

Day 1: Cairo to the white desert

The journey from Cairo to the White Desert is an exciting adventure that takes you from the bustling Egyptian capital to the stunning and otherworldly landscapes of the White Desert.

After exploring the White Desert, head to the nearby [Valley of Agabat](#). This valley is known for its stunning sand dunes and rock formations.

Enjoy a delicious campfire dinner under the starry desert sky. The White Desert is known for its excellent stargazing opportunities due to its remote location and lack of light pollution.

Day 2: Bahariya Oasis tour

You will have breakfast in the desert before travelling to Bahariya Oasis. On the way back, you'll make a stop at [Crystal Mountain](#), also known locally as Gebel al-Izzaz.

The hill's moniker, "the Jewel of the Desert," and its spectacular look when lit by the sun are attributed to the quartzite crystals that make up the hill, which can be seen on the right. That innate characteristic was stumbled upon a few decades ago.

Next, we will visit Bir Sigam is a hot spring that can help people with rheumatism soak in the heat there.

Spend the night at your Bahariya hotel after returning there by car.

Day 3: Tour to Fayoum Oasis & Wadi Al Rian

Begin your day with a hearty breakfast at your accommodation in the White Desert or any nearby town where you might have stayed overnight.

Leave the White Desert and head towards Fayoum Oasis, which is approximately a 4-5 hour drive, depending on your starting point. [Fayoum](#) is a lush oasis known for its agricultural fields, serene lakes, and unique landscapes.

Upon reaching Fayoum, visit [Qarun Lake](#), one of Egypt's largest saltwater lakes. You can enjoy a relaxing stroll along the lake's shore, take in the picturesque views, and watch local fishermen at work.

Have lunch at a local restaurant in Fayoum town or any available eateries nearby. Try some traditional Egyptian dishes featuring locally sourced ingredients.

After lunch, drive to [Wadi Al Rian](#), a beautiful desert canyon located in the Wadi El Rayan Protected Area. It's known for its waterfalls and is an ideal spot for a refreshing swim.

Finally, you will take a trip to the Fayoum water wheels. Then set off on a lovely journey on a felucca, a stylish gaff-rigged wooden sailing craft.
