Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Optional Nile Cruise Dinner

When you arrive at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, the tour guide you have been assigned by Cairo Top Tours will be waiting for you. He or she will drive you to your hotel in Cairo, help you with check-in procedures, and revise your itinerary for the 6-day Cairo and Hurghada Wheelchair Accessible Tour.

This evening, an optional Cairo Nile dinner cruise is offered, where you can enjoy a delectable dinner buffet while cruising the Nile River on a boat for an hour. A pleasant oriental show (belly dancing) and Tanoura dance show will keep you entertained while you dine on the Nile in Cairo.

Day 2: Pyramids, Dahshur, Memphis

Your tour guide will meet you after your hotel's open buffet breakfast today and accompany you on your day trip from Cairo to the Giza Pyramids, Dahshur, and Memphis.

Start your day trips from Cairo with a tour of The <u>Giza Pyramids</u>, you'll be astonished by the size of these massive structures, which were constructed during the old kingdom of ancient Egypt's history by the powerful kings and rulers as evidence of the success they attained 4500 years ago thanks to the Nile River. See the Great Pyramid of King Cheops. King Cheops (who built his pyramid using more than 2.3 million limestone blocks to serve as the eternal home from which he would rise to the heavens) was influenced by his father's attempts to build enormous burial tombs. The structure stood at a height of 146 meters 230 meters long for each side.

passing by the high plateau to see the three pyramids of Cheops, <u>Chephren</u>, and Mycerinus in all their beauty. With a height of 136 meters and some remnants of the outer casing at the top, Chephren's pyramid is a little bit smaller than that of his father Cheops.

Visit the Great Sphinx in Giza, a statue of a lion with a human head that is believed to have been created by King Chephren himself because it is located within his pyramid complex, and go inside the Valley Temple, where the king was mummified as part of the burial ritual.

Continue your Cairo sightseeing by traveling to the location of Memphis, an ancient city that is now known as Mit Rahina. Here, you can visit the open-air museum that features the second-largest sphinx made of alabaster and the enormous statue of <u>King Ramses II</u>, who was the most powerful ruler during the new kingdom.

Transfer to the Dahshur Archaeological Site to see the Red and Bent Pyramids, two of the four pyramids built for King Snefru, the 4th dynasty's founder and King Cheops' father. One of the most unusual pyramids in Egypt is the Bent Pyramid, which still has a significant amount of the outer casing material. The Red Pyramid, which is thought to be the first perfectly shaped pyramid in Egyptian history, can be identified by the reddish color of the limestone blocks that were used to build the structure.

Before being driven back to your hotel, you will eat a fine lunch in a restaurant with a view of the Giza pyramids.

Day 3: Fly to Hurghada, Optional Hurghada Bedouin Desert Safari By Jeep

After breakfast, take a flight from Cairo to Hurghada. At <u>Hurghada International Airport</u>, you'll be met by a representative of ours who will drive you to the hotel and assist you with the check-in process. You can spend the rest of the day relaxing by the pool and watching the evening show, or you can choose to go on an optional Hurghada Bedouin Safari by Jeep at dusk or one of our other Hurghada excursions.

Day 4: Snorkeling Trip to Mahmya Island by Boat

You will have a fun boat tour today in <u>Hurghada</u> the Mahmya Islands. The tour begins when your tour guide drops you off at the location where you will board the boat and sail while making specific stops for the best snorkeling and swimming experiences at one of the best naturally protected areas with a wide variety of fish and coral reefs. After you've finished your boat ride to Mahmya Island for snorkeling, take a transfer back to the hotel.

Day 5: Fly to Cairo, Egyptian Museum, Coptic Cairo, Khan El-Khalili

After a delicious buffet breakfast, you will be transferred to the airport to catch your flight to Cairo. Once there, you will be met by your guide and transferred to the city's oldest district to take a fascinating Coptic Cairo tour.

Visit the Ben Ezra Synagogue, which was once a Coptic church before it was converted into a Jewish synagogue after being sold, as well as The Hanging Church of the Holy Virgin Mary, which was constructed above the ruins of the Roman fortress of Babylon, and the church of St. Sergius, also known as the cavern church, which contains the well where the holy family got their necessary water while taking refuge in the crypt inside.

Enjoy your lunch at a reputable establishment. After that, we'll continue our Cairo day tours with an Egyptian Museum tour, where we'll see the oldest artifacts in Cairo's Egyptian Museum, which first opened to the public in 1902 and is home to the largest collection of antiquities.

Finally, you will be taken to Cairo's oldest market, Khan El Khalili Bazaar, for an unforgettable shopping experience.

You will be transferred to the hotel for check-in and overnight in Cairo.

Day 6: Final Departure, Optional Saqqara Tour with Camel Ride

After enjoying your delicious final breakfast in Egypt, you will be driven to Cairo International Airport for your final departure at the conclusion of your Cairo and Hurghada Wheelchair Accessible Tour. You can reserve our Saqqara from Cairo day trip if you have enough time before the flight. 200 years or so before the great pyramid of Cheops in Giza, to see the oldest stone pyramid in history.
