Day 1: Embarkation/Luxor East Bank Tours

You will be picked up from your hotel in Luxor and one of our representatives will be waiting for you at the starting point of your 5-day Nile Cruise Tour from Luxor to Aswan. After giving the cabin keys to our tour leader, you will have a brief break while you enjoy your first lunch on the MS Royal Viking Nile Cruise.

Your English-speaking Egyptologist tour guide will be waiting for you in the lobby to start your Luxor East Bank Tours, which is 700 kilometers south of Cairo. With approximately 500,000 residents, the city mostly relies on agriculture and tourism for its livelihood. explore the majestic Karnak Temple, Egypt's biggest temple, which is the largest temple in Egypt, was built and expanded throughout 2000 years from a simple shrine during the New Kingdom to a huge Temple that encompasses a massive area and is the largest temple in Egypt. Then continue your Luxor excursions as you are taken to the magnificent Luxor Temple, which is situated in the city bearing his name and was found in 1884 at the East Bank of the Nile in Luxor. After your Luxor Day tours, spend the night on board before continuing with the program tomorrow.

You also can have an (optional) Sound and Light Show in Karnak Temple.

Day 2: Luxor West Bank Tours

After enjoying a delicious breakfast aboard the MS Royal Viking Nile Cruise or similar, you will meet your tour guide to start your West Bank tour of Luxor. Here, you will visit the magnificent rock-cut tombs of the New Kingdom pharaohs, also known as the <u>Valley of the Kings in Luxor</u>. These tombs were built by these rulers far from tomb thieves, and more than 60 of these tombs have now been found. Visit the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, also known as the Temple of El Deir El Bahari, as part of your Luxor West Bank Tours, It is 97 feet (30 m) tall Hatshepsut temple facts is an extraordinary monument capable of dazzling its visitors, and the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, the huge statues of the great King Amenhotep III will be your last Luxor day tours. Your tasty lunch will be served aboard the <u>Luxor to Aswan Nile Cruise</u> and then you will enjoy sailing to Edfu.

Optional Luxor Hot Air Balloon Ride above the west bank monuments.

In the evening your delightful dinner will be served and you will stay overnight aboard the Nile Cruise in Edfu

Day 3:Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

After experiencing the previous two days of Luxor sightseeing tours, you will now taste a delicious breakfast on the Nile Cruise and be accompanied by your knowledgeable tour guide to make one of the most interesting Egypt Day Tours, the tour to Edfu to see the <u>Temple of Horus</u>, which still has all the elements of an ancient Egyptian temple preserved, After visiting one of Egypt's largest and best-preserved temples, the Temple of <u>Edfu</u>, which is the second-largest after the Temple of Karnak, you will return to the cruise ship and embark. As you sail south until you reach Kom Ombo, the ship will serve an unusual lunch.

After arriving in Kom Ombo town, you will be taken to the amazing Kom Ombo Temple, which is devoted to the crocodile god Sobek and was constructed between 1350 and 180 B.C. on King Ramses II's orders. The boat will then set sail for Aswan after your tour of Kom Ombo and Edfu is complete. Enjoy your delicious dinner aboard the cruise as well as the entertainment and local music show, and spend the night in the lovely city of Aswan.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 4: Aswan Nile cruise Tours

During your Aswan excursions, you will have breakfast on board your Egypt-Nile cruise before meeting your personal tour guide. Your first stop will be the <u>High Dam in Aswan</u>. This impressive structure was built to prevent the Nile floods, which used to submerge the country for extended periods due to water mismanagement. Aswan, located in the southernmost part of Egypt, is approximately 1,000 kilometers away from Cairo and is positioned near the initial Nile Falls.

After that, you will explore the <u>Unfinished obelisk in Aswan</u>. During the Old Kingdom of Egypt as well as the New Kingdom, when they built grand temples, colossal pillars, and obelisks, the ancient Egyptians would quarry and transport granite for construction.

After visiting the Unfinished Obelisk, your Aswan tour will proceed to the <u>Temple of Philae</u>. This temple, built in the Greco-Roman style, holds significant mythological importance as it is one of the four sites associated with the stories of Isis, Osiris, and Horus. It was specifically constructed and dedicated to the worship of the goddess Isis.

Following the temple visit, you will return to the cruise for a delicious lunch. In the evening, a high-quality dinner will be prepared and served on board the cruise boat. As part of the evening entertainment, you will have the opportunity to enjoy an engaging Nubian show. Finally, you will spend the night in Aswan.

Meals are included throughout the day: breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 5:Disembarkation/End of our 5 Day Nile Cruise tour From Luxor to Aswan

After finishing your final breakfast of the tour and checking out of the Luxor Aswan Nile cruise boat, then we will transfer you to your requested drop-off location at Aswan like the railway station or Aswan Airport.
