Day 1: Arrival in Cairo, Check-In, Optional Sound and Light Show.

Upon your arrival at [Cairo International Airport](#), you will receive a warm welcome from our representative. They will be waiting for you inside the airport and will facilitate your transfer to your hotel in a comfortable, private, air-conditioned vehicle. Our dedicated tour leader will be on hand to assist you with the check-in process, ensuring that every aspect of your 6 Days Cairo and Alexandria Honeymoon Tour is seamless and hassle-free. If you wish to make any adjustments or add extra [excursions](#) or activities to your itinerary in Egypt or Cairo, please feel free to discuss it with our tour leader.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Egyptian Museum, Coptic Cairo

Your Egypt Honeymoon Tour Itinerary kicks off after indulging in a delightful breakfast at your hotel. Begin your excursion by visiting the renowned pyramids of Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus. Afterward, head to the panoramic area, where you can capture unforgettable photos of the Giza Pyramids. Here, you'll also have the option to enjoy a camel ride around the pyramids. Explore the guardian of the Old Kingdom necropolis, the awe-inspiring [Great Sphinx](#), and enter the Valley Temple, where King Chephren's mummification process took place.

Next on the itinerary is a visit to the [Egyptian Museum](#), a monumental institution constructed over a century ago. It houses a vast collection of Egyptian antiquities, including statues of ancient kings and rulers, as well as the exquisite golden treasures of King [Tutankhamen](#). You'll have the choice to purchase an optional ticket to explore the mummy room at an additional cost. Following your museum visit, savor a delicious lunch at a local restaurant.

Continuing your explorations in Cairo, delve into Old Cairo. Begin your Coptic Cairo tour by visiting the Hanging Church of the Holy Virgin Mary, situated atop the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon's two towers. Explore the cavern church, known as the Church of Abu Serga. Conclude your tour with a visit to one of the oldest Jewish temples in the Middle East, the Ben Ezra Synagogue. As your captivating day in Cairo comes to an end, you'll be transferred back to your hotel for a restful overnight stay.

Day 3: Tour to the Pharaonic Village in Cairo

Your journey begins with a boat ride guided by your knowledgeable tour guide. During the boat trip, you'll witness a faithful reenactment of life in ancient Egypt. Marvel at depictions of [ancient Egyptian religious](#) practices, observe people engaged in hunting and food preparation, gain insights into ancient agricultural techniques, and discover the clothing styles of this bygone era. It's like stepping into a time machine that transports you 5000 years into Egypt's illustrious history.

After this enriching experience, you'll return to your hotel in Cairo for a comfortable overnight stay.

Day 4: Alexandria Trip from Cairo

Start your day with a delicious breakfast at the hotel, followed by a rendezvous with your private Egyptologist guide and chauffeur. They will accompany you in a comfortable, air-conditioned vehicle as you embark on an enchanting journey to Alexandria, often referred to as the "Bride of the Mediterranean." This historic city was founded by the illustrious Alexander the Great in 323 B.C.

Prepare to be enthralled by the wonders of Alexandria during this captivating day tour from Cairo. Your first stop will be the Qaitbay Fortress, an impressive structure built upon the foundations of the ancient Lighthouse of Pharaohs, which was once counted among the Seven Wonders of the World.

Next, you'll explore the Catacombs of Kom El Shokafa, a fascinating blend of Greco-Roman and Pharaonic artistic styles from ancient Egypt. Your journey continues to Pompey's Pillar, where you'll encounter a remarkable collection of Greek monuments, situated at the site of a once-famous temple known as the Serapeum.

You'll also have the privilege of visiting the Library of Alexandria, a beacon of knowledge that illuminated the world's understanding at the dawn of history. This magnificent institution was the epicenter of scientific research during its time.

After your exploration, savor a delectable seafood lunch at a local restaurant. Following this satisfying meal, we will transport you back to your hotel in Cairo, where you'll spend the night.

Day 5: Saqqara Necropolis, Memphis, Khan El Khalili.

Today's itinerary includes a visit to the Saqqara necropolis, where you'll have the opportunity to explore the Step Pyramid complex of King Djoser, the second ruler of Egypt during the 3rd dynasty. This pyramid is a historic masterpiece and the first-ever stone structure built in human history, credited to the brilliant architect Imhotep.

Additionally, you'll discover the pyramid of King Teti and have the privilege of entering one of the tombs belonging to the nobles near the pyramid. The tomb of Kagemni, who served as the son-in-law of King Teti and held the esteemed position of vizier of Justice during the 6th dynasty, is a fascinating site to explore.

Our journey then leads us to Memphis, the ancient capital of Egypt during both the Old and Middle Kingdoms. Although it exists today as an open-air museum, it houses intriguing artifacts, with two standout pieces being the alabaster sphinx of Memphis and the colossal statue of King Ramses II. King Ramses II was a prominent ruler during Egypt's New Kingdom, particularly during the 19th dynasty, and remains one of the most significant figures in Egyptian history.

After this enriching exploration, we will transfer to a local restaurant known for its high-quality cuisine, where you can enjoy a delicious lunch. Following your meal, we'll head to the heart of Cairo, where many Islamic Cairo tours commence – the bustling Khan El Khalili bazaar. Here, you'll have the opportunity to shop for souvenirs and savor traditional mint tea in a local café.

Finally, we'll return to your hotel for an overnight stay.
