Day 1: Arrival to Cairo

At <u>Cairo International Airport</u>, a representative from Cairo Top Tours will be waiting for you with a signboard when you arrive in Egypt.

Using a private, contemporary vehicle with air conditioning, you will be driven to the hotel. The Cairo Top Tours guide will help you check in easily at the Cairo Pyramids hotel or a comparable establishment, and he will go over the details of your <u>Egypt Christmas Tours</u> itinerary with you to confirm the pick-up times for each tour. You'll receive a welcome beverage at the hotel.

Overnight in Cairo

Day 2: Pyramids & Cairo Tour / Train

Prepare for your incredible <u>Egypt luxury tours</u>. You'll have service for breakfast. A representative from Cairo Top Tours will greet you and help you, and you'll then be taken to the Giza Plateau, which is the most well-known.

You'll eat lunch at a neighborhood eatery around midday, after which you'll head to Tahrir Square's <u>Egyptian Museum</u>. The largest collection of Pharaonic artifacts in the entire world may be found at the Egyptian Museum, which is the oldest archaeological museum in the Middle East.

Continue on your journey to see <u>the Ben Ezra Synagogue</u>, the Church of St. Sergius, also called the Holy Family Church, and the Roman fortification of Babylon, as well as the Hanging Church. These are all highly regarded sights that will enhance your experience in Coptic Cairo.

After our trip through Coptic Cairo, we'll go on to our trip through <u>Islamic Cairo</u>. We'll explore <u>Khan El Khalili</u>, the world's oldest bazaar, and enjoy shopping tours in Cairo before stopping for tea at one of the neighborhood cafés in the ideal location for Islamic Cairo visits.

You'll be taken to the Giza railway station to board the incredible train to Luxor. Onboard meals include breakfast and dinner.

Day 4 : Sightseeing tour to the West Bank of Luxor and sailing to Edfu

Enjoy your breakfast buffet before traveling with your authorized guide to the two enormous sculptures of Amenophis III, also known as the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, on the West Bank of Luxor. The stunning rock-cut tombs in <u>the Valley of the kings</u>, where more than 60 pharaohs who ruled Egypt during the New Kingdom rest, including well-known rulers like Tutankhamun and Ramses II, will then wow you.

When the valley was discovered, all the tombs were filled with gold and other valuables that the Pharaohs had planned to enjoy during an afterlife that begins with their death. They are all carved from the Theban Mountain and lavishly decorated with amazing artwork and colors.

The first female ruler in recorded history, <u>Queen Hatshepsut</u>, had her famed architect, El Deir El Bahari, build her temple. After that, we'll transport you back to the ship so you can enjoy a fine lunch while sailing to Edfu.

After you return, the Nile cruise will set sail, and you can take in the stunning scenery while having tea.

Following the serving of your onboard supper in the evening, there will be entertainment that includes music and dancing.

Spend the night on the Nile Cruise.

Day 5 : Edfu Temple & Kom Ombo Temple

Enjoy a delicious breakfast before starting your <u>Aswan day tours</u>. You will ride in horse-drawn carriages to the impressive Ptolemaic <u>Temple of Edfu</u>, which is devoted to the falcon-god Horus. Following your tour to the temple, your carriage will return you to the ship, where you will board and set sail for Aswan before stopping at Kom Ombo. At Kom Ombo, you will disembark and go to explore the magnificent <u>Temple of Kom Ombo</u>, which is devoted to the crocodile, God Sobek, and Haroeris. Your tour guide will drive you back to the MS Royal Lily Nile Cruise so you can eat lunch there. You will embark on your Aswan voyage in the late afternoon.

Dinner will be served on board in the evening and overnight in Aswan.

Day 6 : Tours in Aswan

Eat your favorite meal while admiring the lovely Nile. Start your <u>Aswan excursions</u> by visiting the High Dam, one of Egypt's most significant construction projects. Next, head to the magnificent <u>Philae Temple</u>, which is devoted to the goddess Isis and was constructed in 280 B.C. during the reign of <u>Ptolemy ii</u> <u>Philadelphus</u>. The temple is located on an island, and we can get there after a breath-taking boat ride.

The tour continues to the Aswan granite quarries, where visitors may see the largest known obelisk. Because it was left unfinished, the obelisk inspired experts to calculate how many granite monoliths were liberated from the quarry. Queen Hatshepsut most likely sculpted the unfinished obelisk. You will spend your final night on your enchanted Nile cruise once we return you to your Egypt Nile River Cruise. A magnificent meal will be served.

Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are all included.

Day 7: Your Train back to Cairo

You can either book one of our optional tours, like the Optional Tour to Abu Simbel, where you can see the Great Temple of Abu Simbel, which is dedicated to Ramses Il's worship, and the small temple of Nefertari, both of which were excavated out of the solid rock of a mountain, after enjoying your delicious breakfast, and then disembark your MS Royal Lily Nile cruise to enjoy an amazing free day at Aswan.
