<u>Itinerario</u>

Day 1: Arrival in Cairo, Check-In

We will pick you up from Cairo International Airport and take you to your accommodation in Cairo or Giza.

When you arrive at the hotel, you will be given a welcome drink. Our representative will then go over the schedule for your 9-day Easter tour of Egypt to make sure everything is going as planned and help you check in easily.

Spend the night in Cairo.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids, and Saqqara

You will have your breakfast, and our knowledgeable guide will lead you on an exciting tour of famous ancient Egyptian sites. Your day will begin with a visit to the Giza Pyramids. Once you arrive, you will see the <u>Giza Pyramids</u>, which include the spectacular Great Pyramid of Cheops, which is constructed from 3.2 million stone pieces. You will also see the Pyramid of Mycerinus, the grandson of Cheops, and the Pyramid of Chephren, which is smaller but no less spectacular. <u>The Valley Temple of King</u> <u>Chephren</u>, where his royal corpse was mummified, is seen next to the Great Sphinx.

We are going to Saqqara to see <u>The Step Pyramid</u>, which is made of 6 steps stacked one on top of the other. With the help of a French archaeologist, the region was rebuilt, and we will visit the tomb of Kagemni, his son-in-law, and the Pyramid of Teti to witness the remarkable, flawlessly carved depictions of everyday life.

After enjoying a delicious lunch at a top-notch restaurant, you'll enjoy the rest of the day exploring Cairo on one of our Egypt Day Tours or taking a break in the hotel.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 3: Fly to Aswan, Aswan Excursions

You have to leave the hotel quickly to make your flight to Aswan. thereafter you'll check into our 5-

star Nile cruise. After some downtime, we will begin our Aswan excursions on the Nile by visiting the <u>High Dam</u>. The guide will describe how the Nubian people had to be relocated for the dam to be built and <u>Lake Nasser</u> to be created, as well as some significant historical sites, such as the <u>Abu Simbel</u> <u>Temples</u>, which you will be able to see the following day.

To visit <u>Philae Temple</u>, we will take a little boat excursion to the Island of Agilkia. Constructed in the Ptolemaic period (between 305 and 30 B.C.), the temple honors Goddess Isis, one of the most ancient Egyptian deities. We'll keep visiting <u>The Unfinished Obelisk</u> in the granite quarries to view the most striking obelisk, which is said to have been carved during the illustrious reign of Queen Hatshepsut. Returning and spending the night on the Aswan cruise.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner

Day 4: Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

You will begin your day by participating in our optional tour of the magnificent Abu Simbel temples from Aswan, located in southern Egypt. These famous temples, known as the "Nubian Monument" and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, were hewn out of the mountainside under Pharaoh Ramses II's 18th dynasty in the new kingdom. The group next proceeds to the <u>Kom Ombo Temple</u>, a dual temple honoring the falcon deity Haroeris (Horus) and the crocodile god Sobek. We'll explore the temple for a while before moving on to Edfu. This temple dates back over 2,000 years and was hidden in sand until the French expedition unearthed it in 1798. It was likewise devoted to Horus, the god of kingship. The reason it is the best-preserved temple in Egypt is because it has been concealed for so long. The 5star cruise ship will take us to Luxor, where we will spend the night at sea.

Day 5: Luxor West Bank Tours

Our first stop will be the well-known <u>Valley of the Kings In Luxor</u>, where you may see some of the amazing tombs of the New Kingdom's pharaohs, including King Tutankhamun. After that, we'll have an amazing tour of the Hatshepsut Temple (also known as El Deir El Bahary Temple), which is the tomb of the first queen to lead Egypt during the establishment of the new state. A visit to the magnificent <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, the final remnants of the Amenophis III temple, will mark the end of the day. Once more, spend the night on the cruise ship.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner

Day 6: Luxor East Bank Tours

You will visit the East Bank of Luxor tours to begin your journey today. and take in the view of the Karnak complex, which was formerly a part of Thebes. It features a wide variety of temples, chapels, sculptures, and obelisks and is devoted to the mighty ram-headed deity Amun. We will next see the Luxor Temple, a center of devotion devoted to the triad of Amun, his wife Mut, and his son Khonso,

and connected to the <u>Karnak Temple</u> by a lengthy avenue of sphinxes. Collectively, these temples and gods were instrumental in the annual Opet Festival, which took place during the flood season. Next, we'll go to Hurghada on the Red Sea shore in our air-conditioned car.

Day 7: Optional Snorkeling Trip in Hurghada

You can spend your day however you like, whether it is lounging on the sandy beach or swimming in the pool, complete with unlimited food and drinks. You're in for pure relaxation! However, you have the option to partake in any of the water sports, such as our thrilling scuba diving and snorkeling trips in Hurghada. Some of the world's greatest places to dive coral reefs are in the waters surrounding Hurghada, where you may observe a wide variety of vibrant fish species. Spend the night in the Hurghada resort.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner

Day 8: Fly to Cairo, Egyptian Museum, Khan El Khalili

You will take your car to the Hurghada airport, where you will board a flight back to Cairo to begin your Cairo day tours. We will begin our tour of the Egyptian Museum to learn more about the amazing ancient history of the country after giving ourselves some time to cool off in our hotel. You will be astounded by the sheer volume of artifacts on display there. We will then enjoy a delicious lunch before traveling to the Islamic district of Cairo to explore <u>Khan El Khalili Bazar</u>, a bazaar brimming with souvenir shops.

Day 9: Final Departure
