Itinerary Day 1: Arrive Cairo, Egypt

A Cairo Top Tours representative will receive you at [Cairo International Airport](#) upon your arrival. He will help you at the airport with the necessary tasks. He then takes you to a luxury, air-conditioned car, where he will help you check in at your hotel. After checking in, he will review your 10-day itinerary with you to confirm departure times for each tour and activity.

Day 2: Pyramids and Cairo Tours

On the second day of your trip, our guide will take you to visit the [Great Pyramids](#), one of the Seven Wonders of the World. Our first stop is the Great Pyramid of [Khufu](#), which took more than 20 years to build. The next stop is the family-related pyramids of kings [Mecerinus](#) and [Khafre](#). You will be exposed to the famous Sphinx, a lion with the head of a human who has guarded the cemetery for 450 years.

You will continue your tour of the [Egyptian Museum](#) after seeing the Pyramids of Giza by going to the Museum of Egyptian Antiquities, which was established in 1902 and contains some of the oldest artifacts ever found in human history, including more than 120,000 tools and implements used by the ancient Egyptians in their daily lives, huge coffins, enormous statues, and King Tutankhamun's gold collection.

You will then have lunch at a nearby fine dining restaurant before completing your day trip to Egypt with an educational tour. To [Coptic Cairo](#) to visit the ancient [Roman citadel of Babylon](#), the [Hanging Church](#) that was built hanging from its ancient towers, and the [Church of St. Sergius](#), which is also famous for its beauty. Your tour of Coptic Cairo extends until we visit the Ben Ezra Synagogue, believed to be the site of the castle where Moses' chest was pulled from the Nile by the Pharaoh's daughter.

Day 3: Alexandria Trip

After breakfast, you will meet your tour guide to start your journey from Cairo to Alexandria, the pride of the Mediterranean, with its renowned [Qaitbay citadel](#) from the 15th century. Alexander the Great erected Alexandria to compete with the best Greek and Roman cities of the time. [The Pompey Pillar](#), nearby Roman ruins, [the Bibliotheca Alexandria](#), and [the Kom El-Shoqafa](#) Roman catacombs will all be places you explore. You will eat lunch there and stay the night at the Alexandria hotel.

Day 4: Alamein World War II Cemetery and Military Museum

Prior to getting ready for the day trip from Cairo to El Alamein, enjoy a delicious breakfast at the hotel. Prepare to visit the World War II Commonwealth Cemetery and Military Museum, where you can look over information about the conflict and learn more about the conflicts that happened close to El Alamein. Visit the Italian, German, and Australian cemeteries before being driven back to Cairo for the evening.

Day 5: Fly to Luxor - East Bank Tours

After finishing a delicious breakfast at your hotel, you will be transferred by private air-conditioned car to Cairo Airport to board a domestic flight to Luxor.

Our private guide will meet you at the airport. To begin your [Egypt Nile Cruise](#), you will be transported to Luxor. As your cruise ship navigates the Nile River, savor lunch on board. On the east bank of the Nile, [the Luxor Temple](#) and [Karnak Temple](#) are good places to start your explorations in Luxor.

You will be taken to your cruise after the tour is over.

Day 6: Luxor West Bank Tours

You'll have breakfast on the cruise before beginning your tour of the [West Bank of Luxor](#). You start your journey by visiting [the Valley of the Kings](#). The Valley of the Kings, home to the royal tombs of our great kings, is one of the most picturesque sites in Luxor. King Tuthmosis I of the Eighteenth Dynasty was the first king buried there.

Following, visit the legendary [Temple of Queen Hatshepsut](#), which was built in 1500 B.C. and is also known as [Deir el-Bahari](#). Hatshepsut was the first female pharaoh in Egyptian history.

Next, you will visit the [Colossi of Memnon](#). The statue of Memnon dates back to King Amenhotep III, whose construction was supervised by the famous architect Amenhotep bin Habu.

Prior to sailing to Edfu, savor a leisurely lunch on board. You will be taken to your cruise after the tour is over.

Spend the night on the Nile Cruise.

Day 7: Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

early in the morning, eat breakfast. Then start day tour by visit Temple of Horus in [Edfu](#). Then sail to [Kom Ombo](#) to visit the charming Kom Ombo Temple dedicated to the crocodile god Sobek.

Day 8: Aswan Sighting Tours

Enjoy your breakfast as you cruise along the Nile before beginning your Aswan day tours. The "[Unfinished Obelisk](#)," the largest ancient obelisk, and the [High Dam](#) are ideal starting points for your trip to Aswan. Visit the Queen Hatshepsut's Unfinished Obelisk in Egypt after that. The grand Temple of Isis and Hathor at Philae, which was built by Ptolemy II and finished by Roman emperors in honor of the goddess Isis, mother of Horus and goddess of magic, is a must-see on the final trip to Aswan.

Dinner and overnight on board the Nile cruise.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner.

Day 9: Optional tour of Abu Simbel

Enjoy breakfast while sailing on the Nile River, 3.5 hours required for the optional excursion to [Abu Simbel Temples](#). We offer you a wonderful opportunity to Abu Simbel to see the most amazing Egyptian temple built by [Ramesses II](#). (Optional activity) We promise that you will like it and will remain in your memory.
