Day 1: Cairo to Bahariya Oasis

At 6:00 AM, a tour guide from Cairo Top Tours will pick you up from your accommodation in Cairo or Giza and drive you for around 4 hours to the Bahariya Oasis. Your Desert Egypt safari trips will start when you arrive by visiting the Valley of the Golden Mummies, which was built during the Greco-Roman era and has a variety of mummies of ancient Egyptian rulers.

Also, see the rock-cut Tombs of Zed-Amun-Ef-Ankh and Bannentiu tomb, well preserved twenty-sixth Dynasty <u>Tombs of the Nobles in Bahariya</u>, the most majestic <u>Temple of Ain El-Meftella</u> which is located in the center of Bahria oasis, and <u>Alexander the Great Temple</u> who was known as Alexander of Macedonia who ruled the great Egyptian Empire only in his early 30th. After having a pleasant lunch, you will check in to the hotel for a leisurely afternoon and enjoy the hot spring at the hotel.

Before sunset, you will get to climb the <u>Black Mountain</u> by a 4WD Jeep to visit the English House relishing the scenic view of the Bahariya Oasis during sunset. Overnight in Bahaya. Meals: Lunch, Dinner

Day 2: Bahariya Oasis - Gara Cave (Djara Cave)

eat your breakfast of Egyptian cuisine before starting your 170 km off-road Gara Cave Tours to see the ancient civilisation. While passing through the Baharian Harra Village, you may take in the desert scenery and eat a delicious lunch while walking through the sand dunes. Dinner will be served while guests enjoy the fantastic desert setting and overnight camping.

Day 3: Gara Cave - Agabat off Road

After breakfast, you will go with your certified tour guide to the Gara Cave, also known as the Djara Cave, a stunning cave created by rain corrosion within the limestone from around 55 million years ago. It has crystal-clear rocks. The beautiful stalactites and stalagmites were formed as water melted down the limestone. Artifacts and rock art have also been discovered here, demonstrating human presence inside the cave during prehistoric times, most likely in the late Neolithic era. A thrilling off-road drive will next take you to the lovely Valley of Agabat, where you can admire the contrast between the enormous rocks in the Egyptian

White Desert that are an astonishing white color and the golden sand that surrounds them. Camping for the night in this intriguing

Day 4: Ain Khudra - White Desert Camping

After breakfast, continue your off-road drive to the bubbling spring at Ain Khadra. This ancient water well is close to a palm tree and sits alone on a hill surrounded by Roman, Coptic, and medieval-era ceramics. where we will enjoy a delicious picnic lunch before moving on to the Santa Tree (The Acacia Tree) and driving through the limestone formations on one of the most picturesque deserts in the world, the White Desert. Enjoy the magnificence of the sphinx, whale, and rabbit sculptures, as well as the white limestone rocks that are entirely cream-colored. Camping for the night in the pristine, white-chalk-like sand-covered White Desert.

Day 5: Black Desert - Crystal Mountain - Back to Cairo

Your incredible desert safari trip to Gara Cave ends today. After breakfast, you'll be transported back to Cairo via Bahariya Oasis, past the translucent Crystal Mountains, whose vividly colored rocks sparkle like jewels in a crown. It is regarded as one of the unique and amazing mountains in the entire globe that merits a visit. The Black Desert, where the mountains have been crumbling to cover the desert with a layer of dust and black rocks, continues to the Valley of El Haize Village with its cool water spring, which is situated south of Bahariya Oasis, after which you will drive back to your accommodation in Cairo.
