Itinerario

Day 1: Arrival to Cairo and check in

When your flight lands at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, the tour guide from Cairo Top Tours will be there to greet you with a signboard bearing your name. He will drive you to your hotel in Giza in a luxurious, air-conditioned private vehicle. Make sure to check the itinerary of your Egypt Classic Tours from Cairo to Alexandria vacation for all pick-up times before arriving at the hotel so that our representative can help you with a guick check-in.

Day 2: Pyramids Sightseeing Tour

At your Cairo hotel in the early morning, take pleasure in your gourmet breakfast. Then, after meeting you to begin your tour of the Giza pyramids, our licensed tour guide will take you to the historical sites listed below

The Great Pyramid of <u>Cheops</u> in Giza Necropolis: ill have some free

4500 years ago, during the Old Kingdom, the Great Pyramid was created. During our Egypt Classic tours, you will be able to explore the huge building if you so choose or take pictures of it while your tour guide explains its history.

The second **Pyramid** of king Chechen:

The second reigning son of Cheops, Chechen, built a pyramid in Giza that was respectfully a little bit smaller than that of his father. additionally to the well-known Sphinx, the biggest sphinx in Egypt. The third Pyramid of King Mycerinus

In addition, you will be able to see the smallest royal pyramid in Giza, which was built for King Mycerinus of the 4th dynasty, from above the high plateau, where you will have the option to take stunning photos while riding a camel through the Giza Pyramids

.The Great Giza Sphinx:

This 73-meter-long sculpture of a lion with a human head, intelligent like a human, and as powerful as a lion, served as a guardian for the entire necropolis. It was carved from a single stone. The Valley Temple:

One of Egypt's oldest temples is located directly in front of the Sphinx.

Memphis City:

the oldest capital city of the Egyptian empire since the time of King Menes 5,000 years ago after the unification of the two lands Saggara:

You will see <u>the Step Pyramid</u>, which is the oldest pyramid built by the famous architect Imhotep to King Djoser and it is considered the first stone building in the world.

After finishing your exciting tours in Giza, we will take you back to spend the night at your hotel in Giza.

Day 3: Egyptian Museum and Cairo Tour

Prepare for the next part of your Egypt Classic Tours by ordering breakfast to be served at the hotel. Your allowed tour guide will take you to the Egyptian Museum today. The Egyptian Museum is one of the most well-known museums in the world due to the number of Egyptian artifacts it has on display across its two floors, with the most intriguing ones—including the royal treasure of the golden pharaoh Tutankhamen—being displayed separately.

Go to the Saladin Citadel, which served as the administrative hub of Egypt for many years. You will enjoy the Islamic Cairo trips with its numerous mosques, towers piercing the sky, and magnificent colorful domes, some of which are hundreds of years old and some of which are even older than one thousand years. You will visit the Alabaster mosque of Mohamed Ali upon arrival, which is thought to be a singular reflection of the Ottoman architecture in Egypt.

<u>The Hanging Church</u> of the Holy Virgin Mary, also known as Al Mualaka or the suspended church because it was constructed above the fortress's towers, is one of the stops on our Coptic Cairo tour.

In addition, as part of our Cairo Day Tours, you will see <u>the Ben Ezra Synagogue</u>, which was supposedly constructed on the site where baby Moses' basket was discovered. This synagogue was built above the crypt where the holy family spent three months living and the spring where they obtained their water.

Day 4: Alexandria sightseeing tour

After breakfast, prepare to meet your knowledgeable English-speaking Egyptologist guide to begin the day trip from Cairo to Alexandria as part of our Egypt Classic Tours. We will arrange for air-conditioned transportation for you from Cairo to Alexandria. You will stop along the way for a break during the approximately 2.5-hour journey.

Finally, you will arrive in <u>Alexandria</u>, the second capital of Egypt and the Mediterranean region's amazing pearl. <u>Alexander the Great</u>, who founded the city and governed Egypt in 332 B.C., gave Alexandria its name.

You will begin your sightseeing at the well-known <u>Pompey's Pillar</u>, which was built in 297 BC to commemorate the victory of a Roman emperor named Diocletian (who ruled Rome between 284 and 305 BC and also took control of Egypt) over a revolt in Alexandria. Next, you will be transferred to the <u>Catacombs of Kom El Shokkafa</u>, which were discovered at the beginning of the 20th century and are

thought to be one of the largest burial Roman sites. Finally At the extremity of a little peninsula that extends into the Eastern Port, it has a prime location.

Visit the historical site of the earliest research facility for science Alexandria's <u>Bibliotheca</u>, which formerly held the record for greatest library in the world. It was established by <u>Ptolomy I</u> at the start of the third century BC, in the city that bears its name, on the Mediterranean coast.

If you visit Alexandria, you must eat seafood. Take pleasure in your freshly prepared lunch.

Finally, you will be driven back to your Cairo hotel.
