Day 1: Arrival to Cairo and check in

Our agent will be waiting for you inside your terminal at Cairo International Airport with a signboard that has both your name and the name of the company, Cairo Top Tours. He will transport you to your Cairo lodging in a luxury, air-conditioned vehicle. Check in at the hotel. Our expert will assist you with a smooth check-in and go over the schedule of your Egypt family trip package with you to go over and update all pick-up timings for your tours in Egypt.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids Tour / Egyptian Museum Tour

To start your tour to the Giza Pyramids, meet our representative at the hotel early in the morning. You will visit the Great Sphinx, the Valley Temple, and the three colossal pyramids in Giza that were built for the three kings of the old kingdom, Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus. The mythological figure is considered to have been built for King Khafra. With the help of a Bedouin guide, you'll have the fantastic opportunity to ride camels around the Giza Pyramids during your tour in order to capture the best pictures possible.

Then, proceed to the well-known Tahrir Square in central Cairo to start your personalized tour of the Egyptian Museum. The Egyptian Museum, which was founded in 1902 and has hundreds of sculptures and coffins, is home to various relics. Your tour guide will be able to fill you in on a plethora of knowledge about these items.

After your day trips in Cairo are over, take a transfer back to the hotel. We'll have lunch at a local restaurant after that.

Day 3 : old cairo tours

From your hotel, our tour guide will pick you up to go to the most popular sites in old Cairo.

We'll now travel to Old Cairo for an informative tour of <u>Coptic Cairo</u>. The Holy Virgin Mary <u>Hanging Church</u>, which predates the establishment of Christianity in Egypt, is located here. Additionally, you'll witness the Ben Ezra Synagogue, which is the oldest Jewish house of worship in Egypt, and the Cavern Church of Saint Sergius.

Day 4 : Cairo to Luxor, East Bank of Luxor Tour

Check out of your Cairo hotel and be driven to the Cairo International Airport by a Cairo Top Tours representative in a vehicle. Fly to Luxor, where you will be met by our representative and driven to the port for your Luxor to Aswan Nile Cruise. Starting in Luxor and ending in Aswan, your Nile boat tours.

<u>The Temple of Luxor</u> and <u>the Karnak Temple</u>, two of the largest and most significant temples in ancient Egypt built by numerous monarchs including Amenhotep III, are the places to start your travels in Luxor today.

On board and overnight, take advantage of the lunch and dinner buffets.

Day 5: West Bank of Luxor/ Edfu

On the Nile cruise ship, savor a hearty breakfast before meeting your guide to start your west bank of Luxor tours. You'll go to the Valley of the Kings, where you can see several rock-cut tombs for various kings of ancient Egypt, as well as the Colossi of Memnon, the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, which was built by Hatshepsut, a well-known and strong queen during the 18th dynasty.

Return to your cruise ship and spend the night there.

Day 6: Visit to The temple of Edfu / the temple of Kom Ombo

On the Nile River Cruise, breakfast is served as an open buffet. Then, be ready as your knowledgeable Egyptologist guide leads you to the admirably preserved Edfu Ptolemaic-style temple, which is dedicated to God Horus, who in ancient Egyptian mythology is the protector of monarchy. You can tour the Temple of Kom Ombo, which is devoted to the crocodile Gods Sobek and Haroeris, after being brought back to the ship. Take pleasure in your meal while the Nile cruise ship makes its way toward Aswan.

On board your luxurious Nile cruise, a sumptuous meal will be served as you enjoy the Nubian Show while spending the night at Aswan.

Day 7: Aswan Tours

On board the boat, savor your delicious breakfast before you arrive in the gorgeous city of Aswan to see the iconic Aswan High Dam. This building was constructed to decrease the annual flooding of the Nile's catastrophic effects. We will take you by boat to the spectacular shrine of Philae, an island shrine dedicated to the goddess Isis. The next largest known Obelisk in the Aswan granite quarries is the Unfinished Obelisk, which was probably constructed by Queen Hatshepsut.

Once your Aswan sightseeing tours are complete, your tour guide will bring you back to the cruise ship.

Enjoy your meal and the night on the ship.

Day 8: Disembarkation, Back to Cairo

You now have a wonderful opportunity to travel to <u>Abu Simbel</u>, the most beautiful Egyptian temple built by Ramses II, by land or air early in the morning. (Picky Activity)

On the final day of your Egypt Nile River Cruise, following a sumptuous breakfast and check-out from the cruise ship, your representative will transport you to Aswan Airport so you can catch your aircraft back to Cairo. Your private shuttle will take you to your hotel in Cairo when you arrive.

Day9: arrive fayoum

After picking you up from your lodging in Cairo, your tour guide will drive you more than 90 kilometers to the well-known El Fayoum attractions. Start your day trip from Cairo to El Fayoum to view Karanis, one of the biggest Greco-Roman ruins that was built in the third century BC under the direction of Ptolemy II.

Visit the Pyramid of Hawara, one of El Fayoum's most magnificent structures, built by Amenemhat III of the 12th dynasty (1814–1860 BC), whose reign is recognized as the Middle Kingdom's golden age (2055–1650 BC).

Keep observing the water wheels at Al Fayoum; they were crucial to the community's economy because they were utilized for agriculture. The water wheels serve as the official emblem of the governorate of El Fayoum today.

Visit <u>Wadi Al Rayan's waterfalls</u> and Lake Qarun, one of the most notable historic natural lakes, where activities like bird watching, fishing, and water sports are popular. Then, make the transfer back to your Cairo lodging.

Day14: Alexandria Day Trip from Cairo

You will meet up with your licensed Egyptologist guide to begin your day trip from Cairo to Alexandria, the gorgeous city that was established in 332 B.C. by the well-known Macedonian general and ruler Alexander the Great and served as Egypt's capital for roughly 1000 years.

You will first see <u>Pompey's Pillar</u>, which is located inside the ruined Serapeum of Alexandria, before continuing on to the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa, an ancient catacomb with three floors below ground and

ornamented from the inside with a mixture of Pharaonic and Greco-Roman styles of art and architecture.

Transfer to the Citadel of Qaitbay, constructed with the remains of the former Lighthouse Pharos. On our approach to a restaurant with a view of the water where we will eat a lovely seafood lunch, we will pass by the contemporary Bibliotheca of Alexandria.

For the overnight stay, we will return to Cairo in the same car.

Day 15: Final Departure
