Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Saqqara Necropolis, and Quad Biking in Giza

On the second day of the trip, after enjoying a delicious breakfast at the hotel, you'll head to the [Giza Pyramids](#) complex, which is located in the Giza Necropolis. This iconic site is home to the Great Pyramid of Giza, also known as the Cheops Pyramid, as well as the Pyramid of Khafre (Chephren) and the Pyramid of Menkaure (Mecerinus). You'll also have the opportunity to see [the Great Sphinx](#) of Giza and explore the associated pyramid complexes. If you're interested, you can also opt for a camel ride around the pyramids.

Afterward, the tour will continue to Saqqara, where you'll see [the Step Pyramid](#) of King Djoser, which is considered to be the first stone pyramid in history. You'll also visit the tomb of Kagemni, among other tombs of the nobles, in front of the [Pyramid of King Teti](#) from the 6th dynasty.

For lunch, you'll enjoy a delicious meal in one of the most beautiful restaurants overlooking the pyramids and the Sphinx. Afterward, you'll embark on an adventurous quad biking tour of the Giza Pyramids for one hour. You'll meet a Bedouin guide who will give you an introductory session on how to use the quad bike before setting off on the tour. After a thrilling experience, you'll return to the hotel for the night.

Your meals for the day will include breakfast and lunch.

Day 3: Egyptian Museum - Coptic Cairo Tour - Nile Cruise Dinner

On the third day of the trip, after breakfast, you'll meet up with your Egyptologist guide to start your Cairo city tour. The first stop will be [the Egyptian Museum](#), located in the famous Tahrir Square. Here, you'll have about 2 hours to explore the museum's vast collection of over 120,000 artifacts from different periods in Egyptian history. One of the highlights of the museum is the golden collection of King [Tutankhamun](#) from the New Kingdom, which was discovered in 1922 inside his tomb in the Valley of the Kings.

Afterward, you'll head to the area of Old Cairo to start your Coptic Cairo tour. You'll visit the Roman fortress of Babylon, which is now mostly in ruins except for the base where [the Hanging Church](#) of the Holy Virgin Mary was built, suspended on two towers of the fortress. You'll also visit the Cavern Church of St. Sergius and the oldest [synagogue of Ben Ezra](#), which was once a Christian church and was later sold to a wealthy Jewish man named Ben Ezra.

Later in the evening, you'll get ready for a fancy dinner cruise on the Nile in Cairo. Your tour leader will transfer you to the cruise boat on the Nile corniche, where you'll board for 2 hours to enjoy an [Egyptian](#)

[cuisine](#) buffet dinner while being entertained by belly dancing and the Tanoura dance show. You'll then be transferred back to the hotel for the night.

Your meals for the day will include breakfast, lunch, and dinner.
