## Day 1: Embarkation/ Luxor East Bank Tours

You will be picked up from your Luxor hotel and driven by one of our representatives to the starting point of your 5-day Nile Cruise Tour from Luxor to Aswan. After giving you the cabin keys, your tour guide will give you a brief break while you enjoy your first lunch on the MS Royal Viking Nile Cruise.

Your English-speaking Egyptologist tour guide will be waiting for you in the lobby as you start your Luxor East Bank Tours in Luxor, which is 700 kilometers south of Cairo. With approximately 500,000 residents, the city mostly relies on agriculture and tourism for its livelihood. tour the majestic [Karnak Temple](#), which was constructed and enlarged over the course of 2000 years from a little shrine during the New Kingdom to a gigantic Temple that occupies a sizable area. It is the largest temple in Egypt. Then go on with your Luxor excursions as you are driven to the magnificent [Luxor Temple](#), which is situated in the city bearing his name and was found in 1884 on the East Bank of the Nile in Luxor. After your Luxor tours, spend the night on board before continuing with your schedule tomorrow.

The Karnak Temple offers optional Sound and Light Shows for lunch and dinner.

## Day 2: Luxor West Bank Tours

After enjoying a delicious breakfast on board the MS Royal Viking Nile Cruise, you will meet your tour guide to start your West bank tour of Luxor. Here, you will visit the magnificent rock-cut tombs of the New Kingdom pharaohs, also known as the [Valley of the Kings](#). These tombs were built by these rulers far from tomb thieves, and more than 60 of these tombs have now been found. Continue your Luxor West Bank Tours to the Temple of El Deir El Bahari, also known as the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut. At 97 feet (30 meters) tall, it is one of the world's tallest temples. Your final Luxor day tour will take you to the [Colossi of Memnon](#), two enormous statues of the legendary King Amenhotep III. The Luxor to Aswan Nile Cruise will give you a delicious lunch before setting sail for Edfu.

Hot air balloon ride above the west bank monuments, optional.

You will have a delicious meal in the evening and spend the night on the Nile Cruise at Edfu.

Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are the meals.

## Day 3: Edfu and Kom Ombo Temples

Your expert tour guide will accompany you on one of the most interesting Egypt Day Tours, the tour to Edfu to see the [Temple of Horus](#), which still has all the elements of an ancient Egyptian temple preserved. The

Temple of Edfu is one of the largest in Egypt (the largest after the Karnak Temple) and one of the best. After experiencing the previous two days of Luxor Sightseeing tours, you will enjoy a delicious breakfast on the Nile Cruise.

After arriving in Kom Ombo, you will be taken to the amazing [Kom Ombo Temple](#), which is devoted to the crocodile god Sobek and was constructed between 1350 and 180 B.C. on King Ramses II's orders. The boat will then set sail for Aswan after your tour of Kom Ombo and Edfu is complete. Enjoy your delicious dinner on the cruise as well as the entertainment and local music show, and spend the night in the lovely city of Aswan.

## Day 4: Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

Breakfast will be served on board your Egypt Nile cruise as you begin your day, and then you should get ready to meet your own tour guide to start your Aswan Excursions as follows:

The High Dam

Visit the [High Dam](#), which protected Egypt from the Nile floods that formerly drowned the country for months due to water waste. Egypt's southernmost city is Aswan. Nearly 1,000 kilometers from Cairo, it is situated near the first Nile Falls.

The incomplete obelisk

When creating the vast [Giza Pyramids](#) throughout the old kingdom of Egypt's history, as well as the large temples, enormous pillars, and obelisks, notably during the new kingdom, ancient Egyptians used to cut and transport granite from the granite quarries.

Temple of Philae:

Continue your Aswan sightseeing to the [Philae Temple](#), one of the four locations where the myth of Isis, Osiris, and Horus occurred. It was constructed and devoted to the worship of the goddess Isis.

You will be transferred back to the cruise and enjoy your lunch meal, spend a free afternoon in Aswan, and in the evening, a good quality dinner will be prepared and served aboard the cruise boat, You will watch an interesting Nubian show, and overnight in Aswan.
