Day 1: Friday - Aswan Sightseeing Tours

You will be picked up by Cairo Top Tours at <u>Aswan Airport</u> or Aswan Train Station and transported to your cruise ship, the MS Mayfair Nile Cruise, before lunch.

Your guide will take you to the southern portion of Aswan's most well-known attractions, the Aswan <u>High</u> <u>Dam</u> and the Temple of Isis, also known as the <u>Temple of Philae</u>, which is situated on one of the lovely islands in Aswan, to begin your <u>Aswan Day Tours</u>, then take pleasure in your felucca ride in Aswan on the Nile River.

Day 2: Saturday - Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

The <u>Kom Ombo temple</u>, which was built during the reign of Ptolemy VI and only decorated during the Roman era when Emperor Tiberius and other members of his dynasty were worshiping there, is where you will go. The design, architecture, and decoration of this temple are similar to those of other Egyptian Ptolemaic temples, but it has one advantage that helped it become well-known in the neighborhood: it is the shared temple of the gods Sobek and Haroeris.

After that, you'll ride in a carriage to Edfu to see the Temple of Horus. When the cruise finally resumes, you'll take pleasure in your meal and as the cruise goes on, the Nile River is viewed magnificently.

You'll attend the Egyptian Galabiya party in the evening. Stay the night in Esna.

Day 3: Sunday - Luxor East Bank Tours

Sail to Luxor in the early morning, and when you get there, enjoy your breakfast on board. Start your <u>Luxor Day Tours</u> by going to Luxor on the East Bank of the Nile, The <u>Temple of Luxor</u>, and <u>Karnak</u>, which is home to the temple dedicated to Amun and his wife Mut.
