Itinerario

Day 1: Arrival in Egypt

Arrival in Cairo marks the start of your Cairo and the Nile Cruise Accessible Tour. Our representative will meet you at the [Cairo International Airport](#) the largest and most active airport in Egypt and serves as Cairo's primary international airport. And take you to your hotel in Cairo in a private air-conditioned vehicle. After making sure that your 8-day Egypt-accessible tour package's getting times and any additional excursions have been updated, spend the night in Cairo.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Egyptian Museum

The tour to the [Giza Pyramids](#), where you can see the enormous structure known as the Great Pyramid of King Cheops, was built during the 4th dynasty of Egyptian history (4500 years ago) by the son of Snefru, Cheops from the old kingdom, by the efforts of almost 20 years of arduous labor to become the tallest building in the world. After breakfast at the hotel, meet our accredited Egyptologist to begin your tour in Cairo by visiting the highlights of Cairo one of the Seven Wonder

The Valley Temple of King Chephren, the Pyramid of Mycerinus, and the Great Sphinx are among the day's many historical artifacts. After exploring the Giza plateau, you will be driven to downtown Cairo to begin your tour of [the Egyptian Museum](#). There, you will see more than 120,000 artifacts that will astound you with the intricate perfection of ancient Egyptian art, as well as King Tutankhamun's most intriguing golden collection and the royal mummies room. Next, you will be driven to a restaurant for a delicious lunch before returning to your hotel for the night.

Day 3: Free Day at Leisure, Optional Alexandria Tour from Cairo

Enjoy a delicious breakfast buffet at your hotel and the flexibility to plan your day however you like. As an alternative, you can travel from Cairo to Alexandria on a day trip that is optional. This fascinating city served as Egypt's capital and a thriving hub of Greek influence when it was founded by the illustrious [Alexander the Great](#) in the fourth century B.C. was the ruler of the Macedonian kingdom in ancient Greece. At the age of 20, he succeeded his father Philip II to the throne in 336 BC. He spent the majority of his reigning years leading a protracted military campaign across Western Asia and Egypt.

Explore the ancient ruins to see the traces of the Greco-Roman era. These ruins are a reminder of the city's glorious past and its rivalry with other Greek cities at that time. You can decide whether to spend the day relaxing or exploring Alexandria's fascinating history.

Day 4: Fly to Aswan, Aswan Nile Cruise Tours

In the early morning, after your daily buffet breakfast is finished, you will meet our representative who will be in charge of taking you to Cairo International Airport so you can board your flight to Aswan. When you arrive at [Aswan Airport](#), another representative will be waiting to take you to the cruise ship and help you with the check-in process. You will then leave your luggage and begin your Aswan excursion with an amazing visit to [The High Dam in Aswan](#) is one of the biggest embankment dams in the world, and it was constructed across the Nile in Aswan, Egypt, between 1960 and 1970. the enormous project that modern-day Egyptian President Nasser carried out in the 20th century to protect the country from the annual Nile floods and produce electricity for every part of Egypt.

Continue your Aswan tour to The [Temple of Philae](#), a Ptolemaic structure that was devoted to Goddess Isis, the ancient Egyptian goddess of magic. During your excursions in Aswan, you will be taken to the granite quarries to see [The Unfinished Obelisk](#), which we think was cut during the reign of Queen Hatshepsut. After returning to the cruise ship, dine at lunch and dinner there before spending the night in Aswan.

Day 5: Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

While we comfortably continue our cruise on the Nile, breakfast is served on board the ship. The ship stops in [Edfu](#) where passengers can explore the enormous temple that is devoted to Horus one of the most important ancient Egyptian gods, serving a variety of roles, including those of the sun, the sky, the sun god, healing, and protection. The falcon-headed god and son of Osiris, who rules the skies. Before being transferred back to the cruise ship, lunch, dinner, and overnight are included on board, continue your tour to [Kom Ombo Temple](#), which was devoted to the ancient Egyptian gods Sobek and Horaeris.

Day 6: Luxor East Bank Tours

We will arrive in Luxor, the world's largest open-air museum, after breakfast on the boat. Luxor is home to numerous monuments from ancient civilizations. The Middle Kingdom and the New Kingdom's Egyptian capital was located in Upper Egypt's Luxor region, which served as their Thebes. Luxor, a modern city, is situated on the eastern bank, [Luxor Temple](#), also known as Thebes or Luxor in Arabic, is a sizable Ancient Egyptian temple complex that was built around 1400 BCE on the east bank of the Nile River in the present-day city of Luxor. The enormous [Karnak Temple](#) complex, which was created about 4055 years ago, is located at the northernmost point of the city. It is well known for its main hypostyle hall, which features 134 hefty columns.

Starting from the first pylon, you can explore the ruins and travel through time. We will be traveling to the Temple of Luxor, one of the largest places of worship on earth, via an avenue flanked on either side by sphinxes. It was constructed by King Amenhotep III. After finishing our tours of the Luxor East Bank, we will board the cruise ship once more.

Day 7: Luxor West Bank Tours

You will disembark from your Aswan to Luxor Nile cruise after a sumptuous breakfast to begin your Luxor west bank tours, which will begin with a visit to the [Valley of the Kings](#). An area in Egypt where rock-cut tombs for pharaohs and wealthy nobles were unearthed during the New Kingdom period for nearly 500 years between the Eighteenth Dynasty and the Twentieth Dynasty is also known as the Valley of the Gates of the Kings.

The majority of the tombs were discovered intact and undisturbed at the New Kingdom Necropolis, one of Luxor's most famous sites where excavations are still continuing. We will visit the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, which was constructed as a mortuary temple and tells the divine origin story of the semi-god Queen Hatshepsut, as well as the enormous statues of Amenhotep III known as the [Colossi of Memnon](#). The two enormous stone statues of Pharaoh [King Amenhotep III](#) known as the Colossi of Memnon are located in front of the ruined Mortuary Temple of Amenhotep III.
