Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Egypt

Your English-speaking tour guide from Cairo Top Tours will meet you when you arrive at [Cairo International Airport](#) and assist you in getting to your hotel in Cairo in a luxurious air-conditioned vehicle. You will be given a welcome drink when you arrive at the hotel, and he will help you with a quick check-in and go over the specifics of your Egypt travel packages.

Spend the night and get ready for your tour of the Egyptian Pyramids in the morning.

Day 2: Pyramids and Sphinx Excursion

Following breakfast, you'll be picked up by our knowledgeable guide to start your exciting [Cairo Day Tour](#) to the Pyramids of Giza and the [Sphinx](#), which is thought to have resembled King Chephren, the owner of the middle pyramid.

One of the Seven Wonders of the World, the Pyramids give you an adrenaline rush as you take in their historic majesty. These monuments are an extraordinary and thrilling experience that serves as a reminder of the great pharaohs who lived before us, [Cheops](#), Chephren, and Mycerinus.

Enjoy your lunch at a fantastic neighborhood restaurant and spend the night in your Cairo hotel.

Day 3: Alexandria Trip

After breakfast, you will be driven to Alexandria. You will also go to the contemporary [Bibliotheca of Alexandria](#), as well as the Greco-Roman sites, the [Catacombs of Kom El Shouqafa](#), the ruins of the Roman temple complex, [Pompey's Pillar](#), and the Citadel of Qaitbay. The [Citadel of Qaitbay](#) is one of the top destinations for our [Alexandria Shore Excursions](#) because it is where the famed lighthouse Pharos (one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World) once stood.

You'll then eat lunch at a restaurant serving fresh, premium seafood.

Then you will have your lunch at a fresh, high-quality seafood restaurant. Finally, you will be heading to your hotel in Alexandria for the night.

Day 4: Alexandria to Cairo; Egyptian Museum; Train to Aswan

After breakfast, a representative from Cairo Top Tours will transport you by land to Cairo.

You will be visiting the magnificent [Egyptian Museum](#) in the heart of Cairo, where you can view the world's largest and most unusual collection of Egyptian artifacts as well as the only remaining piece of a royal treasure that has been preserved, the golden pharaoh Tutankhamun.

Before boarding the train to Aswan and spending the night in your compartment, enjoy a delicious lunch in a nearby restaurant after finishing the tour of the Egyptian Museum.

Day 5: Arrive Aswan - Aswan Excursions

We'll have a great time today on our [Aswan day tours](#) to the most stunning sites, and our tour guide will be waiting for you at the train station to greet you in Aswan.

You'll go to the Aswan [High Dam](#), a stunning feat of engineering that has prevented Egypt from repeatedly flooding. Then, visit [Philae Temple](#) and its amazing stones and inscriptions, which have been preserved for thousands of years to tell us the story of an ancient civilization in one of the monuments of Nubian history. You'll be able to see this impressive structure and learn more about its significant influence on Egyptian history.

You will be driven to your hotel in Aswan for check-in and overnight following your day's activities.

Day 6: Abu Simbel Temples

You'll have a fantastic time touring the [Abu Simbel Temples](#) after breakfast. In the 13th century B.C. and during the [19th dynasty](#), under the rule of Pharaoh Ramesses II, these twin temples were hewn out of the mountainside. They are monuments to the king and his [queen Nefertari](#), and their enormous external rock relief figures have become recognizable symbols of his victory at the Battle of Kadesh.

Return to your Aswan hotel to spend the night.

Day 7: Aswan to Luxor - Luxor Temple

You will be transferred to Luxor after breakfast at your Aswan hotel. There, you can take Luxor day tours to see the magnificent [Temple of Luxor](#), which was begun by King Amenhotep III in the [18th Dynasty](#) (New Kingdom) and finished by [Ramesses II](#) in the 19th Dynasty.

Transfer to your Luxor hotel and stay the night.

Day 8: Karnak Temple - Luxor West Bank - Transfer to Hurghada by Land

You will visit the [Karnak Temple](#) today, the largest temple in the entire world and the pinnacle of greatness in Egyptian history. The most significant god, Amun, the well-known goddess Mut, and their son Khonsu are honored in this temple. Numerous Egyptian kings built the structure from the start of the Middle Kingdom until the Graeco-Roman period.

Additionally, you will see the [Colossi of Memnon](#), the Hatshepsut Temple in [Deir Al-Bahary](#), the [Valley of the Kings](#), and the monuments on the West Bank of the Nile.

You will then travel by land for about three hours to Hurghada, where you will spend the night in a hotel.

Day 9: Submarine Excursion in Hurghada

After breakfast, you'll enjoy an amazing two-hour trip underwater on the [Sindbad Submarine](#), viewing different types of marine life and colorful fish on the [Red Sea](#). This submarine has a capacity of 44 passengers, and its crew of two captains will take you on a wonderful trip beneath the sea. It goes 22 meters below sea level. You don't need to be a scuba diver to enjoy this trip; it's accessible to everyone. When you finish, you'll be transferred back to your hotel in Hurghada.
