

Day 1: Wednesday - High Dam - Philae Temple

After your flight lands in Aswan, our tour guide will meet you there and help you transfer to the MS Blue Shadow Nile cruise where you can check in and start your amazing Aswan day tour. First, you'll visit the Aswan [High Dam](#), which has significantly increased storage capacity. Next, you'll go to the [Temple of Philae](#), a temple in the Greco-Roman style that was built to honor the goddess Isis and is one of the four locations where the legend of Isis, Osiris You should return to your Egypt Nile River Cruise for lunch and dinner.

Day 2: Thursday - Kom Ombo Temple - Edfu Temple

After serving up a delectable breakfast on board your deluxe Egypt Nile River Cruise, we'll head to [Kom Ombo](#) to carry on with our Blue Shadow Nile Cruise. Your Egyptologist tour guide will join you to explore the God-built Kom Ombo Temple when we get to the town. One entrance is dedicated to the crocodile-shaped Deity Sobek, and the other one is to the falcon-headed Deity Haroeris. Then you'll continue sailing to the next port of call to see Horus Temple, commonly known as [Edfu Temple](#), Lunch and dinner will be served on the cruise ship.

Day 3: Friday - Luxor Tours

Start your day on the Aswan to Luxor Nile River Cruise with a delicious breakfast before setting sail to Esna and Luxor for your [Egypt day tours](#). Begin with a [Luxor day tour](#) to the East and West Bank, visiting the [Valley of the Kings](#), where over 60 tombs have been discovered, including those of famous pharaohs such as Tutankhamun. You'll also visit the Temple of [Deir El Bahari](#), known as the Queen Hatshepsut Temple, and the [Colossi of Memnon](#), two enormous statues of the great King Amenhotep III.

Next, continue your Luxor excursions with a visit to the [Karnak Temples](#), the largest temple in Egypt, which covers an enormous area and was built and expanded over 2000 years. Then, explore Luxor Temple, one of the most spectacular temples in Egypt and the most important monument in Luxor. Throughout the day.
