itinerário

Day 1: Arrival Cairo

Our tour guide will meet you in Cairo at the airport entrance. We will then drive you to your lodging, which is a non-smoking vehicle.

Put your belongings down, relax, and spend the evening.

Select from one of our trips, an optional walking tour of Cairo, or a nighttime felucca ride on the Nile.

Day 2: the Giza pyramids and Egyption Museum tour

After breakfast at the hotel, you will be driven to the first destination on the itinerary. You will first get to see some of the most <u>famous pyramids</u> at Giza, including the Little Menkaure Pyramid, the Intermediate Pyramid of <u>Chephren</u>, and the Great Pyramid of Khufu.

You will then be able to see the great sphinx, which was constructed to protect the three pyramids from enemies and would-be thieves who sought to take the royal treasures from within them. You'll then be taken to a sophisticated restaurant for a delicious meal.

Your next destination will be <u>the Egyptian Museum</u>, which houses a sizable collection of ancient Egyptian artifacts. You'll then be driven back to your hotel so you can relax after that.

Day 3: the Coptic Cairo tour.

After breakfast, we'll take you to <u>Coptic Cairo</u>. The three most famous churches in Egypt are the Cava Church, also called the Monastery of Saint Simeon, <u>the Ben Ezra</u> Synagogue, and the Hanging Church. Since the Cava Church was carved out of the Mokattam mountain, southeast of Cairo, it is considered a wonder.

We'll visit these cathedrals and then have a typical lunch at one of the local restaurants. We'll also go to <u>Khan El-Khalili</u> and have some traditional tea at <u>Al-fishway</u> Coffee if we have more time.

We'll take you back to your hotel after the adventure is over.

Day 4: Wadi El Natrun monasteries tour/ travel to Alexandria and overnight

Early in the morning, we will leave Cairo to visit the Wadi El-Natrun Monasteries, which are halfway between <u>Alexandria</u> and Cairo and were once a haven for monks fleeing Bedouin and Berber attacks. We will then stop for lunch at a nearby restaurant.

You are welcome to check in and spend the remainder of the evening at your hotel after we get to Alexandria.

Day 5: Explore Alexandria Attractions

Eat breakfast at the hotel before meeting your tour guide to start the trip. then start your day trip. Initially, we will take a plane to Alexandria to see the Saint Mark's Monastery, a church built in Mark's honor as the patriarch of the Coptic Orthodox Church.

Next, proceed to <u>the Kom el Shoqafa</u> catacombs, which house Roman-era tombs and are situated in the Karmooz neighborhood west of Alexandria. Then chow down on seafood at a local restaurant. subsequently See the over 500-year-old <u>Qaitbay citadel</u>, located on the western tip of Pharos island.

You'll return to Cairo and spend the night there after that.

Day 6: Travel to Sinai , Saint Catherine

Proceed to <u>Sinai</u> after breakfast, where your journey will begin with a visit to the prophet Moses' springs: The region is one of the most well-liked travel destinations and has twelve springs. There are hot summers and mild winters in this area, and the water is safe to drink.

The Sacred Cat <u>The sixth century</u> saw the construction of the magnificent Christian monastery depicted here. That is home to the second-largest collection of illuminated manuscripts. You will then be made aware of it. The monasteries in question are among the most well-known in Egypt.

After that, you'll be taken to a restaurant where you can have lunch before spending the night at a hotel.

Day 7: Climbing Mount Sinai

First thing in the morning, you'll eat breakfast and prepare for your big adventure climbing Mount Sinai. Once it's over, you'll be driven back to Cairo for lunch, where you can unwind at your hotel for the remainder of the day.

Day 8: final departure.

On the morning of your final departure, we will come to your lodging and drive you to Cairo International Airport.
