Itinerario

Day 1: Arrival Cairo

With your name on a signboard, our Cairo Top Tours tour guide will meet you at the Cairo International Airport. The long flight is over, it's time to unwind! An exclusive air-conditioned vehicle will transport you to your hotel. Your representative will help you check in without a hitch at the hotel and will review your itinerary for the wheelchair accessible tours to the Pyramids, Nile Cruise, and Sharm El Sheikh with you to confirm and approve pick-up times for each tour.

Overnight in Cairo.

Welcome Drink

Day 2: Pyramids and Saqqara Tour

Your private tour guide will meet you after breakfast at the Cairo hotel to start your Cairo Day Tours to the famous <u>Giza Plateau</u>, where you will see the Great Pyramid of Cheops, the only surviving example of one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, as well as the pyramids of <u>Chephren</u> and Mycerinus, <u>the Great Sphinx</u>, and the mummification temple, also known as the Valley Temple, facing the imposing statue. Our visit to the plateau also includes a panoramic flight over the area.

Now let's go to <u>Saqqara Necropolis</u> to visit the Step Pyramid Complex. This structure demonstrates how pyramid buildings evolved. Although it lacks smooth sides like the Giza Pyramids, the Bent Pyramid, and the Red Pyramid of Dahshur, it was the first pyramid built in Egypt.

Prepare yourself after lunch because we're going to Memphis, which served as the pharaohs' capital for a thousand years and served as an important religious and cultural hub for three thousand years during the ancient Egyptian civilization, to visit the open-air museum, which is renowned for housing the second-largest sphinx made of alabaster, which weighs 80 tons, and the second-largest statue of Ramses, which is broken. After returning home, spend the night in Cairo at your hotel.

Day 3: Aswan Tours

Early in the morning, check out and make your way to Cairo International Airport. traveling to Aswan by air. Your transfer to the cruise will be met by one of our local representatives. Before lunch, we will set sail, and you can eat on the boat. Begin your Aswan day trips by visiting the High Dam, which was inaugurated in 1971, and the Philae temple, which was constructed on an amazing island. After that, we'll set sail for Kom Ombo. After taking your afternoon tea, visit the temple that is shared by the two gods Sobek and Haroeris. In order to see the most beautiful temples in Egypt, we will sail towards Edfu. On the cruise ship will be where your dinner will be served. Get ready for a disco party at the end of the day.

Overnight in Edfu.

Day 4: Edfu Temple

After breakfast is served on board your deluxe Nile cruise, we'll visit <u>Edfu's Temple</u> of Horus, which is the most impressive structure honoring Horus, the falcon-headed god of the sky and kingship who was worshipped in ancient Egypt. You will then cross the lock and set sail for Luxor. You can now take pleasure in your afternoon tea and dinner onboard. You'll go to the Galabya celebration.

Overnight in Luxor.

Day 5: Luxor Nile Cruise Tours

Breakfast aboard the boat, then you will start the west bank of Luxor tour by visiting the Valley of the Kings. It is a narrow valley of generic, red rock, but it is hidden under the ground. The Valley of the King's tombs are nearly 70 pharaohs buried, who ruled Egypt during the new kingdom.

Continue your East Bank of Luxor tour by visiting the Karnak Temple complex, which was constructed by several kings to serve as Amun-Re's throne, the solar disk deity according to ancient Egyptian religion, and the Temple of Luxor. At the Temple of Luxor, you will be amazed by the courtyard, enormous columns, and granite statues of Ramses the Great. On the way back, the group stops at the Colossi of Memnon, two enormous statues of Amenhotep III facing the Nile, has lunch on the Nile Cruise, and spends the evening reflecting on how wonderful the Luxor day tours were.

Day 6: Luxor to Sharm El Sheikh by Flight

After savoring your delicious breakfast, get ready to disembark. Your transfer to the Luxor Airport will allow you to continue your Egypt vacation packages on a flight to Sharm. You will check into your hotel in Sharm El Sheikh after arriving at the airport in Sharm.

Day 7: Sharm El Sheikh Optional Tour to Ras Mohammed National Park

Now take advantage of your free day in Sharm El Sheikh or sign up for our optional trip to Ras Mohammed National Park, a reserve for both terrestrial and aquatic wildlife. The 480 square kilometer protected area is located at the southernmost point of Sinai, where the Gulf of Suez and the Gulf of Agaba meet.

Day 8: Sharm El Sheikh Optional Quad Bike Adventure

Enjoy a peaceful morning of free time. or go on a 2:00 p.m. optional tour. Pickup from your hotel and a 15-minute drive will take you to the Quad Bike Center. Start the quad bike adventure in Sharm after receiving brief safety and operating instructions. Drive through the Sinai Desert's sand dunes to take in the breathtaking views. Free evening and hotel stay the following day.

Day 9: Sharm El Sheikh Optional Tour to St. Catherine Monastery

Spend a free day in Sharm or sign up for our optional tour to The Monastery of St. Catherine, which is situated in Sinai's historic center and is accessible by foot from Mount Sinai's Gebel Musa. This is where Moses received the Ten Commandments. The Greek Orthodox Church owns and operates the Saint Catherine monastery, which is surrounded by gardens and cypress trees. After the Vatican, its expansive library is home to the second-largest collection of illuminated manuscripts in the world. You can see the Burning Bush and a large number of antique works of art: invaluable icons, beautifully carved doors, beautiful wall paintings, and other fine religious ornaments.

Overnight in Sharm.

Day 10: Fly Back to Cairo

Enjoy a delicious breakfast at your Sharm El Sheikh hotel before traveling to the airport to catch a flight to Cairo.

Day 11: Cairo City Tour

In the early morning, enjoy your breakfast at your hotel in Cairo, and then you will be accompanied by your private tour guide to start <u>Cairo trips</u> by visiting the Egyptian Museum, which is considered the oldest archeological museum in the Middle East and includes the world's greatest antiquities from the Predynastic to the Greco-Roman era.

Now we will visit the Citadel of Saladin including Mohamed Ali Alabaster Mosque inside and get a panoramic view of the Islamic district of Cairo with mosques, minarets, and domes hundreds of years old and some above one thousand years old.

Afterward, we will visit <u>Ben Ezra Synagogue</u>, which is rumored to be the location of the pharaoh's palace where the basket of Moses was picked up from the Nile. This is where the ancient <u>Roman fortress of Babylon</u>, the Hanging Church that is suspended above its ancient towers, and the church of St. Sergius with its crypt, where the holy family spent nearly three months, are all located.

After lunch, we will go to enjoy Islamic Cairo trips and explore the walls and barriers of this antiquated city, whose old streets date back to the 10th century. The walk ends with tea at Fishawy's oldest cafe in Khan El Khalili, Cairo's old bazaar. At the end of the day, you will go back to the hotel and stay overnight in Cairo.

After having your last breakfast in your hotel, our representative will pick you up and transfer you to Cairo International Airport for departure at the end of your 12-Day Pyramids, Nile Cruise, and Sharm El Sheikh Wheelchair Accessible Tour.
