Day 1: Arrive to Cairo

Upon your arrival at [Cairo International Airport](#), our Cairo Top Tours tour leader will pick you up and take you to your hotel in Cairo. Our tour leader will help you with a smooth check-in and revise the itinerary to ensure that you book all the important tours in Cairo, Luxor, Aswan, and Hurghada during Christmas. You will spend a comfortable night getting ready for an early morning excursion to the Pyramids of Egypt.

Day 2: Pyramids and Sphinx Tour

Meet your tour guide at the hotel lobby after breakfast to begin your Cairo Day Tour to the Giza Pyramids and the [Sphinx](#), which resembles King Chephren, the owner of the middle pyramid. Your trip to the Pyramids area will raise your adrenaline as you will visit the greatest of the seven wonders of the world which was built Centuries ago to memorize the names of the great Pharaohs Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus.

You will have the opportunity to enjoy a camel ride in the Giza Pyramids (optional activity) before touring the [Valley of the Temples](#) was built for the rituals of the mummification of the king, the Great Sphinx to symbolize the power and intelligence of the pharaohs of ancient Egypt.

Enjoy your tasty lunch in a very styled city restaurant and overnight in your hotel in Cairo.

Day 3: Alexandria Trip

Begin your [Alexandria Tour from Cairo](#) after having your breakfast. You will be transferred by a deluxe air-conditioned vehicle for approximately a 2-hour drive to Alexandria City at the Mediterranean Sea which was built by Alexander the Great during the Greco-Roman Era and used to be the most beautiful city in the whole

world at that time. You will visit the Greco-Roman catacombs of [Kom El Shoqafa](#), the ruins of the Roman temple complex, Pompey's pillar, and [the Citadel of Qaitbay](#). You will visit the famous lighthouse Pharos, which is one of the seven man-made wonders of the world, and the modern Bibliotheca of Alexandria and have delicious fresh seafood at a very good quality restaurant then head to your hotel in Alexandria for overnight.

Day 4: Alexandria to Cairo - Egyptian Museum - Train to Aswan

In the early morning, you will turn back to Cairo after breakfast to visit the magnificent [Egyptian Museum](#) downtown exhibiting the largest and most unique collection of Egyptian antiquities all over the world and the only royal treasure that was found in good condition, the treasures of the golden pharaoh [Tutankhamen](#). Yummy lunch in a good local restaurant before heading to the train station to take the sleeping train heading to Aswan and overnight in your compartment.

Day 5: Arrive Aswan - Aswan Excursions

We will have the opportunity to visit Aswan's most impressive sites during Aswan Day tours. See the Aswan [High Dam](#) which was built in 1960 to save Egypt from the floods happening every year. Then you will visit the [Philae Temple](#) with its amazing stones and inscriptions which have been saved for thousands of years to tell us about how much our ancestors were strong and advanced. After that, you will be transferred to your hotel in Aswan for check-in and overnight.

Day 6: Abu Simbel Temples

Enjoy an extraordinary experience after having breakfast and visit [Abu Simbel Temples](#). These twin temples were carved out of the mountainside in the 13th century B.C., and during the 19th dynasty - the reign of the Pharaoh Ramses II. They were built for the king and his Queen Nefertari, and to commemorate his victory at the Battle of Kadesh, their huge external rock relief figures have become iconic. Back to your hotel in Aswan and overnight.

Day 7: Aswan to Luxor - Luxor Temple

Continue your Egypt Christmas Tours after breakfast at your hotel in Aswan. Our representative will transfer you to Luxor and visit the huge [Temple of Luxor](#) which was built by King Amenhotep III in the 19th Dynasty ([New Kingdom](#)) and was completed by Ramses II during the 19th Dynasty. Back to your hotel in Aswan and overnight.

Day 8: Luxor West Bank - Travel to Hurghada by Land

Enjoy your breakfast and get ready because you will visit the biggest temple in the world through your Luxor Day Tours, [Karnak Temples](#), the greatest example of greatness in the history of Egypt dedicated to the God [Amun](#), his wife Mut, and their son Khonsu. It was constructed from the beginning of the Middle Kingdom to the Greco-Roman Kingdom by many Kings. Also, you will visit the monuments of the West bank of the Nile, [Hatshepsut Temple](#) in Deir Al-Bahari, Valley of the Kings, and the [Colossi of Memnon](#) before travelling to Hurghada by land for about 3 hour's drive to overnight in your Hurghada hotel.

Day 9: Submarine Excursion in Hurghada

Experience a marvelous trip underwater for two hours on board [Sindbad Submarine](#) after breakfast to enjoy watching the different kinds of marine species and beautiful corals reefs and colorful fish on the [Red Sea](#), the only submarine in the Middle East with a capacity of 44 passengers and it has a crew of two captains takes us for a wonderful trip underwater of the red sea. It goes 22 meters deep below sea level where you can see different kinds of marine life. It is not necessary to be a scuba diver. When you finish you will be transferred back to the hotel in Hurghada.
