairo Top Tours. The Great Pyramid of King Cheops and his successors, Chephren and Mycerinus, will be easily understood by you thanks to their guidance throughout the Giza tours. And if you decide to go on an optional camel ride to the Giza Pyramids location, they will assist you in taking the most memorable pictures of the attractions. The renowned Sphinx, which has been watching over the necropolis

for more than 4500 years, will then be shown to you.

After learning about the building of the pyramids, you can go on to the Valley Temple of King Chephren to discover more about the profound secrets of ancient Egyptian mummification. Every pyramid complex in the past had three main components: a valley temple, a mortuary temple, and a burial tomb (which was the actual pyramid). The only monument at the location that is largely preserved is the King Khafre pyramid complex. The pharaoh's pre-burial rites took place at the valley temple.

The Giza Pyramids trip includes a panoramic expedition that provides visitors with an overview of all the pyramids in Giza and the opportunity to take mementos that will last a lifetime.

The alabaster sphinx statue of Ramses II is on display at the outdoor museum located where Memphis, the pharaonic capital of the New Kingdom or the Age of the Pyramids, once stood.

You will visit Saqqara, one of Egypt's most important locations for antiques and discoveries, following a delectable lunch. The Step Pyramid Complex and the Pyramid of King Djoser, the world's first structure entirely composed of six stone bases stacked on top of one another, may be seen at Saqqara. Additionally, you will be able to visit the Teti Pyramid and one of the Nobles' tombs, like the Kagemni tomb.

Arriving at your hotel will mark the conclusion of your day.

Spend the night in a Cairo hotel.

Day 3: Sightseeing excursion of Cairo

With the help of your personal tour guide, you may continue with your Egypt Tours Packages after savoring the breakfast buffet at your Cairo hotel. The Egyptian Museum, spanning two levels, houses the world's largest collection of Egyptian artifacts. This will be your first trip. You will also get to witness King Tutankhamen's amazing royal riches, which were found undamaged. Royal mummies, enormous statues, royal golden goods, and exquisitely crafted accessories belonging to the Egyptian queens are among the treasures housed in the Egyptian Museum.

After seeing the Egyptian Museum, you should definitely check out Coptic Cairo. This includes a trip to the church of Abu Serga, where you can see the crypt that held the holy family for around three months during a time of persecution, and the Hanging Church, which is built over the towers of the old Roman fortress known as Babylon. On your tour of Coptic Cairo, you will also see the Ben Ezra Synagogue, which is said by Jews to be the place where the Pharaoh's daughter found the basket in the Nile that contained the newborn Moses.

You will be taken to the Citadel of Saladin by your own driver and guide following your midday meal at a local eatery. One of the highlights of all our trips to Cairo is the Alabaster Mosque, which offers an amazing view of the ancient mosques, domes, and minarets that comprise Islamic Cairo. Designed with an eye toward Turkish architecture, Mohamed Ali built the mosque in 1805.

After that, you'll be taken to your Islamic Cairo tours, where you may visit the Fatimid Cairo's walls, gates, and narrow streets. You will also have a unique shopping experience at Cairo's Khan El Khalili Bazaar.

Day 4: Cairo to Aswan and Myfair Nile cruise embarkation

The tour guide from Cairo Top Tours will take you to the airport after your hotel buffet breakfast so you can catch your flight to Luxor or Aswan, depending on the program's arrangement.

Our representative will meet you at the airport in Aswan, transport you to start your Egypt Nile Cruise Tours before lunch, and end the tour. A tour guide will meet you in the lobby later in the day and take you on a fun Felucca boat ride around Agha Khan Mausoleum and Kitchener's Island. On the Nile Cruise, there will be afternoon tea served, a delectable meal, and a charming Nubian folkloric display.

Above the Nile River in Aswan, you will spend the night.

Day 5: Kom Ombo/Aswan Tours

The High Dam, which was constructed under the administration of the late president Nasser, will be the first destination. The revolution against Ottoman King Farouk was spearheaded by this figurehead. The Unfinished Obelisk at the granite quarries will then be visible to tourists. During Queen Hatshepsut's reign, this obelisk was constructed in honor of the sun deity Amun Ra. We will also visit the Temple of Philae to study the legend of Osiris and Isis. This temple in Egypt was repurposed into a Coptic church during the Roman Empire. Following that, guests will be returned to the Nile Cruise and directed to sail in the direction of Kom Ombo. Visitors can savor their lunch buffet while boating. When guests arrive to Kom Ombo, Before sailing to Edfu, guests will visit the Temple of Kom Ombo. Along the journey, visitors will enjoy the lovely views and afternoon tea. There will be a fantastic supper served onboard, along with a captain's welcome cocktail for semi-casual dress. There will be entertainment in the form of discotheque music after dinner.

Day 6: Visit Edfu Temple for sightseeing

After enjoying a delicious breakfast on the MS Mayfair Nile cruise, you will ride in a horse-drawn carriage to the Temple of Edfu. The Ptolemaic Era saw the construction of this temple, which honors Horus, the son of Osiris and Isis. It has some Greek characters mixed in with traditional Egyptian components. You can have lunch on board and afternoon tea on the upper deck while sailing to Luxor. Additionally, dinner will be given on the boat, and all groups will participate in an Egyptian Galabya celebration organized by the tour guides. We humbly request your participation.

Day 7: Visit to Hurghada from Luxor's East and West Bank

Once you've had your last open buffet breakfast on the MS Mayfair Nile cruise, get off the ship and start your amazing tour of the west bank of Luxor. You will get to see the Valley of the Kings, a royal necropolis that is home to the tombs of queens and other aristocrats from the 18th, 19th, and 20th dynasties, as well as pharaohs like Tutankhamen and Ramses II. You will also be in awe of the Colossi of Memnon, which were formerly a part of a temple dedicated to mortuaries in Thebes (now Luxor). Despite the destruction of the temple, the Amenhotep III statue remains a remarkable work of art. Visit the El Deir El Bahari temple lastly.

Continue your East Bank tour of Luxor by seeing the temple of Luxor and the Karnak temple complex, which is regarded as the world's largest ancient religious site. After the excursion, you'll spend about three hours being driven to Hurghada in a contemporary air-conditioned car. You will be transferred to the Marriott Hurghada resort for an overnight stay upon your arrival.
