He had a human body with a falcon's head and was the son of Isis and Osiris. Then Esna will be reached by boat. Take pleasure in your afternoon tea while sailing. A second elegant supper will be served on the cruise ship in the evening. You will spend the night on your Nile Cruise in Esna, and the entertainment will be a really amazing Egyptian Galabeya Party.
