Day 1 of your 7-day vacation package to Cairo, Luxor, and Aswan begins with your arrival in Cairo.

When you arrive at Cairo International Airport, a representative of Cairo Top Tours will meet you. Your name will be on a signboard that this agent is holding, and they will help you start your amazing vacation. In order to confirm all pick-up timings and optional excursions that you might want to schedule later, they will go over your itinerary for your Egypt travel packages with you.

We will get you from the airport and drive you to Saqqara to see the Step Pyramid of King Djoser to start your Cairo day tour. Imhotep, the gifted architect and vizier of King Djoser, who was awarded over a dozen titles for his numerous accomplishments, created the world's oldest stone structure, the pyramid. The richest archeological site in Egypt is Saqqara, which is situated roughly 27 kilometers southwest of Cairo. You can see how the royal tomb in ancient Egypt developed there by exploring the Mastaba tombs of the Nobles. Furthermore, you can explore King Teti's pyramid and the tomb of his son-in-law, Kagemni, who was the vizier of justice.

Following a delightful midday meal at a charming eatery, you will head to Memphis City, the once Egyptian capital. This is where you may see the massive, 80-ton Alabaster Sphinx, which is constructed from a one block of stone, and the partially damaged gigantic statue of Ramses II. Following the Great Sphinx of Giza, this sphinx is the second largest of its kind. Around 3100 B.C., Menes the Pharaoh united Upper and Lower Egypt and began the Pharaohs' dynastic history, founding Memphis City. The Museum of Egyptian Antiquities features a stunning exhibit honoring the victory. After the trip, you'll be taken to your hotel so you may check in.

Day 2: Tour of Sightseeing in Cairo

Breakfast will be served at the hotel.

A professional tour guide will go with you to see historical sites like the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon, which was constructed by Emperor Trajan 2000 years ago; the Hanging Church, which was built in the third century and is dedicated to the Holy Virgin Mary; the church of St. Sergius, which was once the residence of the holy family; and, at the end of the Coptic Cairo Tour, the oldest synagogue in the region, Ben Ezra Synagogue.

Once you've resumed your drive to downtown Cairo, you'll get to see The Egyptian Museum. The largest collection of Egyptian artifacts in the world may be found in this museum, which also houses the gold and silver belongings of King Tutankhamun, a young monarch whose tomb was discovered in perfect condition in the Valley of the Kings in Luxor. You will have a unique opportunity to learn more about the mysteries of ancient Egyptian history during your tour of The Egyptian Museum.

Once you've had your delicious lunch, we'll go on an exploration of Saladin's Citadel. We will enjoy the stunning view of Islamic Cairo and contemporary buildings like the Cairo Tower and the Egyptian Media and Television complex from inside the alabaster Mohamed Ali Mosque.

Following the completion of our Cairo Day Tours, we will show you where to go to learn more about Islamic Cairo excursions. You can engage in a unique shopping experience in the quaint and historically significant Khan El Khalili market there.

You will finally be returned to the hotel where you will spend the night in Cairo.

Day 3: Cairo to Luxor

You will get ready to check out of your Cairo hotel. When you head to the airport in Cairo to catch your trip to Luxor today, your personal driver and tour guide will be with you. After landing at the airport in Luxor, you will have a tour of the west bank of Luxor and see the colorful, old tombs of the Egyptian monarchs in the Valley of the monarchs. You will also visit the Queen Hatshepsut Temple, also called the Deir El Bahari Temple, escorted by your Egyptologist and driver. Your trip of Luxor will culminate with a visit to the Colossi of Memnon, which are two enormous statues of King Amenhotep III, the grandfather of the renowned King Tutankhamen.

After enjoying a delicious lunch at a restaurant overlooking the Nile River, continue on with your tour of the East Bank of Luxor. You will see The Karnak Temple, which was the center of governance and religion in ancient Egypt's golden age, and Luxor Temple, which was built by various Egyptian pharaohs over the course of several ages.

Stay the night at Luxor.

Day 4: Tour of Edfu and Kom Ombo

After having the breakfast you will visit one of the best-preserved cult temples in the area, it is devoted to the god Horus of ancient Egypt. Following the trip, your driver will take you to another lovely hamlet in the north where you may take in the breathtaking view of the river and its verdant banks winding through the desert. The ancient Temple of Kom Ombo, which is perched on a hilltop with a view of the Nile, will be your second destination. Sobek, the crocodile-headed fertility deity and world builder, shares this temple's two entrances with Haroeris.

We will send one of our representatives to your Aswan hotel with you.

Day 5: Tours of Aswan

A knowledgeable tour guide from Cairo Top Tours will accompany you and offer recommendations for things to do in Aswan once you've had your delectable breakfast. The Aswan High Dam, which was constructed to control river flow and optimize its usage for agriculture and electricity production during floods, will be your first visit. The spectacular Temple of Isis, which occupies a large piece of the island and is recognized as one of the most remarkable temples in Egypt, may be explored at the Philae temple, which is your next stop.

You will return to the hotel following your fantastic Aswan day tours.

Day 6: Returning to Cairo

After breakfast at the hotel, your knowledgeable tour guide will take you to the airport in the early morning so you can take the plane back to Cairo.

Your personal tour guide will meet you at the airport and drive you straight to the Giza Pyramids tour to start your Cairo Day Trips. Built 4500 years ago, the Cheops Pyramid is the only surviving wonder of the ancient world. You will also witness the construction of the Chephren pyramid, which Khufu's son completed 20 years later, and the third pyramid of King Mycerinus, the lower 16 rows of which still have the reddish tint of the casing. The Pharaohs had faith in an afterlife.

In addition, the sphinx was constructed to guard the deceased monarchs.

At the conclusion of your tour of the Giza pyramids, we will take you to see the Sphinx. The strength and intelligence of the ancient pharaoh is symbolized by the Sphinx. The Valley Temple, which was built using a blend of limestone, granite, and alabaster paving, will be the next stop on our trip.

After the tour, we will drive you to your Cairo hotel and help you through the check-in procedure. Spend the night in Cairo
