

Day 1: Arrive to Cairo

Our representative will meet and assist you at the Cairo International Airport. He will assist you at the airport with the essential activities. Then he will transfer you by a luxurious, air-conditioned vehicle and he will help you with check-in procedures at your hotel. He will go over your 7-day schedule with you once you check in so you can confirm the pick-up times for each tour and activity.

Day 2- Cairo Day Tour to Sakkara and Dahshur Pyramids

The [Sakkara](#) and Dahshur Pyramids Day Tour is one of our most popular Cairo Tours. Get ready for the most exhilarating journey of your life. The largest and most well-known Step Pyramid of the Pharaoh Djoser is located at Saqqara Necropolis, where your qualified Egyptologist guide will greet you and take you there. From every angle, it dominates the necropolis. The famed builder of Imhotep's ancient dynasty built the pyramid around 2650 BC. He is credited for coming up with the idea to elevate the classical Egyptian tomb from its original mastaba form. In actuality, he advised piling one mastaba atop another.

Continue your tour to [Dahshur](#), which is a nearby necropolis where additional pyramids proudly exist as a continual reminder that ancient Egyptian history was littered with great Kings and Rulers. It is 1.5 km³ in size, 26 km south of Cairo, and situated on the west bank of the Nile. On the rocky plateau of Dahshur Pyramids dating back to the 4th, 12th, and 13th dynasties have been discovered. The Red Pyramid of King Senefru and the Bent Pyramid enjoy better maintenance than other nearby pyramids. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant as part of your Cairo Day Tours before being driven back to your hotel.

Day 3- Old Cairo tour

Our tour guide will meet you in the morning at your hotel in Cairo or Giza to start your tour. Your Coptic and Islamic Cairo Tour should start at [the Saladin Citadel](#) and the Mohamed Ali Alabaster Mosque.

Salah Al-Din, who is a well-known Muslim general constructed [the Citadel of Saladin](#) in the year 1176. It represents Ottoman architecture in Cairo because Sultan Ahmed's Blue Mosque in Istanbul served as the design's primary inspiration. You will see the Islamic Center of Sultan Hassan, the Mamluk mosque, and the Madrasas of Ibn Tulun, as well as the oldest still-standing mosque in Africa. You will be taken to another noteworthy location close by.

A huge mosque and madrassa, which is also known as the Sultan Hassan Mosque-Madrassa were built during the Mamluk Islamic period In Cairo's Old City. The mosque was hailed when it was first constructed for its enormous size and avant-garde architectural elements. Al-Maqrizi asserted that the mosque was home to various "wonders of construction" and that an-Nasir Hasan, a sultan with a brief and forgettable history, had given the go-ahead for its construction.

Sultan Hassan Mosque-Madrassa, a massive mosque in Cairo's Old City, was built during the Mamluk Islamic era. This era is renowned for its vastness and avant-garde architectural features.

We will transfer you back to your hotel so you can rest there.

Day4 - Bahariya Oasis tour

Day 5 - white desert tour.

We'll travel to [the White Desert](#), which is a part of [the Farafra Oasis](#) after breakfast. We will stop along the road for a rest stop in order to view [the Black Desert](#), which is made up of numerous Black formations and mountains that are densely covered with old volcanic rocks. The next place we'll pass through is [the Valley of El Haize](#), which is the southernmost Bahariyan hamlet. If you'd like, you can take a hot spring bath right here.

The gorgeous Valley of Agabat is where we'll take you next so you can practice sandboarding and see the quartz crystal in the Crystal Mountains. Last but not least, you'll spend the night camping in the White Desert and taking part in a breathtaking sunset while your guides make your delicious meal.

Day 6 - Back to Cairo

After a hearty breakfast, you'll head to [the White Desert](#) to see the hot springs and admire the stunning white limestone structures that have been shaped there over many generations by the yearly sandstorms that blow over the region. These formations have a variety of regional names, including the Mushroom and the Rabbit.

You'll switch to a more comfortable car at Bahariya Oasis and take Bahariya back to your Cairo hotel.
