Our Cairo Day Tours take you to the sacred necropolis of the Old Kingdom's capital in ancient Egypt, where you can visit the first true pyramid, the Red Pyramid, and the Bent Pyramid in Dahshur. You'll also see the Pyramid of Snefru, known as the Meidum Pyramid, marvelling at these impressive structures built over 4,650 years ago, designed to preserve the legacy of Egypt's early kings and rulers who began the golden age of Egyptian history.

Day Trip to Dahshur, Memphis and Meidum from Cairo

A Cairo Top Tours representative will meet you to explore Egypt's ancient monuments and lesser-known pyramids beyond the famous Great Pyramids of Giza. You'll have the opportunity to see the three pyramids built for King Snefru, father of King Cheops, who constructed the Great Pyramid at Giza. Begin with a visit to the step pyramid at Meidum, then travel to Dahshur to view two more pyramids from the early 4th Dynasty of the Old Kingdom.

The Bent Pyramid, which has a distinctive bend due to the width of its base, and the Red Pyramid, the third-largest in Egypt, follow the pyramids of Cheops and Chephren in size. Continue your day tour of Dahshur, Memphis, and Meidum with a visit to Memphis, once the world's oldest capital, now known as Mit Rahina, where an open-air museum features impressive statues of King Ramses II from the New Kingdom. A delicious lunch will be provided during or after your Cairo trip.
