Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Egypt

When you arrive at [Cairo International Airport](#), the tour leader from Cairo Top Tours will be there to greet you inside the terminal holding a signboard with your name on it. He will drive you to your hotel in Giza in a luxurious private air-conditioned vehicle. After our representative helps you check in smoothly, you can settle into your room when you get to the hotel. Be sure to double-check the pick-up times on the itinerary for your Cairo and Alexandria Wheelchair Accessible Tour Package.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids Tour, Saqqara Necropolis, Memphis City

At your Cairo hotel, savor a sumptuous breakfast in the early morning. Following the meeting with our representative to begin your tour of [the Giza pyramids](#), we will transfer you to the Great Pyramid of Cheops, which was constructed in the Giza necropolis 4500 years ago. You will have some free time during our accessible Egypt tours so that you can explore if you like or snap some pictures of the massive building.

While you visit the three pyramids, you will have the opportunity to enjoy a camel ride in the Giza Pyramids (an optional activity) to take amazing photos. Transfer to see [the Great Sphinx](#) in Giza, which stood as a guardian to the whole necropolis. It was carved from one stone 73 meters long in a figure of a lion with a man's head, smart like a human and as strong as the lion.

You will be transferred for a 35-minute drive to visit the open-air museum in the ancient city of Memphis, which was the capital of Egypt during [the Old Kingdom](#) and a very important city during the Middle Kingdom and the New Kingdom. Transfer to the Saqqara Necropolis, one of the richest and oldest archeological sites in the world. You will see the Step Pyramid, which is the oldest pyramid built by the famous architect Imhotep for King Djoser and is considered the first stone building in the world.

The tour includes visiting [the King Teti pyramid](#), inscribed with hieroglyphs and king cartouches, and the Mastaba tomb, a nobles' tomb in the form of a mastaba, decorated with colorful scenes of ancient Egypt's daily life. Now you can enjoy your lunch in a local restaurant in the village of Saqqara then we will move back to the hotel after finishing your exciting tours in Giza.

Day 3 : Egypt Museum, Coptic and Islamic Cairo Tours

Enjoy a breakfast at the hotel before your licensed tour guide takes you to the Egyptian Museum, a popular museum known for its vast collection of Egyptian antiques on two floors. The most intriguing exhibit is the royal treasure of the golden pharaoh Tutankhamen.

Move to [the Citadel of Saladin](#), which used to be the center of the Egyptian government for many centuries. Upon arrival, you will visit the Alabaster mosque of Mohamed Ali, considered a unique reflection of the Ottoman architecture in Egypt, and you will enjoy the [Islamic Cairo](#) trips with its several mosques, which are hundreds of years old, and some of them are even older than one thousand years.

Our Coptic Cairo tour will take you to see [the Roman fortress of Babylon](#) and the Hanging Church of the Holy Virgin Mary well known as Al Mualaka or the suspended church because it was built above the towers of the fortress. You will also visit the church of the Holy Family, or the Church of St. Sergius, which was built above the crypt inside which the Holy Family stayed for three months. Then we will go to Ben Ezra Synagogue, which, according to tradition, was built on the spot where the basket of baby Moses was found.

We will stop to have a delicious lunch, then we will continue our trips to [Khan El Khalili](#) bazaar and explore the walls and gates of medieval Cairo and the old streets dating back to the 10th century.

Our representative will take you back to your hotel and stay overnight in Cairo.

Day 4: Alexandria Trip from Cairo

After breakfast, get set to meet your proficient English-speaking Egyptologist guide to start the [day tour](#) to Alexandria from Cairo. We will transfer you from Cairo to Alexandria in air-conditioned vehicles. The trip takes about 2 and a half hours, and you will stop on the way for a break. Start your sightseeing at the well-known Pompey's Pillar, which was built in 297 BC to commemorate the victory of a Roman emperor by the name of Diocletian over a revolt in Alexandria.

Next, you'll be transferred to the Catacombs of [Kom El Shokkafa](#), which were discovered at the beginning of the 20th century and are thought to be one of the largest Roman burial places. Finally, you'll drive along the coast to [the Citadel of Qaitbay](#). Visit the oldest center of scientific research in history, the Bibliotheca of Alexandria. Located in the city that gives it its name, facing the Mediterranean, it was founded at the beginning of the 3rd century BC by Ptolemy I.

You will enjoy eating a seafood lunch made out of the freshest ingredients.

Finally, you will be transferred back to your hotel in Cairo.
