Day 1: Saturday - Welcome Day

When you arrive, a member of our staff will welcome you, help you, and accompany you to the Sonesta Amirat Dahabeya Nile Cruise, one of the greatest [Egypt Tour packages from the USA](#), On the Nile Dahabeya boat, lunch will be provided as you take in the tranquility of the Nile River. After supper, you will spend the night in Aswan.

Food: Lunch and Dinner

Day 2: Sunday - Temple of Philae and Kom Ombo

Enjoy your first breakfast on board your Sonesta Amirat Dahabiya cruise ship and then you will start your wonderful Egypt Day Tours visiting the Aswan [High Dam](#) Aswan Dam, which was designed by the Moscow-based Institute of Hydroelectric Projects to save the country from the Nile floods that drowned Egypt every year with unused water, instead saving the energy needed to light the country.

You will also visit the [Temple of Philae](#), dedicated to the wife of the God Osiris and the hero in the myth of Osiris and Isis against the evil God Seth, the Goddess Isis, a structure rescued from the rising waters of Lake Nasser at the time of the construction of the High Dam.

Lunch will be served on the way to Kom Ombo.

Day 3: Monday - Luxor Kom Ombo Day Tour

Enjoy your regular breakfast on board the ship as you cruise to Kom Ombo in the early morning. We will go to the Ptolemaic-style Kom Ombo Temple, which was built to honor the gods of the sky and kingship Horus, who has a falcon on his head, and the crocodile god Sobek, who is represented in numerous settings and sculptures from various periods in Egypt's history.

Day 4: Tuesday - Temple of Edfu Day Tour

After enjoying a delectable breakfast on board your Egypt Nile River Cruise, you will set sail for Edfu this morning. Then, on the west bank of the Nile, you will be able to see the remarkably well-preserved [Temple of Edfu](#), one of Egypt's most intriguing temples that was built during the Ptolemaic dynasty.

Day 5: Wednesday - Voyage to Esna

You will have the rest of the day to yourself to take advantage of the unusual setting following your delicious lunch. After passing the lock and beginning our voyage to Esna, the Dahabeya boat will anchor next to a picturesque island in the Nile. You will be provided with lunch and dinner on board the opulent Sonesta Amirat Dahabiya Cruise.

Day 6: Thursday - Luxor Day Tours

You'll set the ship for Luxor this morning to begin your [Luxor day tours](#). The city has gone by a number of names over its history; among them is Waset, which is Egyptian for "scepter." Due to its resemblance to the Greek city that gave it its name, the Greeks dubbed it Thebes. Your lunch and dinner will be served on board while you explore the beautiful Amon-Ra temple complex, also known as the spectacular Karnak Temple.

Day 7: Friday - Luxor East Bank Tour

After breakfast, your Egyptologist tour guide will take you on a [Luxor East Bank Tour](#) to see the great tombs of the New Kingdom pharaohs, known as the [Valley of the Kings](#). It was here that Howard Carter was successful in finding [King Tutankhamun's tomb](#) in 1922; today, his gold collection is on display separately in the Egyptian Museum in Cairo. Continue on to the nearby Valley of the Queens, Medinet Habu Temple, and the world-famous [Colossi of Memnon](#) constructed for the legendary King Amenhotep III, Tutankhamun's grandfather. Enjoy your meals while you're on board.
