Day 1 : Arrive Cairo - Check-in

At [Cairo International Airport](#), a Cairo Top Tours representative will meet you and assist you with a seamless exit. An air-conditioned van will take you comfortably to your accommodation. Your tour guide will review your itinerary for the Cairo, Nile Cruise, and Red Sea Tour once you arrive at the hotel and will confirm the pick-up dates for your Egypt travel packages. Additionally, they will facilitate a quick check-in process for you.

Either choose to reserve a tour for the Sound and Light Show at the Giza Pyramids region, or choose to spend your first evening at leisure.

Spend a night at a hotel in Cairo.

Have a drink as welcoming from your hotel.

Day 2 : Giza Pyramids & Sphinx and Sakkara tour

At Cairo International Airport, a representative from Cairo Top Tours will be waiting with a sign bearing your name. After that, they will drive you in a private air-conditioned vehicle to your hotel. When you arrive, they will assist you in swiftly and easily checking in.

You can take some time to unwind on your first evening or, if you want, you can head to Giza to see the Sound and Light Show. Breakfast at the hotel will mark the beginning of the first day, which will be followed by a meeting with your own Egyptologist from Cairo Top Tours. They will lead you on the Giza excursions, making it simple for you to learn about King Cheops' Great Pyramid and that of his sons, Chephren and Mycerinus. Should you decide to participate in the optional activity of taking a camel ride near the [Giza Pyramids](#), they will also assist you in getting the most unforgettable images of the landmarks. You will next be transported to see the well-known Sphinx, which has been watching over the necropolis for more than 4500 years.

After learning about how the pyramids were built, you can visit [the Valley Temple of King Chephren](#) to learn more about the ancient Egyptian mummification process's greatest mysteries. Every pyramid complex in the

past was made up of a burial tomb (which was the pyramid itself), a mortuary temple, and a valley temple. The King Khafre pyramid complex is the only one of the structures at the location that is largely unaltered. The pharaoh performed pre-burial rites at the valley temple.

The Giza Pyramids trip includes a panoramic outing that provides a view of every pyramid in Giza and enables visitors to take priceless photos as keepsakes.

The alabaster sphinx statue of Ramses II is on display in the open-air museum at the location of [Memphis](#), the former pharaonic capital during the time of the pyramids or the new kingdom.

After a delectable lunch, you will go to Saqqara, one of Egypt's most important archaeological sites. At Saqqara, you can witness the [Step Pyramid](#) Complex and the pyramid of King Djoser, the first structure ever constructed entirely out of six stone bases stacked on top of one another. Additionally, you will have the chance to visit the Kagemni tomb and the Pyramid of Teti, two of the Nobles' tombs.

Your day will be at the end by reaching your hotel.

Stay overnight at a hotel in Cairo.

Day 3 : Cairo sightseeing tour

You can continue your Egypt Tours Packages with the aid of your private tour guide after savoring the open buffet breakfast at your Cairo hotel. Your first trip should be [The Egyptian Museum](#), which has two levels and houses the largest collection of Egyptian artifacts in the entire world. You will also get to witness King Tutankhamen's amazing royal riches, which were found undamaged. The Royal Mummies, Huge Statues, Royal Golden Possessions, and Beautifully Designed Accessories of the Egyptian Queens enrich the Egyptian Museum.

You might anticipate visiting Coptic Cairo after your tour of the Egyptian Museum is over. You may see the crypt where the holy family lived for almost three months during a time of persecution at [the Hanging Church](#), which was built above the towers of the ancient Roman citadel known as Babylon, and at the church of Abu Serga. You will visit the Ben Ezra Synagogue as part of your [Coptic Cairo](#) trip, which is where the Pharaoh's daughter supposedly found the basket with baby Moses in the Nile, in accordance with Jewish legend.

You will be accompanied by a private vehicle and guide to see [the Citadel of Saladin](#) after eating lunch at a local restaurant. This destination stands out among all of our Cairo tours because it offers a beautiful view of the ancient mosques, domes, and minarets that make up Islamic Cairo. In 1805, Mohamed Ali built the mosque, which was inspired by Turkish architecture.

After being moved, your [Islamic Cairo](#) tours will begin, where you can tour the ancient streets, gates, and walls of Fatimid Cairo. In Cairo's Khan El Khalili Bazaar, you will also get a one-of-a-kind shopping experience.

You can choose to dine on a Nile boat in Cairo after taking an evening tour.

Lunch and breakfast are provided.

Day 04 : Cairo to Aswan and Embarkation to Myfair Nile cruise

After savoring the hotel's breakfast buffet, your tour guide from Cairo Top Tours will drive you to the airport so you can take your flight to Aswan or Luxor, depending on the company running your program.

Our agent will meet you at the Aswan airport when you arrive and drive you to the start of your Egypt Nile Cruise Tours before lunch. A tour guide will meet you in the lobby later in the day and take you on a relaxing Felucca boat ride around Kitchener's Island and the Agha Khan Mausoleum. On the Nile Cruise, afternoon tea will be given before a sumptuous dinner and a beautiful Nubian folkloric display. Above the Nile River, in Aswan, you will spend the night.

Day 05: Aswan Tours/ Kom Ombo

The High Dam, which was constructed under the administration of the late president Nasser, will be the first stop. The revolution against Ottoman King Farouk was headed by this guy. [The Unfinished Obelisk](#) at the granite quarries will then be visible to visitors. The sun deity Amun Ra was honored by the construction of this obelisk during the reign of Queen Hatshepsut. In order to learn more about the Isis and Osiris story, the [Temple of Philae](#) will also be visited. This temple in Egypt was converted into a Coptic church during the Roman Empire. Following that, guests will be returned to the Nile Cruise, from where they will depart for Kom Ombo. Visitors can savor their buffet meal throughout the voyage. Prior to embarking on a ship for Edfu, travelers will first visit the [Temple of Kom Ombo](#) upon arrival in Kom Ombo. Visitors will delight in afternoon tea and the stunning surroundings along the way. A fantastic supper made onboard will follow the Captain's welcome cocktail, which will be served in semi-casual clothing. Discotheque music will be played as entertainment following dinner.

Day 6 : Sightseeing at Edfu Temple

Prior to riding in a horse-drawn carriage to the Temple of [Edfu](#), you will be provided with a high-quality breakfast on the MS Mayfair Nile cruise. Horus, the son of Osiris and Isis, is the subject of this temple, which was constructed during the Ptolemaic Period. Greek characters are mixed in with traditional Egyptian themes. You can have lunch on board and afternoon tea on the upper deck while sailing to Luxor. The tour guides will set up an Egyptian Galabya party for each group, and dinner will also be served aboard the boat. We humbly request your participation.

Day 7: Luxor East and West Bank tour to Hurghada

After enjoying your final open buffet breakfast aboard the MS Mayfair Nile cruise, disembark and begin your incredible [west bank of Luxor tour](#). You will have the opportunity to explore the Valley of the Kings, a royal necropolis where pharaohs such as Tutankhamen and Ramses II, as well as queens and other elites from the 18th, 19th, and 20th dynasties were laid to rest. Additionally, you will marvel at the [Colossi of Memnon](#), which were once part of a mortuary temple located in Thebes (now Luxor). Although the temple itself has been destroyed, the statue of Amenhotep III still stands as an impressive masterpiece. Finally, visit the [El Deir El Bahari temple](#), also known as the temple of Queen Hatshepsut.

Proceed with your East Bank tour in Luxor and visit the [Karnak temples](#) complex, known as the largest ancient religious site globally, along with [the temple of Luxor](#). Once the tour is complete, a modern air-conditioned vehicle will transport you to Hurghada, which takes approximately three hours. Upon arrival, you'll be taken to the Marriott Hurghada resort for an overnight stay.

Day 8 : Free day at Hurghada
