#### Day 1 Itinerary: Welcome to Cairo, Egypt

With a signboard bearing your name and Cairo Top Tours, our Cairo Top Tours representative will be waiting for you at <a href="the Cairo International Airport">the Cairo International Airport</a>. In order to make the most of your tours in Egypt, your 11-day Egypt Christmas Tour Package details will be reviewed with you as you are smoothly transferred to check into your Cairo hotel.

#### **Day 2: Pyramids and Cairo Tours**

After breakfast, start your <u>Cairo Day Tours</u> and enjoy the trip to <u>the Giza Pyramids</u>, which include the Great Pyramid of Cheops and the two pyramids of Chephren and Mycerinus, as well as the Great Sphinx, a representation of power and knowledge with a king-like head and a lion-like body. After a delicious local lunch in one of the high quality restaurants, continue your <u>Coptic Cairo</u> tour by visiting the Museum of Egyptian Antiquities, where you will find a sizable collection of ancient artifacts, as well as <u>Old Cairo</u> Churches like the Hanging <u>Church</u> of the Holy Virgin Mary, the Synagogue of <u>Ben Ezra</u>, and the <u>Church of Saint Sergius</u> and Bachus. You will be escorted back to your hotel in Cairo for the night after your Cairo Tour is over.

#### **Day 3: White Desert Tour**

Enjoy your breakfast as you are escorted to the captivating White Desert, which is close to the Black Desert. Professional photographers as well as curious tourists are drawn to the barren, lifeless desert. You can produce original images at specific times of the day when the play of shadows creates an even more amazing scene. The most common way to travel through the Black Desert is by private vehicle (rented or excursion), as the minibuses that arrive or depart from the capital do not, as would be expected, have a set stop in the region. The Valley of El Haize is located about 50 kilometers south of Bawiti, the main village of the Bahariya Oasis. Including a stop to admire the charming crystal at Crystal Mountain and the lovely Valley of Agabat. Camping in the White Desert is an excellent choice. Then savor your fine-dining meal as you watch the sun go down.

#### Day 4: Bahariya Oasis Tour

After breakfast, your <u>tour of the White Desert</u> will continue as you enjoy the natural limestone formations of the rabbit, mushroom, and other shapes. You will also see hot springs with unique natural features that are excellent for the skin. Back at the Bahariya Oasis, your tour guide will drive you to Cairo so you can check in and spend the night there.

#### Day 5: Cairo to Aswan - Aswan Sightseeing Tours

After breakfast at your Cairo hotel, you will be driven to the airport to catch your flight to Aswan. When you arrive in Aswan, a Cairo Top Tours representative will greet you and help you start your <u>Aswan tours</u>. First, you will visit the Aswan High Dam, which was built in 1960 to protect Egypt from the yearly tides. Next, you will visit the Philae Temple, which is known for its distinctive stones and engravings that have survived intact for thousands of years. After that, you'll be driven to your hotel in Aswan where you can check in and spend the night.

### Day 6: Edfu Temple - Overnight in Luxor

After breakfast and check-out procedures, visit <u>Edfu Temple</u>. This magnificent temple is dedicated to the falcon <u>God Horus</u>, protector of kingship and son of Osiris; you will have time to explore its splendor before being taken to your hotel in Luxor after lunch.

#### **Day 7: Luxor East Bank Tours**

Start your day with a delectable breakfast before embarking on a visit to Luxor Museum, which opened its doors to the public in 1975. Housed within a two-floor building, the museum displays a remarkable collection of grave goods from the tomb of the legendary 18th dynasty pharaoh, Tutankhamen. Additionally, you'll find a multitude of statues dating back to the New Kingdom, some of which were discovered hidden in the Luxor statue cache.

Next on your itinerary is a visit to <u>Luxor Temple</u>, an immense ancient Egyptian temple situated on the east bank of the Nile. Originally established by King Amenhotep III during the New Kingdom, it was later completed by the renowned Pharaoh Ramses II of the 19th Dynasty. Immerse yourself in the grandeur and historical significance of this captivating site.

Finally, you'll be transferred back to your hotel in Luxor, where you can enjoy a comfortable overnight stay.

### **Day 8: Luxor West Bank Tours**

The opportunity to continue your Luxor Tours by seeing the highlights during Luxor West Bank Tours makes today a special day. The most notable tomb belongs to the child king Tutankhamen, and after that, head to the Temple of Hatshepsut, the first female ruler to have such a massive temple named after her. The Valley of the Kings is where the Kings and Pharaohs of the New Kingdom built their tombs away from tomb raiders and where they believed they would be resurrected once more in the afterlife like the sun dies every day in the West and is born again in the East. Keep admiring the enormous statues of Amenhotep III seated in majesty, also referred to as the Colossi of Memnon. After that, you'll be driven to a hotel in Hurghada for the night.

### Day 9: Free Day in Hurghada
