Día 1: Llegada a El Cairo y check in.

Then, continue to the well-known Tahrir Square in downtown Cairo to start your private tour of <u>The Egyptian Museum</u>, The Egyptian Museum, which was built in 1902 and houses thousands of statues and coffins, is home to numerous artifacts. Your tour guide will be able to fill you in on a wealth of information about these items.

Day 5: West Bank of Luxor/ Edfu

You'll go to the <u>Valley of the Kings</u>, where you can see numerous rock-cut tombs for various kings of ancient Egypt, as well as the <u>Colossi of Memnon</u>, the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, which was built by Hatshepsut, a well-known and powerful queen during the 18th dynasty.

Day 6: Visit to the temple of Edfu / the temple of Kom Ombo

Then, get ready as your knowledgeable Egyptologist guide leads you to the admirably preserved Edfu Ptolemaic-style temple, which is dedicated to God Horus, who in accordance with ancient Egyptian religion is the protector of royalty. Following your return to the ship, you are free to explore the Kom Ombo Temple, which is dedicated to the crocodile gods Sobek and Haroeris. Enjoy your lunch, which is being provided to you, as the Nile cruise ship travels toward Aswan.

On board your luxurious Nile cruise, a sumptuous meal will be served as you enjoy the Nubian Show while spending the night at Aswan.

Day 7: Aswan Tours

Enjoy your delicious breakfast on board the boat before sailing into the charming city of Aswan to see the renowned Aswan High Dam. The purpose of this construction was to lessen the yearly floods on the Nile's deadly effects. We'll take a boat ride to the magnificent Temple of Philae, an island temple dedicated to the goddess Isis, where we'll meet you. The next-largest known Obelisk in the Aswan granite quarries is The Unfinished Obelisk, which was most likely constructed by Queen Hatshepsut.

Once your Aswan sightseeing tours are complete, your tour guide will bring you back to the cruise ship.

Enjoy your meal and the night on the ship.

Day 8: Disembarkation, Back to Cairo

You now have the wonderful opportunity to travel to <u>Abu Simbel Temple</u>, Ramses II's most magnificent Egyptian temple, by land or air early in the morning. (Specific Activity)

After an excellent breakfast and check-out from the cruise ship on the final day of your Egypt Nile River Cruise, your representative will take you to Aswan Airport so you can catch your flight back to Cairo. When you arrive, a private vehicle will transport you to your hotel in Cairo.

Day9: arrive fayoum

The well-known sights of El Fayoum are more than 90 kilometers away from where your tour guide will pick you up from your Cairo lodging. Start your day trip from Cairo to El Fayoum to see Karanis, one of the biggest Greco-Roman ruins, which was built in the third century BC under the direction of Ptolemy II.

Visit the Pyramid of Hawara, one of El Fayoum's most breathtaking structures, which was built by King Amenemhat III, a pharaoh of the 12th dynasty (1814–1860 BC), whose reign is regarded as the Middle Kingdom's golden age (2055–1650 BC).

Keep observing the water wheels at Al Fayoum; they were crucial to the community's economy because they were used for agriculture. The water wheels serve as the official emblem of the governorate of El Fayoum today.

Visit <u>Lake Qarun</u>, one of the most renowned historic natural lakes, and the waterfalls of Wadi Al Rayan, where water sports, fishing, and bird watching are popular pastimes. After that, return to your Cairo accommodation by transfer.

Day 10: Fly to Sharm El Sheikh

After an excellent breakfast in the hotel, the representative of Cairo Top Tours will drive you to the domestic departure area of Cairo International Airport so you can board your flight to Sharm El-Sheikh, you will have the opportunity to avoid the crowds and unwind on Sharm El-beautiful Sheikh's beaches after being welcomed and helped at Sharm Airport and being transferred to your hotel.

Day14: Alexandria Day Trip from Cairo

You will first see Pompey's Pillar, which is located inside the ruined Serapeum of Alexandria, before continuing on to <u>The Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa</u>, an ancient catacomb with three floors below ground and ornamented from the inside with a mixture of Pharaonic and Greco-Roman styles of art and architecture.

Transfer to the Citadel of Qaitbay, which was built using the wreckage of the former Pharos Lighthouse. We will pass by the modern <u>Bibliotheca of Alexandria</u> on the way to a restaurant with a view of the water where we will enjoy a lovely seafood lunch.

We'll take the same car back to Cairo after the overnight stay.

Day 15: Final Departure
