Day 1: Arrive in Cairo, Check-In

Day 2: Memphis, Saqqara, and the Giza Pyramids

On day 2 Following breakfast at the hotel, you and your group tour will see Memphis, Saqqara, and the Giza Pyramids.

Any visitor to Egypt must see the Giza Pyramids. They are among the most well-known landmarks in Egypt and one of the Seven Wonders of the World. While there has been much conjecture throughout the years regarding the exact purpose of these pyramids, they were originally constructed as pharaohs' tombs. You will have the opportunity to explore Memphis, a historic city that was the capital of Egypt throughout its Old Kingdom era (2686 - 2181 B.C.), in addition to getting a close-up look at these amazing structures. Additionally, you'll get time to see Saqqara, a significant necropolis in southern Egypt.

Explore another nobleman's tomb at Saqqara, owned by the son-in-law of the sixth-dynasty king Teti.

Day 3: Tours of Alexandria, Cairo to Alexandria

After breakfast, you will head off early in the morning with your authorized tour guide to explore Alexandria, which was named the most beautiful city in the world for centuries and was built in 332 B.C. by Alexander the Great, a well-known leader of the Greco-Roman era. Once you arrive, you will first view the Pompey Pillar and then the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa, which were formerly the tombs of Egyptian nobles and are now open to the public. The art style that combined elements of Roman and Pharaonic art will astound you.

Continue your day journey to Alexandria from Cairo to view the Citadel of Qaitbay, built on the site of the historic Lighthouse Pharos, which is now destroyed but was once considered one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World.

After enjoying a delicious lunch of fresh seafood at one of Alexandria's most elegant eateries with a view of the bay, you will go to the contemporary Bibliotheca of Alexandria to experience one of the most stunning architectural feats in modern history.

Day 4: Alexandria to Marsa Matrouh and El-Alamein WWII Cemetery

After that, spend some time relaxing on the beach. check-in, and spend the night.
