Day 1: Arrival in Cairo

A representative from Cairo Top Tours will meet you and help you at <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, then drive you to your hotel in Cairo in a private air-conditioned vehicle. Your 6 Days Cairo and Nile Cruise Wheelchair Accessible Itinerary will then be reviewed to see if you would like to add any additional trips in Egypt.

Day 2: The Great Pyramid, Egyptian Museum, Coptic Cairo

Start the <u>tour to the Giza pyramids</u> were built during <u>the Fourth Dynasty</u> of the Old Kingdom in ancient <u>Egypt</u> and are considered to be one of the best <u>things to do in Cairo</u>. The site also includes several cemeteries and the remains of a worker's village. Then your specialist Egyptologist will take you to see the Sphinx and outline for you all the historical details regarding this huge statue, and lastly, you will proceed to the Valley Temple or what we call the mummification temple of king Chephren.

Then, your private driver and tour guide will take you to the Egyptian Museum so you can explore its exhibits and marvel at Tutankhamun's treasures. Stop to eat your delightful lunch and you will relish the Coptic Cairo tour to see the old churches and synagogues beginning with the Hanging Church built above the ruins of an ancient Roman fortress of Babylon, the Cavern Church of Abu Serga where the holy family took shelter for few months during the holy family journey to Egypt, as well as Ben Ezra Synagogue, the oldest Jewish temple in Egypt. Back to the hotel and overnight after enjoying a gournet lunch.

Day 3: Cairo to Aswan By Air

After breakfasting in your hotel, continue your Egypt wheelchair accessible tours. After you check out, a representative from Cairo Top Tours will drive you the roughly one-hour distance from Giza to Cairo International Airport. Take the hour-long flight to Aswan that you have reserved. One of the most highly recommended Egypt Nile River Cruises, your 5-star Nile Cruise from Aswan to Luxor will be waiting for

you when you arrive.

In the late afternoon, your certified tour guide and driver will pick you up so you can enjoy a Felucca ride on the River Nile around <u>Kitchener's Island</u> and the Agha Khan Mausoleum. Evening tea. Enjoy the open-buffet dinner that will be provided on the boat, and take in the Nubian folklore performance. You have the opportunity to see <u>the Philae Temple</u> sound and light show to learn more about the <u>Osiris</u> and Isis myth in such a wonderful setting.

Day 4: Aswan Tours, Kom Ombo Temple, Sail to Edfu

After enjoying your breakfast aboard your Aswan to Luxor Nile Cruise, Your Aswan Day tours will take you on a tour to see one of the most outstanding modern projects that are completely associated with raising Egyptian income. It's the famous Aswan High Dam. <u>The Unfinished Obelisk</u> block of stone was destined to become an obelisk almost 40 meters high. The unfinished obelisk weighs more than 1000 tons.

Visit the Temple of Philae to see the main temple honoring Goddess Isis, the mother of Horus. Observe the two granite lions that guard the temple's entrance; they date from the late Roman period and exhibit Byzantine influences. Return to your opulent boat and set sail for Kom Ombo on the Nile cruise. Lunch will be served as an open-buffet buffet while you sail. When you arrive, you will be greeted by your personal tour guide and begin your amazing journey to the Temple of Kom Ombo, a double temple built during the Ptolemaic dynasty and dedicated to God Horus and God Sobek, a crocodile-related evil spirit in ancient Egyptian mythology. The Nile Cruise vessel will then depart for Edfu. Take pleasure in your afternoon tea while at sea, Captain's welcome drink.

Dinner will be served aboard the cruise and disco music in the lounge bar for tonight's entertainment. Overnight on board at Edfu.

Day 05 : Edfu Temple, Sail to Luxor

Your tour guide will meet you on your boat after breakfast and take you on a sightseeing tour to the Temple of Horus in Edfu, which features some of the best Horus-related architecture from the Ptolemaic era. The entrance to the temple is guarded by a sizable granite statue of Horus. The Double Crown of Upper and Lower Egypt is placed atop it. Once you have learned everything there is to know about Edfu, you will board the Nile Cruise ship once more and set sail for Luxor. Both your lunch and afternoon tea will be served on board.

In the evening your high-quality dinner is included onboard the ship, then you will enjoy a wonderful traditional Galabya party.

Day 6: Luxor Excursions, Back to Cairo for Final Departure

In the early morning of your final day during the tours in Egypt, take your breakfast aboard the Nile cruise vessel and start disembarkation from your Nile cruise vessel.
