### Day 1: Arrival

At Cairo International <u>Airport</u>, a representative of our company will meet and assist you. exclusive transportation to the hotel in air-conditioned vehicles

## Day 2: Cairo - Egyptian Museum & Great Pyramids

Our tour guide will come to you when you are staying in Cairo and take you to the Giza Pyramids (Cheops, Chephren, and Mykerinus) for an incredible experience. After that, visit two historic sites: the Valley Temple and the Great Sphinx. Lunch will be served in the neighborhood café in Giza during the Pyramids.

Proceed to the Egyptian Museum next. It has a unique collection of nearly 250,000 authentic artifacts that go back up to 5000 years, and it also has a special exhibition that features artifacts from the <a href="Tutankhamun">Tutankhamun</a> era. Many artifacts, gold, and jewelry that had been hidden in his tomb for over 3,500 years were found when it was excavated in 1920.

should you wish to see the magnificent hall of the mummies. When on a day trip through Cairo, ask the tour guide to take you to the National Museum of Egyptian Culture; admission is extra. It will set you back 200 Egyptian pounds.

Spend the night at the Hotel in Cairo.

The show of light and sound at the Giza Pyramids is an optional tour.

# **Day 3: Nile Cruise - Aswan**

After breakfast at the hotel, you will ride in a private air-conditioned car to Cairo Airport to catch your flight to Aswan. You can expect our knowledgeable guide to meet you when you get to the airport. We'll drive a private, air-conditioned car to get you there.

Starting at the High Dam, the Aswan day tours will proceed to the Unfinished Obelisk block of stone was destined to become an obelisk almost 40 meters high, Unfinished Obelisk weight is more than 1000 tons. You will visit Philae Temple. When the journey is over, you will be brought to the boat. The ship will head toward Edfu.

# Day 4: Nile Cruise- Edfu

Our knowledgeable tour guide will meet you after breakfast and drive you away in a private, air-conditioned vehicle. Your first stop on your full day's journey will be the Temple of Horus in Edfu. You will return to the ship and have lunch while the boat travels to Kom Ombo, where you can see the temple that was used by the gods Sobek and Haroeies.

You can take part in the neighborhood get-together known as the Galabya party on a boat in the evening. Think about sailing to Luxor on a cruise.

# **Day 5: Nile Cruise - Luxor East Bank**

Our knowledgeable tour guide will meet you after breakfast and drive you away in a private, air-conditioned vehicle. The largest open museum in the world is located on the East Bank, and it's the place you should start your Luxor day tours. Then, one may view the exquisite courtyards and granite statues of Ramses II at the temples in Luxor and Karnak. When the trip is over, you'll be taken to the boat.

### Day 6: Luxor West Bank - Cairo

One of our knowledgeable tour guides will greet you after breakfast and drive you away in a private, air-conditioned vehicle. <u>The Valley of Kings</u> and Queens, The Colossi of Memnon, and the <u>Temple of Queen Hatshepsut</u> are the first stops on the day trip to the West Bank.

You will be driven to the airport to board your flight back to Cairo following the excursion. A member of our staff who is qualified will greet you as soon as you land. You will be driven to your accommodation in a private, air-conditioned car.

# **Day 7: Alexandria Tour**

Following a delicious breakfast, you will board a private, air-conditioned vehicle with our knowledgeable guide and travel to Alexandria for three hours. You can see the impressive monument known as <a href="Pompay Pillar">Pompay Pillar</a>, which was built in Emperor Diocletian's honor.

Then, you should visit the Sultan Quitbay Citadel, which was constructed on the site of the venerable Alexandria lighthouse. The Catacombs of Kom El Shokafa, the largest Roman cemetery, are made of three levels of tunnels cut out of the underlying rock. They show how Roman and Egyptian art can coexist.

After that, you are free to explore the gardens of King Farouk's <u>Montazah Palace</u> and the renowned <u>library in Alexandria</u>. In Alexandria, you'll have the opportunity to take some truly remarkable and original pictures. After the trip, you'll return to spend the night at your Alexandria hotel.

# **Day 8: Alexandria-Siwa**

After an excellent breakfast, your knowledgeable guide will drive you to Siwa Oasis in a private airconditioned vehicle. There will be a stop in the ancient city of <u>Siwa</u> before moving on to the Amun Ra Temple and the Alexander Temple.

The Tombs on the Mountain of the Dead, the Siwa Museum, the Dakrour Mountains, and the Crocodile Tombs are a few more attractions. Spend the night and make a visit to Siwa.

### Day 9: Siwa- Cairo Open Day

After a delectable breakfast, you will return to Cairo in a private air-conditioned vehicle.
