Islamic Cairo Day Tour

Enjoy an extraordinary journey through Cairo's architectural wonders, beginning with a visit to the Citadel of Salah El-Din and the Mohammed Ali Mosque. Built-in 1176 A.D. by the Arab Sultan Salah El-Din, the Citadel stands majestically on a plateau, offering panoramic views of Cairo. It served as both a fortress and the administrative centre until the mid-20th century. The Mohammed Ali Mosque, completed in the early 1800s, is renowned for its striking twin minarets.

Your tour continues to the Sultan Hassan Mosque, a masterpiece of 13th-century Islamic architecture, often called the "Pyramid of Islamic Art." This grand mosque complex includes educational madrasas and accommodation for students.

Next, explore the Rifai Mosque and the tombs of King Farouk and Shah Mohammed Reza Pahlavi before visiting the Ibn Tulun Mosque, the oldest in Cairo, where you can climb the minarets for a spectacular city view. Enjoy a delightful lunch at a local restaurant.

The tour proceeds to Cairo's ancient gates, including Bab Zuweila and El Moez Street, renowned as an open-air museum showcasing Islamic art. Conclude your adventure at Khan el-Khalili, a vibrant bazaar with a labyrinth of passageways offering an authentic shopping experience. Relax with a traditional Egyptian tea or coffee at the historic Fishawy café.

After your tour, you'll be transported back to your hotel in Cairo or Giza.
