Day 1 : Arrive Cairo / Check-in

Upon your arrival at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, a tour guide from <u>Cairo Top Tours</u> will be waiting to assist you with the immigration process and transfer you in a private vehicle to start your<u>Egypt</u> <u>Luxury tour</u>. Upon arrival at your hotel in Giza, our tour manager will facilitate a smooth and convenient check-in process for you. They will also review your itinerary for Egypt Travel Packages to ensure that all pick-up times are convenient for you and your travel companion.

You will spend the first night of your tour in a hotel in Cairo.

Day 2: Cairo day tour

After breakfast, your English-speaking tour guide will meet you at the hotel to begin your tour. You'll visit two of the world's oldest and most significant wonders that are still standing today: The Great Pyramid of King Cheops and the Middle Pyramid of his son Chephren at <u>Giza Pyramids</u>. Additionally, you'll see the Great Sphinx and King Chephren's <u>Valley Temple</u>.

Next, you'll be taken to the <u>Egyptian Museum</u>, a two-story building that houses the world's largest collection of Egyptian artifacts. It also features the unique golden treasure that young King Tutankhamun discovered unharmed in the Valley of the Kings.

Finally, you'll be transferred back to your hotel for overnight.

Day 3 : cairo to sinai

Our representative will meet you at your Cairo hotel to begin your exciting Sinai Trekking Tour. You'll depart for Sinai in the early morning, a 5-hour drive from Cairo. Once you arrive, you'll check-in to the Bedouin camp - eco loge el karm - where you'll have an hour to rest, check your packing, and prepare for your hike.

Your first stop will be <u>Wadi Al Fara</u>, which requires a 3 km off-road drive. The highlight of this hike is a challenging mountain climb followed by a steep descent.

Next, you'll visit Jabal Shayeb Al Banat, one of the Red Sea's mountains in the Eastern Desert of Egypt. The mountain is composed of large igneous rock slabs, and it features several deep valleys descending from its flanks. Tourists come to this mountain to engage in various activities, such as camping, hiking, and rock climbing. Afterward, you'll be transferred to visit Wadi el Nogra.

Finally, you'll return to your eco loge el karm camp for the night.

Day 4 : sinai day treks

After enjoying Bedouin tea and breakfast at the camp, you'll be transferred to Wadi Tala. Rather than

returning to St. Katherine, you'll take the lower path that leads directly into Wadi Itlah, accessible through a small opening in a stone retaining wall. From this viewpoint, you'll see the visible impact of thin water curtains flowing off the rock face after rainfall, leaving a V-shaped indentation and coloring it white.

Next, you'll visit A Sheik's tomb and a Bedouin hamlet located in the highlands of Sinai. It is a popular hiking destination due to the diverse mountain landscapes on the trails connecting St. Katherine and this location.

Finally, you'll return to the camp to rest and have lunch.

Day 5 : Sinai to Cairo

After breakfast at the camp, you'll travel back to Cairo. We'll transfer you to your Cairo hotel where you'll check-in and spend the night.

Day 6; Old Coptic Cairo

After breakfast, our tour guide will drive you to <u>the Citadel of Salah El-Din</u> to visit the Mohamed Ali Alabaster Mosque, one of the main Islamic <u>attractions in Cairo.</u>

For lunch, you'll have the opportunity to savor the most delicious delicacies of Egyptian cuisine, followed by a half-day excursion to the churches of Old Cairo, where you'll learn about Babylon's ancient Roman fortifications. The highlight of this tour is <u>the Hanging Church</u>, but you'll also visit St. Sergius Church, built over the crypt where St. Joseph the Carpenter, Jesus Christ, and his mother lived for three months. Lastly, you'll see the <u>Ben Ezra Synagogue</u>, originally a Coptic church that was later converted into a Jewish synagogue.

Continuing our Cairo day tour, you'll explore the Islamic neighborhood of Cairo, including mosques like Egypt's Al-Hakim mosque and historical defenses. The city's medieval madrasas, sails, and city gates, as well as its ancient stone-paved streets, are remnants of the Islamic era. You'll also visit the oldest section of the Islamic quarter, <u>Khan El Khalili</u>, where you can admire the minarets of Al Hussein Mosque and Al Azhar Mosque. To cap off your tours of Islamic Cairo, you'll enjoy a mint tea at Fishawy, one of Cairo's oldest and most famous traditional Egyptian coffee shops.

Finally, our tour guide will return you to your hotel to relax.

Day 7 : Final Departure

Enjoy your breakfast before being transferred to Cairo International Airport for your final flight.
