Day 1: Arrival in Cairo

Upon your arrival at Cairo International Airport, you will be warmly welcomed by a representative from Cairo Top Tours.

Look for a signboard with your name on it to easily identify your tour leader.

You will then be transferred to your hotel in a private, air-conditioned deluxe vehicle.

During the transfer, your tour leader will review your Egypt Easter Tours itinerary with you and confirm the pick-up times for each tour day.

This will ensure that you have all the necessary information for a smooth and enjoyable experience. Once you arrive at the hotel, our representative will assist you with a seamless check-in process.

You will also be served a welcome drink, allowing you to relax and unwind after your journey.

Enjoy your overnight stay at the hotel, preparing for an exciting exploration of Cairo and the Nile in the coming days.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids & Cairo Tour

After enjoying your breakfast at the hotel, you will meet your knowledgeable tour guide to begin your Egypt Easter tour.

Your first stop will be the Giza Plateau, where you will marvel at the Great Pyramid of Cheops. This architectural masterpiece is one of the Seven Wonders of the World and was built using over 2.6 million blocks of rock, each weighing 50 tons. Learn about King Cheops, one of the most famous rulers in ancient Egypt, and admire the grandeur of his pyramid. Next, you will visit the middle pyramid of King Chephren.

Although smaller in size than the Great Pyramid, it is situated on a higher plateau, creating the illusion of being larger. You will also see the pyramid of Mycerinus, the smallest of the three main pyramids at the Giza Pyramid Complex.

Your tour continues with a visit to the Great Sphinx of Giza. This iconic limestone statue depicts a mythical creature with the body of a lion and the head of a human. Built by King Chephren, it was intended to protect the pyramids from tomb robbers, adding to the mystique of the Giza Plateau. You will then explore the Valley Temple, a mortuary temple associated with King Chephren.

Afterward, enjoy a delicious lunch at a local restaurant before heading to downtown Cairo. Your next stop is the renowned Egyptian Museum, home to over 120,000 artifacts, including the spectacular treasures of King Tutankhamun.

Admire the massive statues and ancient relics that provide insight into Egypt's rich history. Continuing the tour, you will visit the old Coptic Cairo area. Explore the Hanging Church, also known as the Church of the Virgin Mary, which was built on top of a Roman fortress wall dating back to the 4th century BC.

Discover the church of St. Sergius, believed to have provided shelter for the Holy Family during their escape from King Herod and the Roman soldiers. Finally, visit the Ben Ezra Synagogue, a sacred place for Jews, and hear the story of how the box of Baby Moses was found in this location.

Next, delve into the vibrant atmosphere of Islamic Cairo. Explore the famous Khan El Khalili market, where you can find a wide array of Egyptian souvenirs and traditional crafts. Take a break and enjoy a cup of tea at El Fishawy Cafe, a popular spot in the heart of the El-Hussein area.

Finally, you will be transferred back to your hotel.

Day 3: Arrival in Luxor / Luxor Excursions

After enjoying breakfast at Cairo Hotel, you will check out and be transferred to Cairo International Airport for your flight to Luxor.

Upon arrival, a representative from Cairo Top Tours will be there to meet and assist you.

Your guide will then transfer you from Luxor Airport to the Nile Cruise.

Once on board, you will have lunch and then embark on the East Bank tour.

The first stop is Karnak Temple, the largest man-made temple complex in the world.

Explore the awe-inspiring temples, towering columns, and intricate hieroglyphics that make this site truly remarkable.

Afterward, you will visit the majestic Temple of Luxor, which is beautifully illuminated at night. Marvel at the grandeur of this ancient temple and learn about its historical and cultural significance.

Throughout the day, you will enjoy delicious meals on board the cruise.

Day 4: West Bank of Luxor / Edfu

Start your day with a delicious breakfast served on your Nile cruise.

Next, you will visit the Valley of the Kings, where 62 pharaohs of the New Kingdom were laid to rest, including the famous Tutankhamun and the legendary Ramesses II.

Explore the tombs carved into the mountainside, adorned with intricate paintings and filled with treasures that were intended for the pharaohs' afterlife.

Continuing the tour, you will visit Hatshepsut's Temple, also known as El Deir El Bahary. This temple is dedicated to Hatshepsut, the first female ruler in written history.

Admire the grand architecture and learn about the fascinating story of this powerful queen. After lunch on board the cruise, you will set sail to Edfu.

Enjoy a delightful dinner while cruising along the Nile and spend the night on the cruise.

Day 5: Temple of Edfu / Kom Ombo

Next, you will sail to Kom Ombo to visit the captivating Temple of Kom Ombo. This unique temple is built on a traditional plan and is dedicated to two gods: Horus, the falcon-headed god, and Sobek, the crocodile-headed god.

Admire the symmetrical design of the temple, with two entrance pylons, forecourts, hypostyle halls, and sanctuaries for each deity.

Afterward, enjoy a delicious lunch served on board the cruise as you sail to Aswan. In the evening, savor a delightful dinner on the Nile cruise and spend the night, enjoying the serene atmosphere and beautiful scenery.

Day 6: Aswan Tours

Start your day with a delicious breakfast on the Nile cruise.

Your Egyptologist guide will accompany you to visit the famous High Dam. Built between 1960 and 1971 by the second president of Egypt, Gamal Abdel Nasser, the High Dam has had a significant impact on Egypt. It increased the country's production of electric power, controlled floods, and allowed for the storage of water for later use. Learn about the engineering marvel of this dam and its importance to Egypt's development.

Next, you will visit the magnificent Philae Temple, dedicated to the Goddess Isis. Originally located on Philae Island, the temple had to be relocated to Agilika Island due to the construction of the High Dam. Marvel at the beautiful architecture and intricate carvings that depict ancient Egyptian mythology and religious beliefs.

Continue your tour with a visit to the Unfinished Obelisk. This massive obelisk was carved out of solid rock during the reign of Queen Hatshepsut. Although it remains unfinished, it provides insight into the ancient Egyptian process of obelisk construction. Today, it is located in the granite quarries near Aswan, exactly where it was semi-carved.

Afterward, you will return to the cruise and enjoy a delicious dinner on board.
