Day 1 : Arrival to Cairo and visiting Sakkara and Dahshur Pyramids

Explore the wonders of ancient Egypt in just one day with this exciting tour! Your tour begins with a meet and greet at Cairo International Airport, followed by a visit to the iconic [Giza Pyramids](#) and Sphinx where your expert guide will provide a comprehensive explanation of their construction and history.

Next, you will be transferred to Saqqara to visit the famous [Step Pyramid](#) of King Djoser, created by the brilliant architect Imhotep. Enjoy a delicious lunch during the tour before heading to the Dahshur Pyramids, including the Bent Pyramid and [Red Pyramid](#) of King Senefru.

Your final stop for the day is Memphis, where you will view one of two massive statues of Ramses II. After a full day of exploration, you will return to your hotel for check-in and free time in the evening.

Day 2 : Alexandria Day Tour

Indulge in a luxurious seafood lunch at a high-end restaurant in Alexandria before visiting the Modern Bibliotheca of Alexandria, comprising three buildings. Explore the city's main squares, local markets, and landmarks before returning to Cairo with a coffee or tea break midway.

Spend another night at the hotel in Cairo. This one-day itinerary is perfect for travelers who want to experience the best of Alexandria in a short amount of time. Meals included for you: Breakfast and lunch.

Day 3 : Cairo Tour

- Visit [the Egyptian Museum](#) and discover the world's most extensive collection of Egyptian antiquities, including the golden mask and coffins of King Tutankhamun.
- Explore the [Citadel of Saladin](#), a fortress built to protect Egypt from Crusaders. Visit the Mohamed Ali Alabaster Mosque, built in the 19th century by King Mohammed Ali.
- Enjoy a nice lunch before embarking on a journey through Coptic Cairo.
- Visit the ancient Roman fortress of Babylon, the Hanging Church suspended on towers, the church of St Sergius, and the Ben Ezra Synagogue.
- Stroll down [El Moez Ledin Ellah](#) Street in Islamic Cairo, see the Al Azhar mosque, and take a break at El Fishawy, the oldest cafe in [Khan El Khalili](#), where you can enjoy a Turkish coffee or a special mango juice.
- Return to the hotel and stay overnight in Cairo.

Day 4 : Cairo to Luxor

Begin your day with a domestic flight from Cairo to Luxor, the world's greatest open-air museum. On arrival, kick off your tour with the magnificent West Bank, home to the [Valley of the Kings](#). We'll have the opportunity to explore three fascinating tombs, each adorned with intricate artwork and rich symbolism. Explore three fascinating tombs of New Kingdom pharaohs, then marvel at the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut and the [Colossi of Memnon](#), two massive statues that once stood in front of King Amenophis III's mortuary temple.

Post a delightful local lunch, cross to Luxor's East Bank to visit the grand Complex of [Karnak Temple](#), an awe-inspiring site representing over 2,000 years of construction and dedication by various rulers. Walk the Avenue of the Sphinxes, and witness the hypostyle hall, the largest Obelisk, and the sacred lake. End the day with the architectural splendor of the [Luxor Temple](#), an architectural masterpiece that stands as a symbol of ancient Egyptian grandeur.

Optional: Attend the Sound and Light Show at Karnak Temple.

Overnight in Luxor with breakfast and lunch included.

Day 5: Luxor to Aswan

Depart from Luxor at 7:00 AM and embark on a 3-hour scenic drive to Aswan. Start your Aswan adventure with a visit to the Aswan [High Dam](#) an engineering marvel constructed during the era of President Gamal Abdel Nasser, a symbol of modern Egypt's economic development. Afterward, enjoy a boat ride to the [Philae Temple](#), situated on an island in the Nile. This ancient sanctuary is an amalgamation of architectural wonders from various periods in Egypt's history, including the Pharaonic, Ptolemaic, Roman, and Christian eras. Among its notable monuments are the Temple of Isis, the Temple of Horus, the Temple of Hathor, and the Kiosk.

Relish a local lunch in Aswan before checking into your hotel. Your day concludes with an overnight stay in Aswan, with breakfast and lunch included.

Day 6 : Abu Simbel to Cairo

After breakfast, your Egyptologist guide will escort you to the awe-inspiring [Abu Simbel](#) temples. These iconic ancient Egyptian temples are a testament to the grandeur and engineering prowess of the pharaohs. Carved out of the mountainside by Ramses II, also known as Ramesses II or Ramesses the Great, was one of ancient Egypt's most celebrated and powerful pharaohs. Return to Aswan by 1:00 PM, then catch a flight back to Cairo.

Upon arrival in Cairo, a representative will guide you to your hotel for check-in and overnight stay. Your day concludes with a well-earned rest, with breakfast and lunch included.
