

Day 1: Visit Abu Simbel Temples

When you arrive, our Tour leader will welcome you and help. You will be driven to the wonderful Movenpick Prince Abbas Lake Nasser trip for your 4-Day to Aswan [Lake Nasser](#) trip in a contemporary, air-conditioned vehicle.

Enjoy a delicious meal at this elegant cruise diner. The magnificent and historic [Abu Simbel Temples](#) will be the highlight of your first tour.

You'll return to the cruise ship for a lovely afternoon tea after viewing the Abu Simbel temples. At [Philae Temple](#), you will also have the option of attending an unusual sound and light display (additional ticket required).

Dinner on board and a lovely night's sleep in your cabin at Abu Simbel will round out your day.

Day 2: Kasr Ibrim/ Amada Temple/ Derr Temple/ Wadi El Seboua

Following the serving of breakfast on the Movenpick Prince Abbas Lake Nasser Cruise, you will prepare to set sail for Kasr Ibrim. Your cruise ship will make a 15-minute halt, allowing you the opportunity to capture some pictures of the location from the sundeck.

You will be transferred to three ancient sites after your brief stay in Kasr Ibrim, starting with the [Temple of Amada](#), which is said to be Nubia's earliest temple. Next, you will see the Temple of Der. Once you get back aboard the cruise ship, you will start cruising to [Wadi El Seboua](#), also known as the Valley of the Lions. A delicious lunch will be served along the way, and an afternoon tea will be served a little later.

You'll enjoy a drink at a small cocktail reception party in the evening before it's time to eat another delectable dinner and see an entertaining Nubian Show. We'll spend tonight on the boat at Wadi El Seboua.

Day 3 : Wadi El Seboua Excursion and Sailing to Aswan

After breakfast, visit the Temples of [Wadi El Seboua](#) with a professional guide. These temples, dedicated to god Amun and established by Ramses II, were dismantled and relocated to higher ground due to rising water levels from the Aswan [High Dam](#). Return to the Movenpick Prince Abbas Lake Nasser Cruise and enjoy the rest of the day at your leisure, including lunch and afternoon tea. Have dinner on board and spend the night in Aswan. Included meals: Breakfast, lunch, and dinner.

Day 4: Sightseeing and Disembarkation at Aswan

Start your day with a delicious breakfast before visiting the [Kalabsha Temple](#) with an Egyptologist guide. This temple from the Greco-Roman period is one of the most extraordinary examples of Egyptian architecture in Nubia and was relocated to higher ground to preserve it from the rising water level of Lake Nasser. Admire the fine decorations and artwork as your guide explains their significance.
