Day 1: Welcome to Cairo:

A representative from Cairo Top Tours will meet you at the <u>Cairo Airport</u> and transport you to your overnight hotel. We will go through your itinerary to make sure that all of the excursions in Egypt have been scheduled appropriately for your nine-day trip to <u>Cairo</u>, Luxor, Aswan, and Abu Simbel.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids / Saqqara / Memphis

Among the most magnificent sights on the planet are <u>the Great Sphinx</u> and the Pyramids of Giza. You will meet your private tour guide and proceed there after breakfast at the hotel. You can experience the wonders of the world that the Egyptian pharaohs created in this vast collection, ride camels among <u>the Giza pyramids</u>, and explore the Valley Temple of Khafra. Visit Memphis, another stunning site that was the capital of <u>the</u> Old Kingdom in ancient Egypt, after lunch.

The location of it is south of the Nile Delta. Prior to touring the Step Pyramid of King Djoser in Saqqara, one can view the enormous statue of Ramses II here along with other fascinating artifacts like the Alabaster Sphinx of Memphis. Among the magnificent tombs of the nobles are those facing the Pyramid of King Teti of the 6th dynasty and the tomb of Kagemni, which has some impressive scenes of ancient Egyptian art.

You will spend the night at the hotel after your tour of the Giza Pyramids.

Day 3: Egyptian Museum ,copitic and islamic Cairo

Our knowledgeable English-speaking Egyptologist guide will greet you after breakfast and take you in a private vehicle to the Egyptian Museum. Many magnificent monuments and historical artifacts can be found at the historical site known as the Egyptian Museum. Eating lunch at a local restaurant is enjoyable.

You can find out more about <u>Islamic Cairo</u> Tours by first touring the Saladin Citadel, built by Salah El Din <u>Al-Ayoubi</u>, and the Mohamed Ali Mosque, built in 1805 AD in the Turkish style and eerily resembling Turkey's Blue Mosque. On your tour of <u>Old Cairo</u>, which also takes in the Coptic area, you will see the Blessed Virgin Mary Church, also known as the Hanging Church, the Ben Ezra Synagogue, and <u>the cave</u>

Day 4: Arrive Luxor (The East Bank Tours)

After breakfast, check out of your <u>Cairo hotel</u>. A member of our staff will meet you there, and you will be driven to the airport in order to catch your flight to Luxor. Our guide will accompany you to your hotel upon your <u>arrival in Luxor</u> and assist with the check-in process. A sphinx avenue connects the Luxor Temple and <u>the Karnak Temple</u>, which are both located on the Luxor East Bank of the Nile. We'll start our tours of this area in the afternoon. Lunch at a restaurant in the neighborhood.

After leaving the hotel, you will make your way back to Luxor and spend the night there.

Day 5: Luxor West bank Sightseeing Tour

Our tour guide will pick you up at your <u>Luxor hotel</u> after breakfast, when you will meet with our representative. Afterwards, you will be transferred to the Wes Bank of Luxor excursions, which take you to some incredible places, such as the <u>Temple of Hatshepsut</u> and the Colossi of Memnon.

Among the women to ascend to the position of power in ancient Egypt was Hatshepsut, who ruled during the 18th dynasty of the newly established kingdom. midday meal at a nearby eatery. After leaving the hotel, you will travel back to Luxor and stay the night.

Day 6: Aswan Excursions (The High Dam - Unfinished Obelisk)

We'll drive to Aswan in an air-conditioned car after breakfast, where our guide will show you to your lodging. During <u>Aswan</u> day tours, guests will see <u>the High Dam</u> and the Unfinished Obelisk, two important projects for Egypt to control flooding on the banks of the Nile, after lunch at a nearby restaurant. Following that, you'll head back to your Aswan hotel.

Day 7: Aswan Excursions (Philae Temple Sound and Light Show)

Continue your tour of Aswan after breakfast by visiting the Philae Temple, one of the four sites where the events of the myth of Isis, Osiris, and Horus took place. The purpose of building this temple was to worship the goddess Isis.

Lunch is at a restaurant in the vicinity. Next, you will return to your <u>Aswan hotel</u> room. At the dock, a speedboat on <u>the River Nile</u> will be ready to transport you to the island home of the Philae Temple Sound and Light Show. You will travel through time and learn more about ancient Egyptian history with the help of

this application. One of the most breathtaking things to do in Aswan at night is this.

The Philae Temple was regularly submerged for six months of the year, putting its location in danger. After a major and vital campaign to try to keep it from disappearing due to the severe flooding of water that occurred in the middle of the 20th century, the temple was moved to the higher ground level of Agilika Island, where it is now.

Following the performance, you'll board a boat to return to the harbor, where a shuttle will transport you to your Aswan hotel.

Day 8: Tour to Abu Simbel Temples - Back to Cairo

Hotel breakfasts are provided. You will go on a private, air-conditioned tour of Abu Simbel with one of our staff members. You will go to the Temples of Ramses IV at <u>Abu Simbel</u>. You'll travel back to Aswan, spend the night at your hotel, and then take a flight back to Cairo.

Day 9: Final Departure

Our representative will pick you up at the hotel after a filling breakfast and drive you to Cairo International Airport in time for your last flight home. We hope your nine-day tour of Cairo, Luxor, Aswan, and Abu Simbel was enjoyable.
