Itinerario

Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Check-In

After reaching <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, a representative from Cairo Top Tours will be there to greet you and take you to your hotel in Cairo. They will also help you with the check-in process. Once you are settled, they will review your 9-day Egypt Wheelchair Accessible Tour to Cairo and Siwa Oasis itinerary to confirm the pick-up times. Additionally, they can discuss any additional optional excursions you may be interested in during your Cairo trips and Egypt desert safari adventure.

Welcome Drink.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids Tour, Saqqara Necropolis, Memphis City

Following your first breakfast at the hotel, a representative from our company will meet you in the lobby to assist you with your Cairo day trips. Your first stop will be the fascinating tour of the <u>Giza Pyramids</u>, where you will be astounded by the size of these enormous structures built during the old kingdom of ancient Egypt's history by the greatest kings and rulers.

Visit the Great Pyramid of Cheops, who was inspired by his father's difficult attempts to build expansive burial tombs, and King Snefru, the founder of the 4th dynasty and owner of two great pyramids in Dahshur. Then, make your way to the high plateau for a spectacular view of the three pyramids, including the pyramids of <u>Chefren</u>, who was the son of Cheops and the successor of King Dedera. His pyramid was somewhat smaller than his

The Great Sphinx in Giza, a statue of a man with the body of a lion thought to have been made for King Chephren himself, is now visible after having the option to take a camel ride across the plateau where the Giza Pyramids are located. Next, enter the Valley Temple, where the king was mummified as part of the burial process.

The Step Pyramid is the first pyramid constructed entirely of stone by <u>King Djoser</u>, the second king of the third dynasty. The Step Pyramid is situated in the Saqqara Necropolis and is regarded as a significant stage in the development of pyramids in Egypt. Saqqara Tours is now your next stop to see the Step Pyramid. You will also visit one of the noble tombs built for the king's son-in-law, the tomb of Kagemni, who served as the vizier of justice during King Teti's reign, as well as one of the pyramids on the property, the pyramid of King Teti from the sixth dynasty.

Continue your Cairo sightseeing by traveling to Memphis, an ancient city, where Egypt's first capital once stood. There, you will find an outdoor museum housing an alabaster sphinx and a massive statue of <u>King Ramses II</u>, who ruled Egypt during the New Kingdom era.

Before being driven back to the hotel, you will enjoy a delicious lunch in a high-quality restaurant that has a view of the pyramids and the Sphinx.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch.

Day 3: Egyptian Museum, Coptic Cairo Tour, Khan El-Khalili

After completing your 2-hour tour of <u>The Egyptian Museum</u>, you will transfer to the Coptic Cairo neighborhood to view the Christian heritage there, including the Hanging Church of the Holy Virgin Mary, which was constructed atop two towers of the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon, and the Church of St. Sergiu. Your private Egyptologist guide will meet you at the hotel after breakfast. Your trip to Cairo will begin there. Before being transferred to the Islamic <u>Khan El Khalili</u> district for the best walking tours in Cairo and a close-up look at the Egyptian locals, enjoy your lunch in a high-quality restaurant. After your Cairo City Tour is over, you will be driven back to the hotel for the night.

Day 4: Cairo to Alexandria Day Trip

Prepare to meet your fluent English-speaking Egyptologist to start your day tour from Cairo to Alexandria after enjoying a delicious breakfast at the hotel. We offer the best Egypt Wheelchair Accessible Tours. You'll ride in an air-conditioned vehicle as it takes you to Alexandria. The journey takes about 2.5 hours to complete, including a stop for a break.

You will begin your tour of Alexandria, the city that <u>Alexander the Great</u> founded in 332 B.C., at Pompey's Pillar. You will then be taken to the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa, and finally, you will drive along the coast to the Citadel of Qaitbay, which was constructed over the ruins of the ancient Lighthouse Pharos of Alexandria, one of the ancient seven wonders of the world.

Visit the <u>Library of Alexandria</u> as well, which was built to replace an earlier library that is no longer standing. The library was built by Ptomoly I in the third century B.C. to serve as the global hub for science and knowledge.

Before being driven to your hotel in Alexandria for check-in and overnight, enjoy a delicious seafood lunch at one of the best restaurants in the area overlooking the harbor.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch.

Day 5: Alexandria to Alamein, Siwa Oasis

After breakfast and check-out from the hotel, we will drive for about 7 hours to the stunning Siwa Oasis. En route, we will stop in the Alamein region to take El Alamein tours, starting with the Military Museum and El Alamein War Cemetery to view army models and learn about the main battle that took place in Alamein during WWII. Before continuing our tour to Siwa Oasis, we will now travel to the charming city of Marsa Matrouh where we will eat lunch at a delightful restaurant. After arriving, we will leave our belongings in the eco-lodge and travel to one of Egypt's most relaxing natural hot springs to take a bath that will calm our muscles after a long day's drive. Back to the hotel and overnight.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch.

Day 6: Siwa Sightseeing Tours

Enjoy your breakfast of Egyptian cuisine in the Eco-lodge before embarking on one of our Siwa Oasis tours. While there, take some time to explore the ruins of the Shali Fortress, where the ancient Siwan people sought safety from raids by outsiders. The Temple of The Oracle at Aghurmi Village, which dates back to the 26th dynasty, as well as the Temple of Um Ubeyda, a temple dedicated to the worship of the god Amun Ra, will then be visited. After that, you will learn about the priceless Siwan heritage during your visit to the Siwa House Museum, and lunch will be served at one of the Oasis' lovely restaurants. Cleopatra Spring, one of the most well-known hot springs in the area, one of the most famous hot water springs in Siwa Oasis that is believed to be used by the last pharaoh, Queen Cleopatra, enjoy swimming and dipping into the glittering water after that you will be transferred to Fitnas Island to enjoy the charming Sunset view.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch.

Day 7: Egypt Desert Safari Tour to the Great Sand Sea

After a delicious breakfast at the hotel, your certified Egyptologist will take you on the Siwa Oasis Desert Safari in a 4x4 vehicle to explore the Great Sand Sea.

Before moving on to the lovely sand dunes and the fossilized corals from the Cambrian era, we will start our Egypt Desert Safari adventure by visiting the Mountain of the Dead and many of the tombs of the oasis' rulers. Then, we'll take you to one of the amazing locations in the Great Sand Sea, a stunning lake in the middle of the desert, where you might be lucky enough to see flamingo birds appreciating the tranquility of the desert and bathing in a very calming mood.

We will now enjoy sandboarding, the thrill of sliding down the Dakrour Mountain now we will enjoy sandboarding, the thrill of sliding down the sand dunes instead of snow, after snowboarding, it is time

to wash up in the hot spring notable as Bir Wahid to chill and smooth our muscles, enjoy another astonishing sunset at the end of the Great Sand Sea Tour in the middle of the dunes while having Bedouin tea.

Overnight in Siwa after being transferred back to the eco-lodge.

Day 8: Back to Cairo

Early in the morning, before departing from Siwa Oasis via Marsa Matrouh for Cairo, you will have your breakfast box. You will be taken to your hotel for the night in Cairo after arrival. If you're fortunate and we arrive back in Cairo earlier than expected, you can reserve one of the things to do in Cairo by night, such as a belly dancing and Tanoura dance performance while dining on an optionally entertaining Nile cruise while on a sailing boat on the Nile River.
