Day 1 : Arrival to Cairo and check in

At [Cairo International Airport](#), our representative will be waiting for you inside your terminal with a signboard bearing your name and the name of the business, Cairo Top Tours. He will drive you in a luxurious, air-conditioned limousine to the hotel in Giza. Once you arrive in Giza, check into the hotel. Our representative will help you check in easily and go over your itinerary for your 8-day Egypt tour with you to go over and revise all pick-up times for various tours.

Overnight in Cairo.

Welcome Drink will be served.

Day 2: Egyptian museum and Cairo Tour

Enjoy your breakfast buffet at the hotel restaurant, and then get ready to continue your [Egypt Classic Tours](#). Today your tour guide will take you to visit [the Egyptian Museum](#), which displays about 120.000 artifacts from mummies, sarcophagi, ceramics, jewelry, and the most famous collection of [King Tutankhamun's](#) treasures.

We will move on to enjoy the [tour of the Giza pyramids](#) and [the Great Sphinx](#), which are also two of the most recognizable relics of the ancient Egyptians. The Hanging Church of the Holy Virgin Mary, also known as Al Mualaka or the suspended church because it was constructed above the fortress's towers, is one of the stops on our Coptic Cairo tour.

As part of our Cairo Day Tours, you will also see [the Ben Ezra Synagogue](#), which was supposedly constructed on the site where baby Moses' basket was discovered. This synagogue was built above the crypt where the holy family spent more than three months living and the spring where they obtained their water. We will stop to have a delicious lunch then we will head to Khan El Khalili bazaar.

Our representative will take you back to your hotel and overnight in Cairo.

Day 3: Alexandria Sightseeing Tour

After breakfast, get ready to meet your knowledgeable English-speaking tour guide to begin the tour from Cairo to Alexandria with our Egypt Classic Tours. We will provide air-conditioned transportation for you from Cairo to Alexandria. You will stop along the way for a break during the roughly 2 and a half hours journey.

Begin your sightseeing at the famous site known as [Pompey's Pillar](#), a Roman triumphal column in the city of Alexandria. then you will be transferred to the Catacombs of [Kom El Shokkafa](#). They were discovered before long because the twentieth century began and are thought-about one of the most important burials in Roman places

After that, you will drive by the seaside to reach [the Citadel of Qaitbay](#), built on the ruins of the ancient Lighthouse of Alexandria. It enjoys an excellent position, at the end of a narrow strip of land extending into the Eastern Port. Visit the Bibliotheca of Alexandria, which once held the record for largest library in the world. It is the oldest scientific research facility in human history. It was established at the start of the third century BC by Ptolemy I, and it is situated in the city that bears its name, facing the Mediterranean.

Having a fresh seafood lunch meal is a must while visiting Alexandria! enjoy it made out of the freshest ingredients.

Finally, you will be transferred back to your hotel in Cairo.

Day 4 : Cairo to Aswan and Embarkation

Enjoy your breakfast at the hotel, and then the tour guide from Cairo Top Tours will drive you to the airport so you can catch your flight to Aswan. You will be met at the Aswan airport upon arrival and transferred to the starting point of your [Egypt Nile River Cruise](#) before lunch.

The tour guide will meet you in the lobby in the afternoon to begin your [Aswan day tours](#), and he will lead you on an amazing journey to sail on the Nile by felucca around Kitchener's Island and the Agha Khan Mausoleum. A delicious dinner will be served on board the Nile Cruise, followed by a lovely Nubian folkloric show. Afternoon tea will also be served. Spend the night in Aswan, which is located above the Nile.

Day 5: Aswan Tours/ Kom Ombo

Another breakfast will be served aboard the Nile cruise boat, then head to visit [the High Dam](#), which was built during the time of the former president Nasser, and the Unfinished Obelisk block of stone, which was destined to become an obelisk almost 40 meters high.

In addition, [the Temple of Philae](#) Complex rose to prominence during the [Ptolemaic Dynasty](#) as the center of the cult of the goddess Isis. The guide will then return with you to the Nile Cruise, where you can enjoy your buffet lunch while sailing to Kom Ombo and then visit the Temple of Kom Ombo. After you've spent time at Kom Ombo, set sail for Edfu. Take in the beautiful scenery as you travel to the Captain's welcome cocktail and afternoon tea (smart casual attire). A fantastic dinner will be prepared on board, and afterward, there will

be disco music for entertainment.

Overnight on board in Edfu.

Day 6 : Sightseeing at Edfu Temple

After enjoying a high-quality breakfast on your Nile cruise, you'll ride in a horse-drawn carriage to the Temple of Edfu, which was constructed during the Ptolemaic Period and was dedicated to the god Horus, the son of the gods Osiris and [Isis](#). This temple incorporates some classic Egyptian elements with a few Greek characters. While traveling to Luxor, enjoy your onboard lunch, and on the upper deck of our Nile Cruise, afternoon tea will be served. A second elegant dinner is also provided on board, and the tour guides will arrange an Egyptian Galabya party, in which all of the groups on board are cordially invited to take part.

Overnight on board in Luxor.

Day 7: Luxor East and West Bank tour - Back to Cairo

Disembark from your Nile cruise after taking your last breakfast on board and begin your magnificent [sightseeing tours in Luxor](#). On the West Bank of Luxor, including [the Valley of the Kings](#) tombs, there are nearly 70 pharaohs buried who ruled Egypt during the new kingdom.

We will also see the huge [Colossi of Memnon](#), which is a mortuary temple located in Thebes. The temple has now been destroyed but the statue of Amenhotep III remained. The statues, even after the destruction, seem to be an impressive masterpieces. Visit the Temple of Hatshepsut, known as El Deir El Bahari temple.

Explore one of the oldest locations in the entire nation of Egypt, the enormous [temple complex](#) known as Karnak. The only location that can rival the magnificence of this magnificent temple complex is the Giza Pyramids in Cairo; it is divided into four main sections, with only the most inclusive section open to tourists. After that, you will be transferred by a modern air-conditioned vehicle to Luxor Airport to take your flight back to Cairo. Upon arrival in Cairo, you will be transferred to your hotel overnight.
