Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Optional Nile Cruise Dinner

When you arrive at Cairo International Airport, the tour leader you have been assigned by Cairo Top Tours will be waiting for you. He or she will drive you to your hotel in Cairo, help you with check-in procedures, and revise your itinerary for the 6 Days Cairo and Hurghada Wheelchair Accessible Tour.

This evening, an optional Cairo Nile dinner cruise is offered, where you can enjoy a delectable dinner buffet while cruising the Nile River on a boat for an hour. A pleasant oriental show (belly dancing) and Tanoura dance show will keep you entertained while you dine on the Nile in Cairo.

Day 2: Pyramids, Dahshur, Memphis

Your tour guide will meet you this morning after your hotel's open-buffet breakfast and accompany you on your day trip from Cairo to the Giza Pyramids, Dahshur, and Memphis. Start your journeys with a tour of the Giza Pyramids, where you will be astounded by the size of these massive structures constructed during the old kingdom of ancient Egypt history by the most powerful [kings and rulers](#) as evidence of the success.

passing by the high plateau to get a scenic view of the 3 pyramids of [Cheops](#), Chephren, and Mycerinus. Chephren, who was the son of Cheops built his pyramid slightly smaller in respect to his father, with a height of 136 meters with some remains of the outer casing at the top. You will see the Great Sphinx. Then you will enter [the Valley Temple](#), where the mummification process of the king took place as part of the burial process.

Continue your tours in Cairo by moving to the location of the ancient [city of Memphis](#), which was once the capital of Egypt. There, you can visit the open-air museum that is home to the second-largest alabaster sphinx and a colossal statue of King Ramses II, who was one of the most powerful rulers of the new kingdom. Transfer to the Dahshur Archaeological Site to view the Red and Bent Pyramids, two of the four pyramids built for King Snefru, the creator of the 4th dynasty.

You will have a gourmet lunch in a good-quality restaurant overlooking the pyramids of Giza before being transferred back to your hotel.

Day 3: Fly to Hurghada, Optional Hurghada Bedouin Desert Safari By Jeep

After breakfast, take a flight from Cairo to Hurghada. When you land at the airport in Hurghada, a representative from our company will be waiting to greet you and assist with check-in. Enjoy your lunch at a reputable establishment. After that, we'll continue our Cairo day tours with an Egyptian Museum tour, where we'll see the oldest artifacts in Cairo's [Egyptian Museum](#), which first opened to the public in 1902 and is home to the largest collection of antiquity.

Finally, you will be transferred to the oldest market in Cairo for an amazing shopping experience in the Khan El Khalili bazaar.

You will be transferred to the hotel for check-in and overnight in Cairo.
