Day 1: Arrival to Cairo airport

Inside <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, our representative will meet you with a signboard bearing your name and the <u>Cairo Top Tours</u> emblem. You will be driven in a luxurious vehicle from the airport to the Cairo hotel. It is regarded as the first museum in the entire world to present a thorough overview of Egyptian Civilization throughout its history, from prehistory to modern times.

Numerous artifacts are on display at NMEC to provide visitors with a glimpse of Egyptian civilization over the ages, beginning with predynastic and ancient Egypt.

After that, we'll move on to Citadel Square. We'll go to Sultan Hassan Mosque, a Mamluke architectural marvel built in 1359. El-Rifai mosque (1912), with its distinctive design and elaborate worship hall decorations, and Sultan Hassan mosque are the symbols of ancient Islamic Egypt, just as the Giza pyramids are for ancient pharaonic Egypt.

And you'll be taken back to your hotel at the conclusion of the day!

Day 4-Embarkation in Luxor
