Day 1 : Embarkation/ Aswan day Tours

Your Aswan experience begins with a local Cairo Top Tours representative greeting you in the morning. You will be transferred by air-conditioned private vehicle to your Nile boat, where check-in procedures will be conducted quickly.

After check-in, you will take a leisurely tour to [the Aswan High Dam](#), built by Gamal Abdel Nasser in 1960. The High Dam is an important engineering masterpiece intended to regulate the Nile waters and generate power.

The trip will then continue to the banks of the Nile where you will board a motorboat heading to [Agilika Island](#). There, you will discover the [Temple of Philae](#), which dates back to the 3rd century BC during the Greco-Roman era.

The [Aswan day tour](#) ends with a visit to the unfinished obelisk, which was discovered in a granite quarry in the southern part of the city.

After the tour, you will return to your Nile boat for the night, where you will enjoy lunch and dinner on board.

Day 2 : Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

Your day on the cruise begins with a refreshing breakfast served in a quiet and relaxed atmosphere. After breakfast, your cruise will dock at Mövenpick MS Darkum Nile Cruise in Kom Ombo, where a visit to the [Temple of Sobek](#) and Haroeris awaits.

At the Temple of Sobek and Haroeris, built in the Ptolemaic era, you will learn about its history and the unique details it preserves. The temple is dedicated to two important gods of antiquity: The local crocodile Sobek and the legendary eagle god Haroeris.

After enjoying the visit, you will return to the Nile cruise to rest and refuel. Then you will head to the [Temple of Horus in Edfu](#), one of the best preserved ancient Egyptian temples in the Nile Valley.

After this exciting journey, you will return to the Nile cruise for your overnight stay, where you will enjoy lunch and dinner on board.

Day 03: Luxor West Bank

As an optional extra, you can enjoy a spectacular hot air balloon ride over the West Bank of Luxor tours. This experience will be a unique opportunity to enjoy breathtaking views from the air and see Luxor's magnificent landmarks from a height.

As for your [Luxor day tours](#), you will set off from the West Bank to explore more of the magnificent landmarks. You'll start with a delicious breakfast before visiting the [Valley of the Kings](#), where you'll discover the tombs of New Kingdom rulers.

The tour continues to the Deir el-Bahri Temple, which was built during the reign of Queen Hatshepsut in the 18th Dynasty. You will learn about its history and the unique details it holds.

Finally, the last stop of the tour will be the [Colossi of Memnon](#), the only remaining relics from the massive burial temple of Amenhotep III.

After these exciting tours, you will return to the Nile cruise for your overnight stay, where you will enjoy breakfast, lunch, and dinner on board.

Day 04: Check Out - Luxor East Bank

Enjoy your wonderful Nile cruise from Aswan to Luxor after breakfast. You will head to the East Bank of Luxor to explore two beautiful temple complexes.

Our first stop will begin at the [Karnak Temple](#), which has undergone a thousand years of development. You'll learn about the magnificent pieces from the New Kingdom and admire the massive columns in the Hall of Columns, erected by Ramses II, one of the greatest pharaohs in the history of Ancient Egypt.

Then you will head to the [Luxor Temple](#), which was built around the 14th century BC and was rebuilt by Ramses II, Queen Hatshepsut, and many other pharaohs.

After completing the excursion, you will be transferred to your accommodation in Luxor.
