Plongez dans les merveilles antiques de Louxor, qui compte un nombre impressionnant de monuments représentant près d'un tiers des sites historiques du monde. Grâce à nos [excursions d'une journée en Égypte](#), vous pourrez découvrir les temples enchanteurs de Kom Ombo et d'Edfou, qui offrent chacun un aperçu unique du passé historique du pays. Enfin, embarquez pour des excursions captivantes à Assouan, où vous aurez l'occasion de visiter de magnifiques temples et sites antiques, ainsi que d'explorer les tombes royales nichées dans la Vallée des Rois.

Day 1: Arrival Cairo \ first day of your Egypt 7 Day Itinerary

Your Cairo Top Tours tour guide will meet you at the Cairo International Airport once your flight lands and will be holding a signboard with your name on it to start your tours of Egypt. He will go over the details of your Egypt 7 Day Itinerary with you.

Start your wonderful Cairo day tours by being taken to [the Step Pyramid](#) of King Djoser in [Saqqara](#), which is the oldest building in the world made entirely of stone mastabas or steps stacked on top of one another. The step pyramid was constructed by the renowned architect and vizier of the Pharaoh named Imhotep, and Saqqara is located about 27 kilometers southwest of Cairo. It is one of the most significant archaeological sites in Egypt where you can see the Mastaba tombs of the Nobles and trace the evolution of the burial tombs throughout history.

Have your nice lunch in a beautiful restaurant, then you will transfer to the ancient capital of Egypt's [old kingdom](#) which is known as [Memphis City](#), where you are going to see the huge statue of [Ramses II](#) and the great [Alabaster Sphinx](#) which is the second biggest sphinx after the Great Sphinx in Giza, this city was established by [King Menes](#) who united the two kingdoms of the north and the south and generated the dynastic history of the Pharaohs nearby 5100 years ago.

You will be transferred to your hotel for check-in.

Overnight in Cairo hotel.

Meals: Lunch

Day 02: Cairo Sightseeing Tour

Have your breakfast in the morning, which is included, and you will be accompanied to see the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon. It was built around the year 30 BC, with the arrival of the emperor Augustus in [Egypt](#). You will visit [the Hanging Church](#), which is built during the third century, and the church of St Sergius, where the holy family stayed before. Towards the end of [the Coptic Cairo Tour](#), you will visit Ben Ezra Synagogue, which is the oldest one in the whole area.

Passing by the Coptic district of Cairo visit [the Egyptian Museum](#), which includes the world's greatest antiquities from the Predynastic to the Greco-Roman era. Enjoy your delicious lunch before we

move on to [the Saladin Citadel](#). There, we will visit the mosque of Mohamed Ali and take in views of both contemporary structures like the Cairo Tower and the Television Building as well as the Islamic Cairo as a whole. We will take you to Islamic Cairo to spend the time shopping in the old and unique market of Khan El Khalili.

Lastly, you will be transferred back to the hotel and overnight in Cairo.

Day 3: Cairo to Luxor

After leaving your hotel in Cairo, your Egypt travel packages will continue. You will be escorted to the Cairo airport today to catch your flight to Luxor by your personal driver and guide. Once you reach Luxor, your day tour will begin with a stop at the West Bank of Luxor, where you can admire the colorful ancient tombs in the Valley of the Kings. Your tour guide and driver will then take you to the [Temple of Queen Hatshepsut](#), which is a royal cemetery located on the western mainland of the Nile, facing the current city of Luxor, and includes the mummies and funeral equipment of more than fifty high-ranking Pharaonic.

The last stop during your Luxor day tours to the west bank of Luxor will be at the [Colossi of Memnon](#). Enjoy your lunch in a Nile view restaurant and continue your tour to the East Bank of Luxor where you visit the Karnak and Luxor Temple.

Spend your night in Luxor.

Day 4: Edfu and Kom Ombo Tour

You will be treated to a delectable breakfast in the hotel's main restaurant before going on a tour of the Edfu Temple, which dates back to the worship of the ancient Egyptian [god Horus](#) and is regarded as one of the country's most secure cult sites.

Then, as you take in the sight of the magnificent river and its two green banks winding through the desert, your driver will take you north to another amazing town. On the way, you'll stop to see the historical Temple of Kom Ombo, which is shared by the falcon-headed Horus and the crocodile-headed [Sobek](#), the god of fertility and the creator of the world. The temple has a double entrance.

Our representative will accompany you to your hotel in Aswan.

Day 05: Aswan Tour

After your delicious breakfast, your certified tour guide from Cairo Top Tours will take you to start your Aswan sightseeing tours. You will first see the incredible structure known as a [High Dam](#), which was built to

regulate the river's flow. The Dam also serves as a source of electricity. It retains water during floods to benefit irrigated land to the fullest. as well as [the Philae Temple](#), which houses the Temple of Isis, which is one of Egypt's largest temples and takes up about a quarter of the island.

You will be transferred back to the hotel after the trip.

Overnight in Aswan

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 6: Back to Cairo

Your tour guide will accompany you to the Aswan Airport to catch your flight back to Cairo after breakfast is served at the hotel. As the Pharaohs believed there was life after death, they built the Pyramids to spiritually escort the dead pharaohs into the afterlife and they also built the Sphinx to protect the deceased kings. Meet your personal tour guide at the Cairo Airport to begin your Cairo Day Trips by the tour to Giza pyramids of Cheops (the Greatest Pyramid 4500 years old), [Chephren](#) (the Second Pyramid built 20 Years Later), and the Third Pyramid of Mycerinus. Therefore, we will take you to [the Valley Temple](#), which was constructed from a combination of limestone, granite, and alabaster, near the end of your tour of the Giza pyramids.

After the tour, you will be transferred to your hotel in Cairo and we will help you to check-in.

Day 7: Final Departure

On the last day of your Egypt Itinerary 7 Days, take your last breakfast at your hotel then Cairo Top Tours representative will meet you at the end of your Egypt tour itineraries to be transferred to Cairo International Airport for departure.
