Day 1: Arrival to Cairo airport

Visit the <u>Valley of Agabat</u> to enjoy the thrill of sandboarding down the gigantic sand dunes, the magnificent formations, and the petrified wood, as well as <u>Crystal Mountain</u> to see ancient quartz crystal formations.
